



When he left he donated a trophy as a token of appreciation to the club who befriended him. His name is Kaj Bournebusch and he now lives on the Continent. The meeting which bears his name is also very much alive and if you need proof you have only to look at to-day's entry list.

Sidecar motocross gives the British a chance to hold their heads high once again. We have at this event some of the home riders who can mix it with Europe's — indeed the World's — best. There are the winners of the British Sidecar Grand Prix, Nick Thompson and Dave Beavis on the Heanes Norton. On the Denselube Weslake John Turner and north-countryman Pete Logan will make it difficult for any one who fancies his chances and hard riding Terry Good, on the Pegasus Norton, is bound to have wings. Completing the English contingent will be Andy Wilkins, Tony Hall, Bob Spencer and Bob Gollner on the immaculate but screaming Kawasaki.

But to-day's race is an international affair so from Belgium comes Pierre Borms riding a Norton Wasp and Boudenign De Kort on another Kawasaki. Representing France will be Pierre Piron on his own special with a Yamaha engine. Star of the meeting last year was the globetrotting Dane, Per Jorgenson, whom we hope will have time to drop in to delight the Chalton crowd. And who could mistake West Germany's Josef Brockenhausen whose Hagon Hedlund must be one of the most unusual machines on the track.

I can say with confidence that you will enjoy this Portsmouth Club promotion because it has a good sidecar entry and chairmen, being the sportsmen they are, never let you down.
