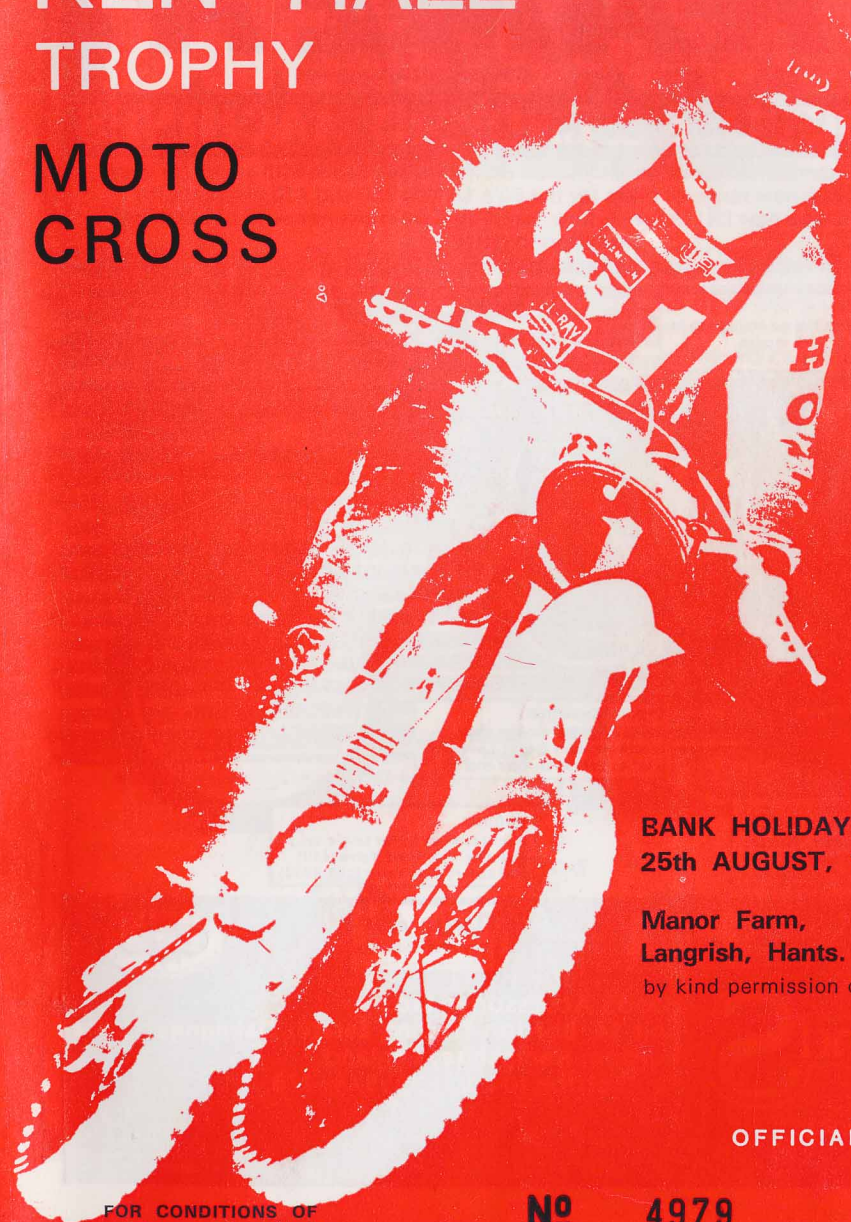

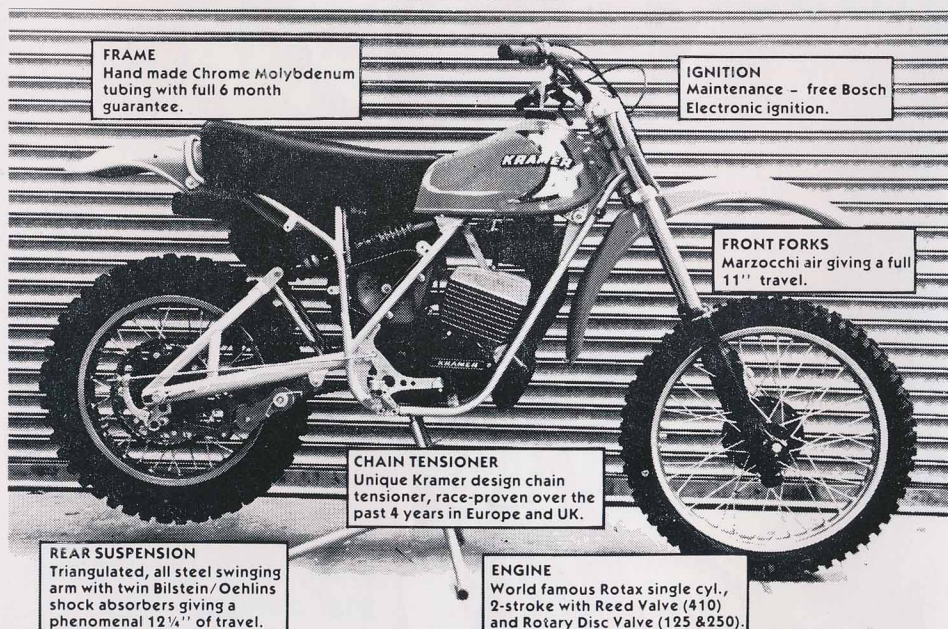

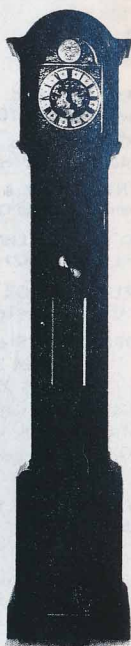

International Ken Hall Trophy Moto Cross.

It's always exciting to be in at the start of a new venture, and today's the day that the Ken Hall becomes an international for the first time. After 14 years as a national this prestige solo and sidecar event plays host to the tops in the sport from both Britain and Europe.

And British fans get their first chance to salute the newly-crowned champion of the world! It's just two weeks since Belgium's André Malherbe clinched the championship that had been held for the previous year by double Ken Hall winner Graham Noyce.

Five times world champion Roger De Coster is the second Team Honda man on the entry list and is always a popular figure with British fans.

While the Honda men might be favourites, they'll have plenty of opposition from their continental rivals. From West Germany come Maico number one Herbert Schmitz and on-form KTM man Ludwig Reinbold, the Dutch are represented by popular Suzuki man Gerard Rond and Toon Karsmakers (Maico), Scandinavian Bertil Ovegard carries Husqvarna's hopes and France is represented by Kawasaki's Daniel Pean and 125 GP rider Jacky Vimond (Yamaha).

But there's a top line-up of homespun talent who are out to ensure that the Ken Hall Trophy remains in the UK.

Last year's winner Stephen Beamish is back on form after returning from a broken ankle and is determined to hold on to the trophy for another year. But there are plenty of riders out to prevent him retaining the title.

Favourite among the British lads must be Neil Hudson, who is flying back from the Swedish 250 GP in order to ride today. He too has had his injury problems this year but is now fully fit and back to form.

Then there is current British championship leader Geoff Mayes, who holds a joint first place in the title series with the injured Graham Noyce. These three English men must be the favourites but from across the Irish sea, Ulsterman Laurence Spence has to be counted as a serious challenger. His GP experience in 1980 has caught the eye of a lot of observers.

A total of 27 men will line up for the two leg International event and others to watch include Bob Wright (CCM), Jonathan Wright (Suzuki), Pete Mathia (Montesa), Roger Harvey (Maico), Billy Aldridge (Suzuki), Vic Allan (KTM), Steve Harrison (Kawasaki), Paul Harrison (Maico), and Paul Hunt (Yamaha).

In the three wheeler category, British champion Terry Good was to have topped the list but he is out through injury so the interest will settle on Nick Thompson, John Turner, John Elliott, John Roberts, Kim Logan and Billy Lee. They are men who will battle it out for the second Ken Hall Trophy over the two 20 minute plus one lap races.

Here's hoping for a great day's racing!
