

THE 'KEN HALL' INTERNATIONAL MOTO CROSS

Well another twelve months have passed and it's come round to that time of the year when the Waterlooville Motor Cycle Club stage their annual Ken Hall Trophy Moto Cross at Manor Farm, Langrish on August Bank Holiday Monday. The event is dedicated to a local rider, Ken Hall, who lived in the village of Stroud, within sight of this circuit, and who possessed all the qualities in a sportsman that endeared him to spectators as well as helping him to win races and friends where-ever he rode - dedication, aggression and determination coupled with a friendly good humour.

This year will be the 19th running of the Ken Hall Moto Cross on what is one of the best viewing circuits in the land. With a host of crews from abroad the meeting will again have an 'International' tag as the best of our home sidecar-cross drivers are challenged by the cream from West Germany, France, Holland, Switzerland and Denmark.

British champion Terry Good, who holds the Ken Hall Sidecar Trophy may have a harder job on his hands this season in trying to retain the title. His opposition from Britain will include Doug Fox, Paul Millard and Kim Logan, who gave 'TG' a run for his money in 1984. And with strong competition from abroad we are sure to have some cracking action from the three-wheeled brigade.

From the quality of the field in the solo national class, it would appear we should have a day of quality racing there too. Heading the field is American Danny Magoo Chandler, who is this season contesting the world championship using an Irish licence, permitting him to contest British nationals. Danny, who has greatly assisted the club in the layout of the track for this season's event, is well up in the world rankings and loves to please the crowds with his aerial acrobatics during the races.

Two of his main rivals will be British former world champions Graham Noyce and Neil Hudson. Noyce won the Ken Hall Trophy in 1975, '77 and '78 and went on to win the world 500cc championship in 1979. Hudson has never had his name on the silverware but the 1981 world 250cc champ was only beaten by Yorkshire's Brett Steel last year. Also likely to be amongst the battles for top honours is Jeremy Whatley the national 250cc champion, who had been having a great year both at home and abroad before breaking his wrist in America which put him out for a month.

Mervyn Anstie, a protege of Noyce, has been acclaimed as the find of the year on the Grand Prix scene, with an aggressive style which is reaping good results for the Newbury youngster.

Andy Nicholls and Willie Simpson are men who don't give up easily and both would like to join the impressive list of stars who have laid claim to the Ken Hall Trophy.

One such star, who won the event in 1969, Vic Allan will be competing again today and with another Scot from the same era -Jimmy Aird - also in action there could well be fierce battles between the pair.

To round off the fiercely competitive nature of each class riding here today will be a field of virtually all of the top names in the schoolboy category of the sport in Britain. The champions of this year and the adult champions of future years could well be in the field.

Lastly, I would like to pass on thanks to the sponsors of the meeting, without whom the Waterlooville club could not stage such an exciting event. City Garage of Chichester is the main sponsor, but Rock-Oil, Mott Motor Cycles and Don Schmidt Motor Cycles are also assisting on this front.






