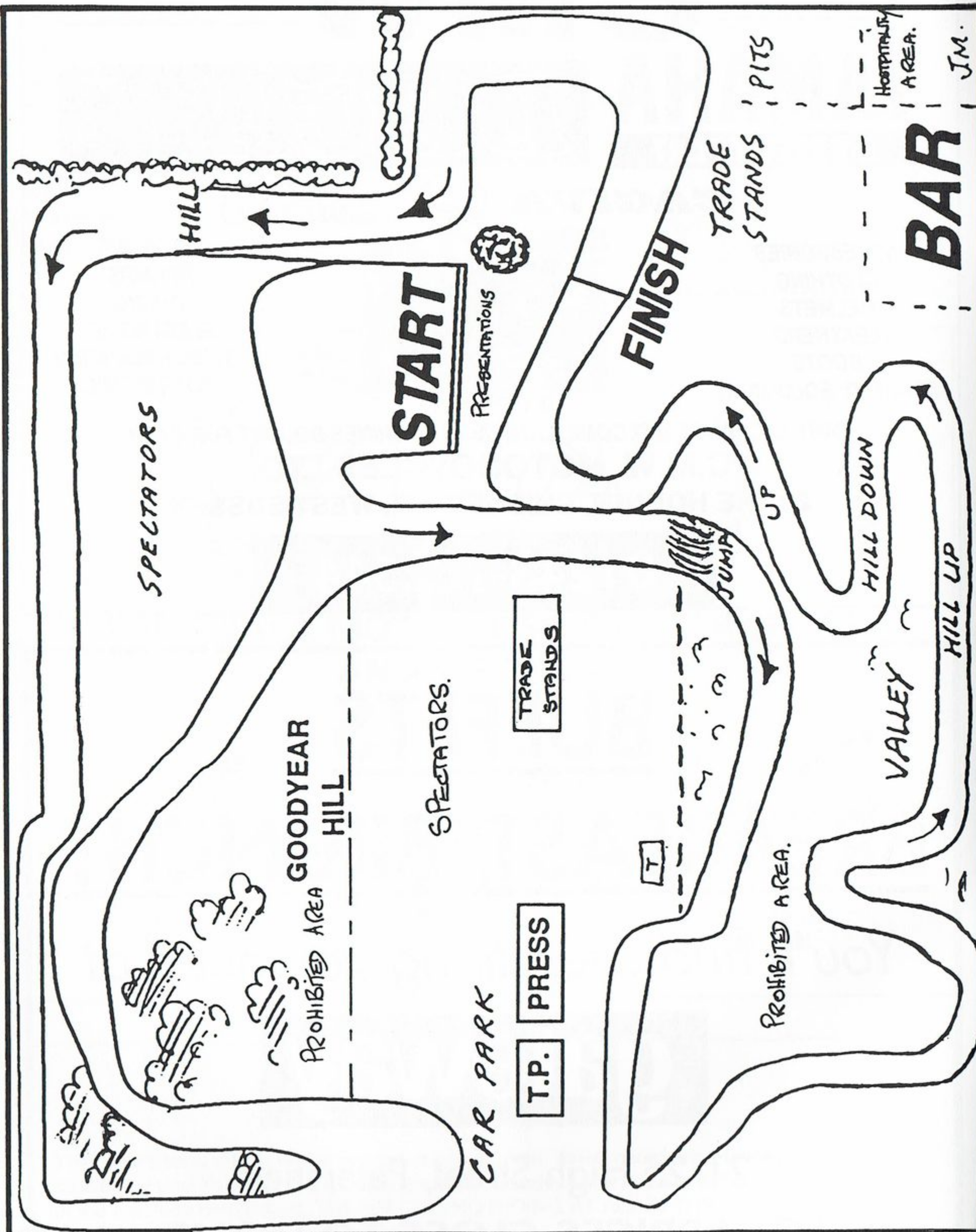

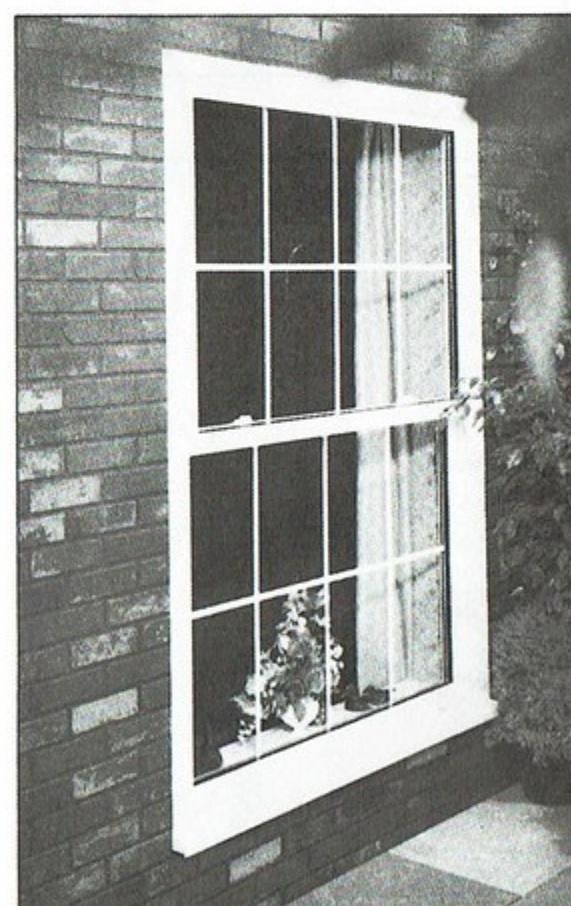

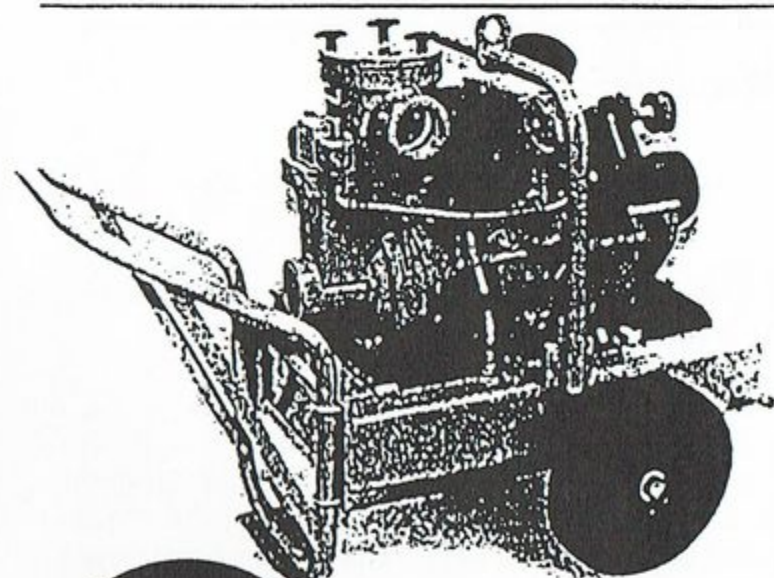

THIRTY YEARS ON

It was in August 1965 when that race scrambler Ken Hall, lost his life in a racing accident. This scruffy, likeable character lived just up the road from this circuit, near the "Seven Stars" pub, and he is buried in Langrish churchyard.

In August 1966 the Waterlooville club organised the first Ken Hall trophy moto-cross here at Manor Farm. It became a major annual fixture, and was contested by almost all of Britain's top solo and sidecar stars and several top continental aces over the years. And this year Waterlooville stages a 2 day "Ancient and Modern" spectacular, to mark the 30th anniversary of Ken's passing.

Sunday is the nostalgia day, for the entry is mostly made up of former Ken Hall trophy entrants, and there are several winners among them.

Topping the list of solo pastmasters is Hampshire's own Graham Noyce, the 1979 world 500 cc moto-cross champion, who won five open class British titles. Noyce also won the Ken Hall trophy three times. His most noteworthy victory was in 1978 when he blitzed 'em on a standard 250 cc Honda, which was assembled out of a crate, just in time for practice.

And there's another world champion here. Neil Hudson won the 250 cc title in 1981, then he scooped the British open series the following year. Hudson and Noyce have been firm friends since their schooldays, but the fur used to fly when they took to the track - maybe it will again on Sunday.

We are also honoured by the appearance of two more old friends - former Triumph teamsters, John Giles and Ken Heanes. They are both in their 'sixties, but they'll make sweet music as they snick their Meriden twins into top on the main straight.

Somewhat younger (and somewhat wilder) is "Kranky" Ken Hanson, the wild man of Wycombe, and his even younger cousin, Greg Hanson, who is a current top liner, but qualifies as a pastmaster because he rode in the "Ken Hall" back in 1977!

Ginger haired Brummie, Arthur Browning, was a star of the Grandstand trophy TV series in the 1960's. He's still quick, and very stylish as we saw at Farleigh castle last month. Another Midlander who was neat as well as fleet is "Mr Suzuki" Rob Hooper.

South Midlander, Steve How, will be in the lineup, hopefully aboard his CCM, along with Chris Scriven, the shock winner of the 1976 Ken Hall trophy, Des Helyar, who has been watching the calories and shrinking his waistline, and Dennis Smith, who won't be allowed to start unless he wears his famous blue and white chequered helmet.

The sidecar lineup is headed by that charismatic character, Terry Good, with Barry Williams, who passengered him to 3 of his 7 British titles, and one of his three Ken Hall victories. Terry the terror told me: "I won't be coming to play around, I'm coming to win," but he'll have to stretch the throttle wire to get the better of his great rivals of the early 1980's, Doug Fox / John Cooper.

My money is on Essex men, Dave Mallows / Darryl Groat to win, but others might wager their shirts on John "JR" Roberts / Mick Ripper or maybe former AMCA champions, John Snape / Rod Todd or Johnny York / Chris Herbert. Then there's Pompey pair, Steve Cook / Shane Skeates, wrinkly Reading racers Peter Weait / Pete Glazier, Terry Burton / Andy Thomas, andy / Nick Wilkins (the 1970 British champs) and Peter White / Shane Rice. Look out too for Tony Girling / Owen Turnbull. Bob Nash / AN Other (he's a well known passenger), local pair, Adam Daniels / Roger Warren and Euro aces, Wim / Rina Hakkesteeft and Serge Pyck / Remy Lecompt.

Former passenger, turned driver and now a top TV motor sport commentator. That's Barry "Nutters" Nutley. He's having a nostalgic gallop, but his passenger is not yet known. Could it be Murray Walker, Anna Ford, Ruby Wax...?

The solo and sidecar pastmasters will have three outings each on Sunday then one each on Monday, providing they survive Sunday night in the beer tent, but the main interest on Monday will focus on the young guns, who will be racing for real for the Ken Hall trophies and the large crock of prize gold.

Paul Mailin, the British 125 grand prix victor, is my tip to become the 29th Ken Hall solo trophy winner, but Rob Herring would disagree with me. He scored a stunning hat trick last year and needs to regain the winning habit, following his early season injury.

Joakim Karlsson has a great chance of becoming only the third non British Ken Hall trophy winner, after Holland's Gerard Rond and super Swede, Hakan "Carla" Carlqvist.

Mark Eastwood would love to get his name on the trophy, along with that of his father, Vic, who won in 1967. So too would his Skymast team mate, Justin Morris, who needs to justify the faith shown in him by his mentor, the great David Thorpe - and the other Skymast teamster, Carl Nunn has had to wear a "World Champion to be" label, from a very early age. Can he shows us that he has what it takes?

Greg Hanson will be flying, following his extra lappery on Sunday. So too will Nathan Shelton, Ed Bradley, Kelly Swanson, Jimmy Marsh, Chris Warren (mum said I had to mention him), Jason Higgs, Brian Wheeler, Jon Pettitt and Waterlooville's Neil Hewson.

Chris Etheridge has won the Ken Hall sidecar trophy twice, first with Shane Skeates, then with Garry Withers. He and Garry will be out to clinch the hat trick, but they will have to give a performance comparable to that which won them that fabulous 1973 grand prix victory at Langrish. Colin Philpott very nearly won here last year and he and Paul "Boggy" Henderson will be out to go one better this time. Then again, both pairs of aces could be trumped by the very much in form Marton Hagon / Mike Turner - and what about Stuart Brown / David Keane or shooting stars, Peter Clark / Jason Peters?

Look out for comeback pair, Martin Guilford / Mike Philp, also the Welsh Bright boyos, Irish brothers, Maurice / Jeff Walker, Trevor Hollister / John Chambers, upgraded from the support class, and last year's support champions, Kevin Turner / Mark Banks. Then there are the local crews; Waterlooville's Scott Wilkinson / Paul Huntley, Portsmouth's Rob Oldfield / Colin Dunkley, Petersfield's Paul Pelling and his girl friend, Sue Kemp, and Rogate brothers, Andy / Lionel Eastman. All are in with a chance of netting the big one.

And there you have it, folks - an "Ancient and Modern" bank holiday weekend - and all will be described by that ancient man with the mike, John Mould. I reckon there's no commentator to match him. Mind you, young "Nutters" shows promise.
