

#### TODAY'S EVENT

Welcome to Manor Farm, Langrish, for what promises to be one of the best national moto cross meetings of the year. And what a magnificent setting for this great battle deep in the loveliest part of Hampshire. Today's mile-and-a-half long course makes full use of some spectacular terrain, with a formidable uphill drag, and a hair-raising descent making the highest demands on riding skill and courage.

The Waterlooville Club are lucky enough to have a track which will match any on the Continent, and make many in this country envious. For this they are doubly fortunate to have an enthusiastic landowner like Mr. George Lambert allowing the annual use of this circuit. And the entry for today's main events, both solo and sidecar, will see it demonstrated to its full.

Leading the pack for the two thirty minute Ken Hall solo legs is British Champion Graham Noyce. The 20-year-old Maico ace won this event two years ago, and has come hot foot from the last Grand Prix of the season to repeat his success. Also returning from the World Championship trail is John Banks, likely to be his major challenger, on CCM. Another fourstroke favourite is Vic Eastwood, who has also won the coveted Ken Hall Trophy, last time in 1973.

Struggling to make a comeback from injury, Vic Allan could be another man to watch on Husqvarna. But among the promising young riders hoping to make a break alongside the established stars are Geoff Mayes, Rob Hooper, teenager Steven Beamish and Terry Dyer who was tempted out of premature retirement onto the Motorite KTM.

Matching the star studded solo entry is a well-matched sidecar field for the two twenty-minute three-wheeled legs. And it looks like a horsepower battle of the big motors with John Elliott's overbored 920 cc Norton Wasp making fierce current form. Former British champion John Turner, and local lad Bob Spencer look the likeliest contenders, with Doug Fox leading some of the up-and-coming young chairmen. Making an all-too rare appearance is also the massive 1,000 cc Kawasaki-engined outfit of Denmead motor cycle dealer Bob Gollner.

It all adds up to a great programme, and after several years of globe trotting I'm particularly glad to be able to return to the Ken Hall to see it. Especially as I'm now a local lad myself!

## Ken Hall . . .

This is now the 12th annual meeting at Manor Farm, held to honour the memory of the late Ken Hall.

Ken started scrambling in 1950 and because of his determination and absolute dedication it was not long before he was challenging for supremacy in the Southern Centre. By 1954 he had earned a season-long ride on a works Ariel, resulting from a win at the St. Paul's Trophy meeting; an event which is still being run in aid of the Auto-Cycle Union Benevolent Fund.

The next few seasons saw the name Ken Hall heading many result sheets at courses such as Idsworth and Trafalgar Farm. Then while competing at a South Newbury scramble he suffered head injuries which led to serious concussion. In 1965 he was fit and determined to compete again, but this time in 'Grass-track' and it was at a meeting near Salisbury in the summer months when his fatal accident occurred.

Ken lived just across the fields from here in the village of Stroud. His many friends remember him as a cheerful, carefree but determined character and the Waterlooville Motor Cycle Club are extremely proud to be able to look down their list of members since the inception of the Club in 1928 and see the name of KEN HALL.
