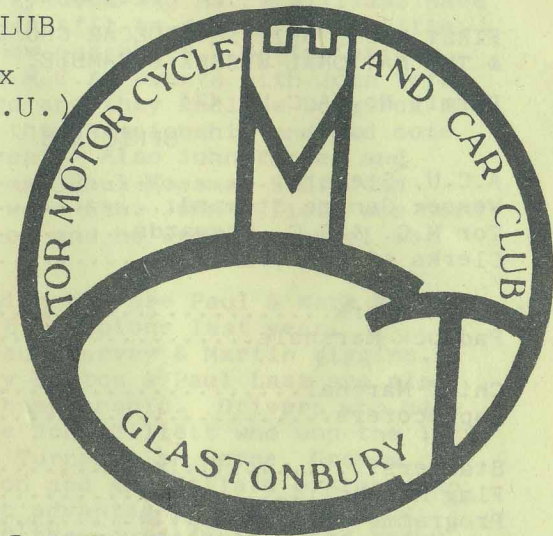

Welcome to Launcherley Hill for the first round of the 1980
British Sidecar Cross Championship.

The 1979 British Champions, Terry Good and Barry Williams have
spent the Winter building a new outfit to defend their title.
Runner-up Nick Thompson has a new passenger. He is Chris
Herbert who rode last year in A.M.C.A. events with John York.
All the top drivers have entered and they include Doug Fox and
John Cooper who were fourth in the championship and had some
really good rides abroad last year. Also John Turner and
Mike Ripper, 3rd. John Elliott and Paul Mossman 5th. John
Roberts and George Skeates who were 6th. John Elliott was born
not all that far from Launcherley and he went to school at
nearby Wells.

Making their debut in the championship are Paul & Mark Millard
from Bath, they were the Support Champions last year.
Barry Nutley & Glen Restricks, Paul Harvey & Martin Wiggins,
Tony Hall & Graham Cooper, Terry Burton & Paul Last are also
riding in their first British Championship. Drivers who have
ridden at Launcherley before are John Elliott who won the 1979
Tor Sidecar Cross meeting, John Turner, Ian Horne, Graham
Stokes, Norman Gale, Terry Burton and the Millard brothers so
these drivers will have a slight advantage. Paul and Mark
with Ian Horne helped to set out the course being used today.
Everything is set for one of the best day's racing in this
area for years so stand well back from the ropes and let the
men get on with it, full bore slides around corners and long
jumps, its all happening out there on the track. Points are
awarded as follows:- 1st. 15 point, 2nd. 12, 3rd. 10,
4th. 8, 5th. 6, 6th. 5, 7th. 4, 8th. 3, 9th. 2, and 10th. 1
point for each race. The Camelot Trophy will be awarded to
the overall winner of the three races, in the event of a tie,
the position in the third race will decide.

RIDING IN THE PADDOCK

It cannot be stressed too strongly that the LIABILITY FOR A SUBSTANTIAL CLAIM COULD REST WITH THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE AND THE DRIVER (OR THE PARENTS IN THE CASE OF A MINOR). The Union's Insurers will quite legitimately repudiate any claim on them for damage arising out of any accident caused by an unauthorised driver.

Spectators are requested to keep off the course. Also the public are requested not to damage the property, cause fires or leave litter. Please put your litter in the bins provided.

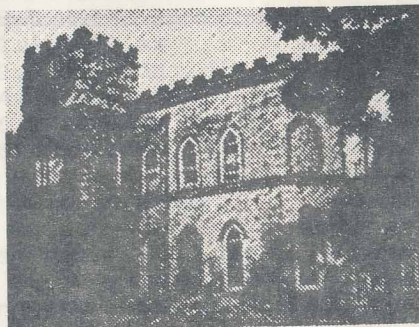
