AMCA NEWS

August 15th 2000

Richard Du'Feu wins the IMBA Round

With a superb demonstration, Richard Du'Feu from West Lancs won the 6th round of the IMBA's European Championship held at Marshfield near Bristol on Sunday. Before the meeting he was 5th and despite the atrocious conditions with rain nearly all day, he won two of the 3 races with a 2nd place in the second race behind the Swiss rider Patrick Kasper, and is now 3rd in the Championship with one round to go in Germany, next month. After a week of hot dry weather, which meant watering before the weekend, the rain started just after practice began and continued till well after the meeting ended.

Championship leader Danny Wauters from Belgium never attempted any heroics on the slippery cambers and announced Saturday night with a lead of over 100 points that he would just ride round, which he did scoring 11 points for the three races. His team mate Serge Van Huffel closed the gap scoring 11 but is still 52 behind, while Noel De Busser who was 3rd only scored 36 and is now 25 points behind Du'Feu.

5 in top 10

With 5 places in the top ten the AMCA riders took full advantage with Simon Gower 5th, Richard Cuff 6th, James Cumber 7th and Gary Parker 9th. Christian Payne blew his bike up in the 2nd race while Martin Beddoes failed to score. Gower is now 10th, Cumber 6th and Cuff 12th, he has missed 3 rounds due to injury but averaged 45 points a meeting for the three he rode.

Protest

After the meeting the Belgium riders complained of 'course cutting' by some of the AMCA riders but this was not upheld and the results stood. With a circuit getting on for two miles in length it was certainly a tricky circuit. Support races for juniors saw very few riders finish on the same lap as the winner.

Marshfield Club

Well done to the club for running under such conditions and a special thanks to Ray Hockey for providing the marquee, very handy on such a day.

Pete Flower thanks all those people who attended to observe this year. There were more than needed. Saturday saw the 63 riders compete over 3 laps of 21 sections while Sunday they rode 4 laps of 20 sections.






