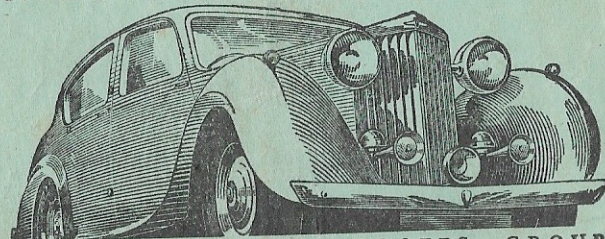

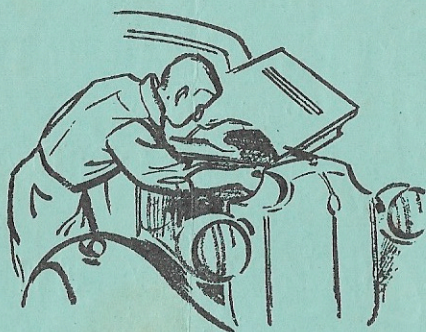

That "C" is the index letter of many villages in Cumberland? Some of them are on the routes of Club Runs and Trials. Cumwhinton often is a centre, but you meet Carleton more often, especially on the way to Croglin or Cumrew; whilst Carlatton Mill and Castle Carrock suggest Corby Hill as link.
