

BRITISH MOTOCROSS CHAMPIONSHIP

Foreword by Paul Owler (Motor Cycle News)

One round down and seven to go! A very warm welcome to Leighton Woods for the second round of the Motor Cycle News British Moto Cross Championships.

Once again the action is centered on the West Country—and if the racing is half as good as we saw at Torquay last month we will all go home today feeling very satisfied.

Graham Noyce has already given us a hint of why he is regarded Britain's best hope of a world 500cc moto cross title for years. The three times British champion took maximum points at Torquay and now heads the table by a full 10 points.

Hot on the 22 year-old Honda works rider's tail is Maico's Neil Hudson, who starts his World 250cc GP bid in Spain next week. Neil's two second places at Higher Rocombe showed that he is certainly capable of taking the title he was so close to winning last year.

Three men are tying with equal points in third spot on the title ladder.

Veteran Scot Vic Allan [Bultaco] is no stranger to the rigours of the British championship which he won last in 1975. He shares third place with Midlander Vaughan Semmens [Maico], who at 27 is in his first year as a professional moto cross rider, and Suzuki's British number one Stephen Beamish.

Next comes Bob Wright who holds fourth place on the strength of a third position in the second leg at the opening round. He leads the all-British CCM squad which boasts the

only four stokes in the competition.

Plenty of young blood courses through the veins of the Motor Cycle News championship with Axbridge farmer Roger Garret [Maico], Suzuki's Jonathan Wright and Maico's Mike Pearce well up in the table along with last year's British Support Series champion Steve Harrison [Maico] and 1978 Under 18 Champion Dave Watson who scorced his first points for Montesa.

KTM's challenge is headed by Dave Tomasik and team-mate Terry Dyer is hoping to be fit after his Higher Rocombe crash which left him with torn ligaments in his knee. Geoff Mayes [Maico], Billy Aldridge [Suzuki], Norman Barrow [CCM], Maico's Mike Stephens, Midlander Roger Harvey and Scot Willy Simpson all notched up points in the first round as well as Pete Mathia who obtained the first scoring result for the Bolton-based Cotton EMY team.

Riders who failed to get their points tally off the ground include Steve Harrison [Maico] who suffered a face injury at the last round, Midlander Rob Hooper [Maico], Cotton EMX man Rob Wilkinson, CCM's Jimmy Aird, and veterans Vic Eastwood [Hagon Yamaha]

and Andy Roberton [Yamaha].

At the conclusion of the series five riders are relegated from the championship and replaced by the top five men from the Support Championship. Leader of the all-important secondary series is welshman Neil Griffiths who nabbed maximum points with two wins and he's followed by former British Schoolboy champion Dave Thorpe, Kawasaki's only works rider in the adult classes.

The two Motor Cycle News British Championship races are each of 40 minutes plus two

laps while the Support series boys race for 30 minutes plus two laps.

Winner of each main championship race gets 30 points with scoring to 15th spot where the rider gets a single point.

Support series points are allocated on the conventional GP basis with 15 for a win down

to one for 10th place.

The scene is set for a memorable day. Enjoy the action.
