

## Foreword ....

Welcome to Asham Woods for the 2nd Round of the 1980 Sidecar-Cross Championship.

After the 1st Round at Launcherley Hill last week, we have the 1979 Champions in the lead with 45 points. John Turner 2nd with 28 points, 3rd Nick Thompson with 24 points, 4th John Roberts 19 points, 5th Doug Fox and Paul Morris both with 16 points.

Local rider Paul and Mark Millard made a good start to their first year with the Grade One Riders by scoring 8 points.

In the Support Championship, we have T. Hedges with 30 points, 2nd I. Horne 18 points, 3rd T. Dane and also A. House with 12 points. P. Wealt and R. Nash both with 8 points, J. Pattison and M. Williams both with 8 points, and P. Johnson with 6 points.

The Top 10 Points Scorer's in the Support Races in the 1st Round, do not have to ride in the heats today.

Championship Points are awarded as follows: 1st - 15 points; 2nd - 12 pts.; 3rd - 10 pts.; 4th - 8 pts.; 5th - 6 pts.; 7th - 4 pts.; 8th - 3 pts.; 9th - 2 pts.; and 10th - 1 point.

The Sidecar Trophy will be awarded to the Best Rider Overall in the Championship Races. In the event of a tie, the Winner in the 1st Leg will be deemed the Winner of this award.

With most of the Top 35 Solo Riders entered for this years event, we can expect some fine racing, and as Graham Noyce (last years winner) is not present today, we shall see a new name added to the list of winners.
