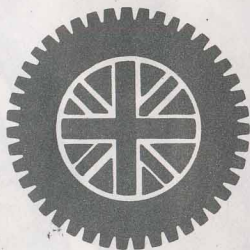

# AMCA news



Entries for AMCA Moto Cross events this year are showing a considerable reduction over previous years with under 4000 entries for the events held in March this year compared with over 8000 in 1991. Whilst the average number of entries per event is about the same at around 140.

No doubt the weather caused some cancellations in March when 24 moto cross meetings were held compared with 52 in 1991 and 50 in 1992 with 35 in '93.

So far this year the average number of late entries is around 30 compared with 22 last year while One Day Licences are averaging 8 which is 2 up on 12 months ago.

## **SIDECARS - CHAMPIONSHIP.**

A revised date for a Sidecars Championship round has been made with the Andover Club now holding the final round at Upavon on October 9th. This will replace the August 7th round originally planned at Boraston. The Upavon track is the same venue used for the International at Easter.

## **RIDERS - PLEASE NOTE.**

A reminder to all moto cross riders that the FLAG SIGNALS likely to be shown around a track during racing or practice must be abided by.

The two main flags are RED - this means riders must stop and cut engines.

The YELLOW flag means riders should slow down and not overtake as there maybe someone injured on the track.

Any rider failing to comply with the flags shown renders himself liable to suspension from the remainder of the meeting, this also includes practice.
