The team official will be Lionel Beck. None of these riders have competed in the 125 AMCA International Championship class this year and this gives an opportunity to other riders to compete abroad.

The final round of the IMBA European Championships takes place in Switzerland at the popular Amriswil circuit in the north and this year the club will be running its 36th International. Interesting to note that support riders have to be present by 6.30am to practice at 7.15am while the sidecar start at 9.45am.
