SWOR CODE OF PRACTICE FOR RACE MARSHALS

Please make sure you sign the insurance form when you collect your flags

Your allocated marshal point should be manned at all times and you should not leave it unless instructed to do so by the Chief Marshal. If you are handing over to another Marshal, ask them if they have signed the insurance form.

Do not allow anyone to stand in the area between the spectator rope/fence, track rope/fence or on the circuit, including riders.
Cameras must not be used while you are on a marshal point.

You will be given 3 flags which are:-

YELLOW FLAG

(Obstruction on track) This flag should be ready at all times during racing. If a rider stops or falls off then the flag should be raised clearly to caution other riders of an obstruction in the track ahead

(Injured rider obstructing track) If a rider falls off and he/she or the bike is laying in the track causing a dangerous obstruction to other riders then the yellow flag should be raised and waved clearly. All riders should slow down and not overtake and should not attempt to clear a jump under any circumstances.
Any rider who overtakes or clears a jump must be reported to the Chief Marshal.



WHITE FLAG WITH RED CROSS

(First Aid required) This flag is to be waved clearly if someone requires First Aid.



BLUE AND WHITE FLAG

(For track maintenance when required) When a section of track needs repair the nearest Marshal must wave the Blue and White flag to attract the attention of the track maintenance crew or commentator so that they can replace the ropes or knock the posts back in.



TRACK CLEAR

At the end of each race if you are happy that there are no riders on your section of track please raise both the Yellow and Red Flags in a cross to indicate to the starter that the next race can begin.

When using the flags above it is important that you display them clearly so that both the riders and track officials can see them.

Qualifying group C - 10 minutes of practice + 10 minutes of qualifying

Racing:

Race 1 - Group 1: 20 minutes + 1 lap

Race 2 - Group 2: 15 minutes + 1 lap

Race 3 - Group 3: 15 minutes + 1 lap

Race 4 - Group 1: 20 minutes + 1 lap

Race 5 - Group 2: 15 minutes + 1 lap

Race 6 - Group 3: 15 minutes + 1 lap

Race 7 - Group 1: 20 minutes + 1 lap

POINT SCORING

1st in each race - 45 points, 2nd - 42 points, 3rd - 40 points, 4th - 38 points, 5th - 36 points, 6th - 35 points, 7th - 34 points, 8th - 33 points, 9th - 32 points, 10th - 31 points etc.

The winning rider in each group is the rider with the highest number of points, any ties will be settled by the result of the last race in each group.

Do not cross whilst a race is in progress.

Spectators are only allowed in designated spectator areas. (A spectator is ANYONE other than a rider competing in the race or race officials).

No spectators should enter Prohibited Areas.

Clubs may allow additional roaming track marshals for the Auto / Junior class, these marshals must sign on and must be identified by wearing a hi-visibility bib, they are to assist all fallen riders.
