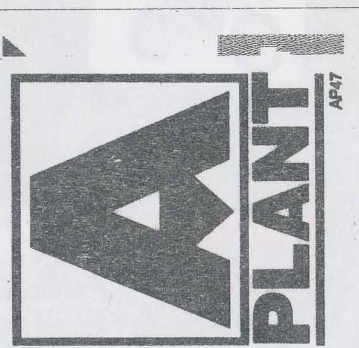

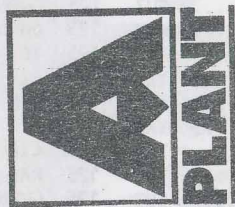

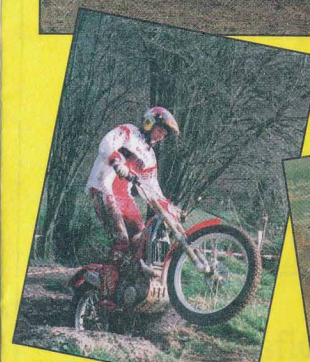

17th May 1999

1st Round of the 125's in Europe

Belgian riders dominated the opening round held at Sint Lenaarts in Northern Belgium with last years champion Noel Steurs winning the overall result. Best of the AMCA riders Simon Lane from Upton who was 6th overall with James Cumber 7th and Paul Willis 8th. Gary Davies finished 10th after two bad races, in the first he was involved in a first bend pile up after having to start from the second row. As it was the first round, only the top ten from last year have the first ten places on the gate, Davies drew the last number. He came through to 13th place and then had his bike seize up on the finish line. In the second race he was forced out when in 5th place due to his plug melting. For the third race he used his spare bike and gained 23 points with a 4th place behind the three top Belgians. James Cumber had two 4th places but crashed out in the 3rd place, was 7th overall. Mark Milward from Staffordshire was 17th after crashing while Paul Cumber was out of luck finishing 25th. A 29 race scheduled with nearly 500 riders competed at this event in Belgium. Next round is on June 6th in France

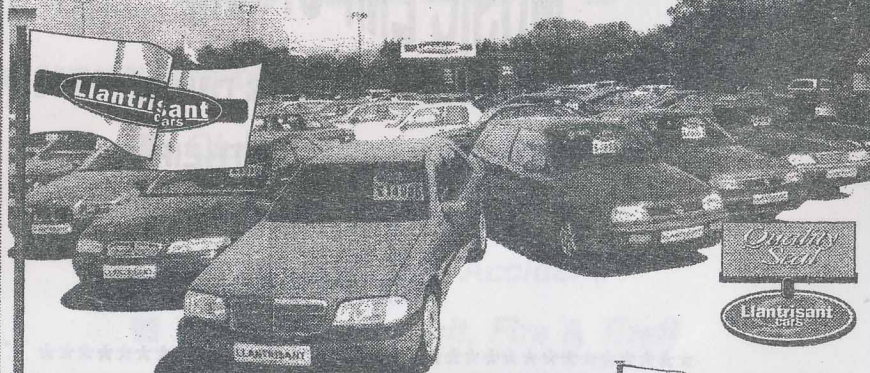

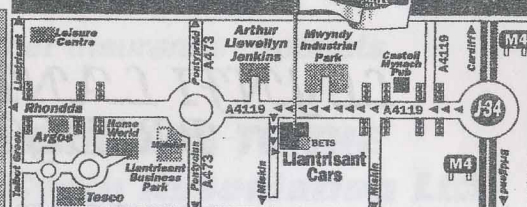

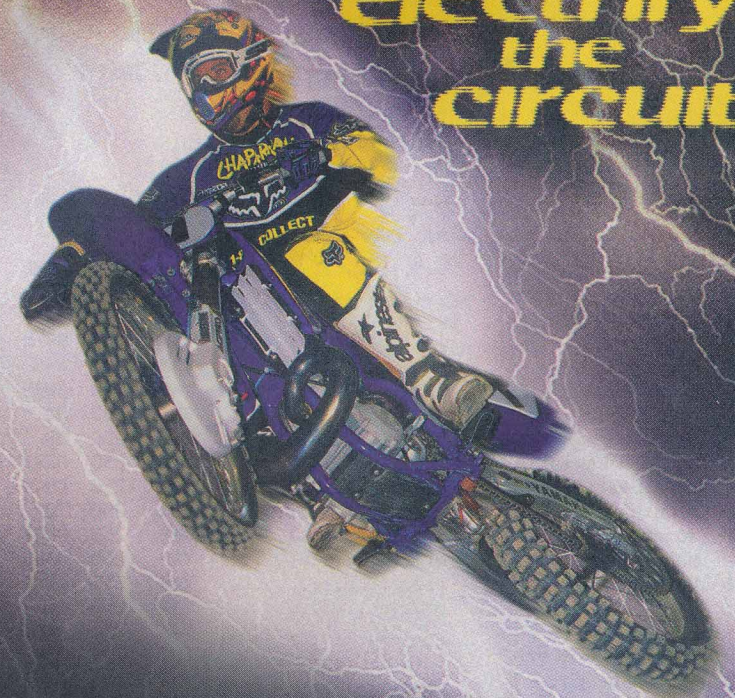
