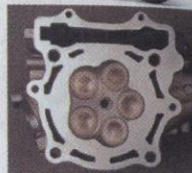

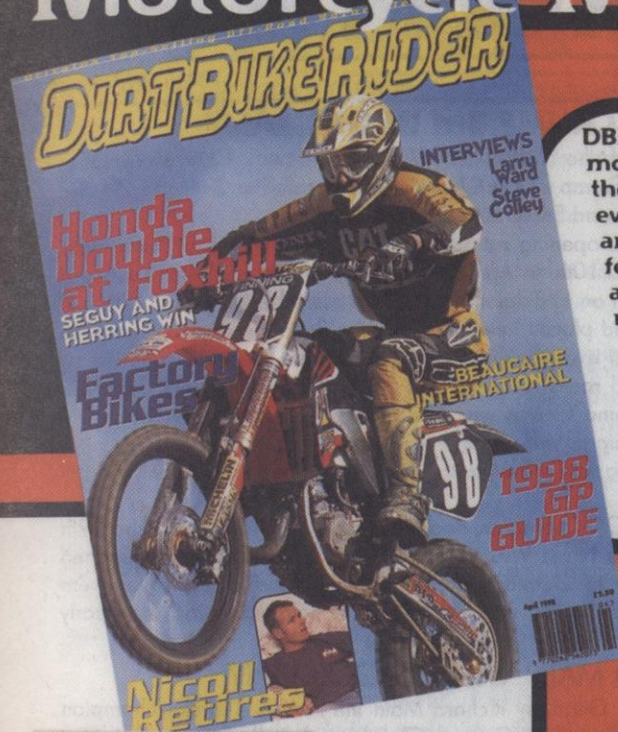

PATRICK CRUMP 3rd IN GERMANY

Riding in the final round of the IMBA's 250/750cc European Championship at Kleinhau on Sunday Patrick Crump of the Clee Hill Club scored a 2nd and 2 - 3rd places to finish 3rd on the day and 5th in the championship.

Patrick has improved since the opening round in Switzerland in March at the famous Wohlen track when he finished 10th. In April he had problems in the Dutch sand and only scored 11 points, he went on to Belgium in July and scored 29 finishing 12th and at Elsworth after 2 brilliant 2nd places failed to finish the 3rd race and in France he took 4th place, winning the 1st race. Belgium riders dominated the series with Danny Waueters winning 14 of the 18 races run, 2nd was Serge van Huffel, Noel de Busser 3rd, and Erwin Buys 4th. Behind Crump was Alex Hartley from the South West who finished 6th in the championship as well as 6th in Germany.

Gary Parker from Preston riding with a broken tow took 8th place and who finished 8th in the championship.

Andy Watkins the 750cc AMCA Champion declined to go to Germany finished 9th while Aaron Crowder from the North West took 10th spot in Germany and finished 13th. Only 4 riders travelled to Germany as Richard Cuff and Barry Holley were injured, Brett Henson declined having only ridden in the Belgium round after early season injuries.

RICHARD MAIN WINS IN GERMANY

Riding in the support races in Germany Richard Main the AMCA 4 stroke champion won both races and as a member of the German Club he marshalled all day Saturday before riding Sunday. Lionel Beck travelled with Main and reported the event at Kleinhau, which did not attract the usual big crowd, this may have been due to the Luxembourg car Grand Prix being run nearby also the German elections were also held on Sunday.

ROSSENDALE CLUB PROBLEMS

Despite all the precautions taken by the club Rossendale still have noise problems with the local council. Each event the club build a wall of straw bales and only use the track three times a year but complaints still arise from one nearby resident.

DOGS AT MEETINGS

Two clubs have asked to mention the problems they are having with dogs at events. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES, farmers are complaining about dogs worrying sheep.

CONCERN OVER AMCA IMBA SELECTIONS

With nine different riders used in the 125 and the 250/750cc IMBA European Championships with each series run over 6 rounds, questions will be asked about the selection process. While some riders are unable to complete due to injury such as Richard De'Feu who rode in the Elsworth and French rounds then broke his collar bone others are dropping out for no reason.

Consideration may have to be given to riders who do not complete the series when selection for next years championship comes round.

WINTER EVENTS

Two events scheduled so far: Uley Club on November 15th at Nympsfield and the Annual Weymouth Beach Race on October 25th run by the Purbeck Club who invite any AMCA riders to compete. Riders are asked to sign the entry sheets now at clubs, entry fees are £18 'A' licences and £23 for 'B'. Separate races for Juniors, Seniors and Experts with up to 100 in a race.

CANCELLED EVENTS

North Wilts have cancelled their event on October 25th. Bristol Spartans at Yarley and Calderdale at Charlie Pitts have cancelled 1st November 1998 and Ross Falcons will not be running their scheduled event on 22nd November.

RAY TONKS

A big turn out of friends including many riders from the West Midlands Group attended the funeral of the Cannock rider Ray Tonks last Thursday (24th September). Ray died after an accident at work on September 15th, he first joined the AMCA in 1982 and was a regular rider this season.
