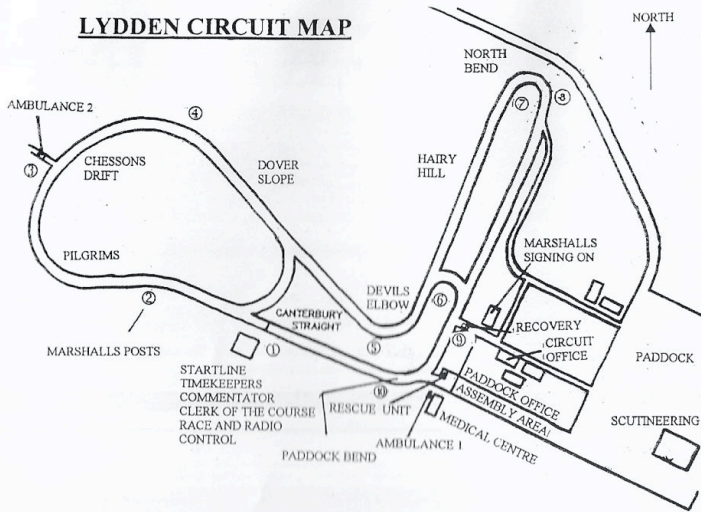


LYDDEN CIRCUIT MAP

Welcome to Lydden for Round Six of the Historic Racing Season. We start off by welcoming the Velocette Owners Club who joins us here each year as well as sponsoring the meeting. They bring along our European competitors as well and will hold their championship races here with us today.

We had a superb meeting at Darley Moor near Ashbourne, Derbys just two weeks ago the weather was fantastic and the riders were most entertaining. I wish someone would tell these riders that they are supposed to stay on the tarmac to race and not the gravel traps, as someone found out to his cost twice in the same day. We nearly had a "Plonker of the Meeting" when a rider went out for his practice session, then went out and had his race and only just crossed the finish line before..... Wait for it.....Yes, RAN OUT OF FUEL, well at least he finished the race instead of being picked up off the track!!

The number of meetings left for us to run is getting lower but here we are with two day's worth of championship points to achieve and here was how they were looking upto the round at Darley and how they are looking at the start of this meeting. In the Tuers Garage Championship we had Ian Bain, No. 190 being chased by No. 51 Toby Smedley who had a cracking day at Darley winning every event he went out in. He will have closed the gap nicely there. The Hart McLeod Championship for the 250cc machines saw No.65 Stu Noble take the chequered flag and increase his lead over No.197 Tim Johnson who was unable to get to the meeting, so Tim will be going all out this weekend to catch up on some points I shouldn't wonder. The Jim Lidgate Memorial Championship will see No.154 Stu Tonge and No. 2 Lee Moore try and close the gap between them and No.12 Steven Radakovic whose regular sparring partner Martin Page won't be there to battle against, unless he enters late that is!

The Old Bike Mart Championship (better known as OBM to most) sees No. 190 Ian Bain out front with Graham Buller (No. 195) hot on his heels, or should I say rear tyres, but with Toby Smedley doing so well at Darley he may be closer in the points than he was. The ICS Championship or Integrated Control Solutions if you can get your tongue round it, should see Graham Buller leading it now as he had a better day than No.89 Ogle Dixon so Ogle will be out to outwit him today and gain some points back. G B Motor Company who sponsor the 351-500cc class will see the return of No.1 Doug Jones who has been absent for a couple of meetings and has still managed to retain his lead over the up and coming youngster, Lee Moore.

The TemPer Recruitment Services Championship (a new name to add to the list of sponsors and we welcome them aboard and hope they enjoy what remains of the season) has No.40 Nigel Waring battling his Dresda against No.77 Cliff Ransley on his Velocette Venom and there are only a few points separating the two of them now. The Bennett & Associates over 500cc Specials Championship sees Cliff Ransley at the top leading from Nigel Waring and John Greenwood, who will be commenting for us this weekend instead of riding.

The Langham Engineering Championship may have seen a change in the standings as the team of Steve Harpham and Daniel Toone had two very good races two weeks ago and will have added points and may have gone into the lead, but Len Diggins/Aston Everett and Nick Weston/Kerry Williams are both back to put some screaming tyre marks on the track as they battle against one another again.

In the Three Wheelers Unlimited Championship despite Bill Tuer taking to the gravel he may still have the edge on the points from fellow teamsters Greg Bibby/Debbie Bain. But with the two championships running together this weekend there will be more machines out there and not enough tarmac, well I suppose it's one way for the circuit to get it's grass mown isn't it!!

The Bantams Championship of M.A.N Flying Systems saw No.142 Pete Tibbits and No.62 Keith Woods right up on each others rear tyres as they nipped round each bend and down the straights, and with Lydden being all bends and not many straights it will test their riding ability and they will have the added extra contender of the very fast Mark Carkeek who currently holds the club lap record here for this event, which he gained in 1997, will anyone else beat it this year or will he knock a tenth or two off himself?

The Norvil Novice Championship will see a mass of Orange bibs fight from the back to the front of this handicap race for the chequered flag, No. 177 Martin Owen still on top slot with Ogle Dixon only 4 points short of him.

The two premier events of the day are the Fujitsu Computers Solo Champion of Champions which saw Lee Moore take the chequered flag at Darley with two seconds to spare from No. 5 Stacey Killworth which now puts Lee at the top of the championship. Will it be Lee who has the number one plate next season who knows! In the Richard Adams Photography Sidecar and Three Wheeler Champion of Champions we still see No.1 Bill Tuer and Maggie Tuer at the top with Greg Bibby and Debbie Bain close on his back wheel.

We hope that you enjoy this weekend and look forward to you joining us in September at the twisty circuit of Three Sisters near Wigan for another weekend of battles as the season draws nearer to a close
