FLAG SIGNALS

Competitors are reminded of the meaning of the Flags used by the Flag Marshals :-

Union Jack—Start **Red**—Stop immediately

Yellow (Waved)—Great danger ; prepare to stop

Yellow (Motionless)—Take care ; danger

Blue (Waved)—Another competitor is trying to overtake

Blue (Motionless)—Another competitor is following you closely

Yellow (with Vertical Red Stripes)—Oil on the Course

White—An ambulance or service car on the circuit

Black (with driver's number)—Driver with that number must stop

Black and White Chequered—Signal for End of Race

SPECIAL NOTICE—A car that does not stop when the Red or Black Flag is shown will render the driver of that car liable to a fine of £5
