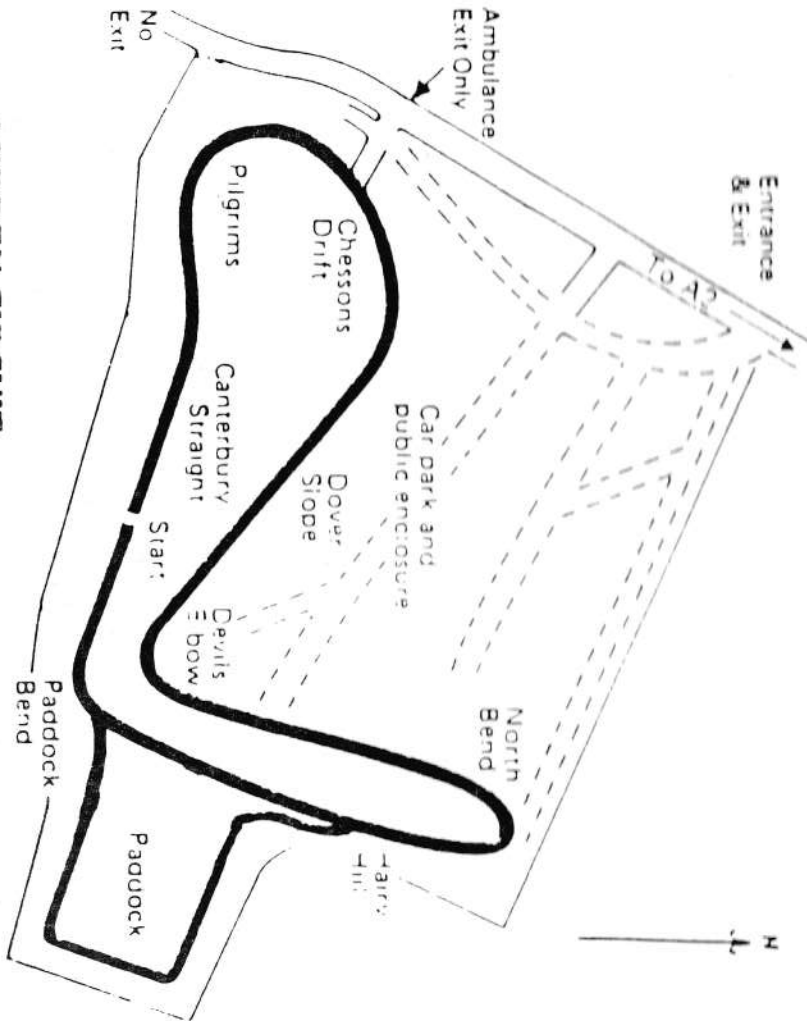

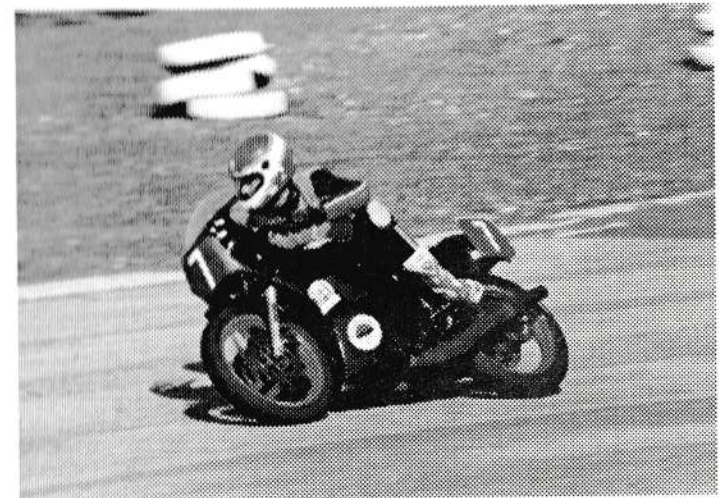

FLAG SIGNALS

NATIONAL FLAG (lowered) or **GREEN SIGNAL LIGHT**; **START**.
RED; When shown at Marshals Points around the circuit all competitors must immediately cease racing, and return with extreme caution to the **START/FINISH**, unless instructed otherwise by Marshals or Officials.
YELLOW; (Motionless) Signal of **DANGER**.
YELLOW; (Waved) Slow down, **DO NOT OVERTAKE**, be prepared to **STOP**.
BLACK WITH DRIVERS NUMBER; Informs the driver of the motorcycle bearing that number, that he must stop at his pit on the next lap.
RED WITH YELLOW STRIPES; Deterioration of adhesion on track surface.
GREEN; Course Clear.
WHITE; Slow moving intervention vehicle on track, ride with caution.
CHEQUERED FLAG; Race Finish.

SPECTATOR NOTICES

Please do not leave litter about the grounds, place in receptacles provided, or take home with you, remember one piece of litter could be **FATAL**.
Please drive with care and consideration for others when leaving the circuit, this is a race track the road outside is not.

OUR 94 SEASON AND ON

Well past the mid way point with only today, a meeting and the re scheduled 24th September, now being run on October 9th, remaining in our 94 Club Championships, plus The Lord of Lydden, on October 2nd, and our final motorcycle meeting The Sidecar Burn up on October 23rd, both of these meetings are open to club riders, but are not Championship Points meetings, there is some prize money on both.

It has been a hard year, more so than normal, as we now have to manage a Circuit as well as promote our own meetings, we quite often wonder if we will get things done in time, but with our small band of helpers and a 28 hour clock we have managed so far and hope to continue to do so, at the end of the bike season when you can start thinking of rebuilds for next year, and what class you are going to compete in, we carry on with Rallycross through to the end of January, then start a major clean up in time for next seasons circuit racing.

If any of you have any spare time during your close season we would welcome a hand, that way we get the work done much quicker, and you can feel proud of the fact that you have had a part in the improvements, you dont have to be a master builder or engineer, we can find jobs for everyone, yes even the ladies can hold a paint brush, or better still make the tea.

We would welcome some input as to what classes you would like us to run in 95, in the last programme I set out the ground rules for our Championships asking for comments, to date we have recieved none, so can only assume you are happy with the proposals, if not please let me know, why not chat to Dave Stewart your riders rep to see what changes if any are feasible, dont forget they are your Championships and we want you to have a say how they operate.

We intend to completely re furbish the paddock toilets in an effort to make things more comfortable for everyone, we trust that it will be appreciated and kept in a clean and tidy condition, just remember it is your club funds that are being used, if we have to keep repairing damage it only raises your fees.

We also have our annual Dinner Dance and presentaion of awards in November, we are getting more enquiries than usual so it would appear to be shutters up much earlier than usual, dont leave it too late to book, we are taking deposits now to avoid disappointment, even if you have not won an award come along and give those a cheer that have done, there are some special awards which no one apart from myself and the engraver knows the identity of until the night, who knows it could be you.

The Championships so far.

With only 2 rounds of our Championships still to go the places are starting to hot up, we have actually got 3 Classes tied up, In the Lydden Solo Championship Mark Whiting cannot be beaten, but behind him all is still to fight for with only 1 point seperating Ivan Hildige and Ian Oatridge, The Lydden Sidecar has Tony Chilcott 36 points clear of "Old Tart" Jeff Matthews, who is only 3 points clear of Andy Dingsdale.

The Overall BEMSEE Championship is headed by Steve Gridley 36 points clear of Trev Stafford, with Andy MacDonald a further 9 points adrift.

Moving on to the BEMSEE CLASS CHAMPIONSHIPS John Ansell cannot be beaten in the 125, Newcomer Matt Taylor is 50 points behind, with Rob Keys a further 21 points back. The Unlimited Singles has gone the way of Trev Stafford on 172 points, a mere 75 ahead of 2nd placed David Walker, who will have to keep at it as Paul Stonebanks is on a charge only 6 points behind, The 250 Singles are led by Craig Millward who is 35 points in front of his friend and mentor Nick Bourne, Rob hunt has started to pile on the points with 92 giving him 3rd place.

The 250 LC is led by Darren Mowat 26 points in front of Matt Baker, with Andy Nichols 3rd on 77, The 350 LCs are led by Andy MacDonald on 129, with 2nd placed Mark Lawes on 104, only 9 point behind is Paul Reeves. The TZR is now led by Craig Millward who only started in the class mid season and has gradually chipped away at Richard Lee, now being 4 points in front, in third is Ian "Bertie" Bassett a mere 41 points adrift.

Steve Lee is leading the Formula Junior by 38 points from Tim Mathias, with our keenest Lady rider Sonjah Parsons in 3rd, she will have to keep pegging away as Mick Fincham and Desperate Dan Harris are only a few points behind, Steve Gridley leads the Formula Senior followed by the other 2 Steves, Goodyear and Bedingfield in that order.

The Open Solo sees Mark whiting in charge on 108 points, followed by Ivan Hildige 31 points adrift, Dave Stewart is 3rd, he might have been higher if he had not swapped classes mid term.

The closest fought solo class is the MZs where Mark Penford leads Dave Higgins by just 2 points, with Tony Calton only a further 6 points behind.

The real fly in the ointment is those riders who have not yet used their Double Points Option, unfortunately I have not got the list to hand of those that have been used, as Tracey keeps the points, so there could well be more than three series that are sown up, if the second and third placed runners have already used their Double Points.

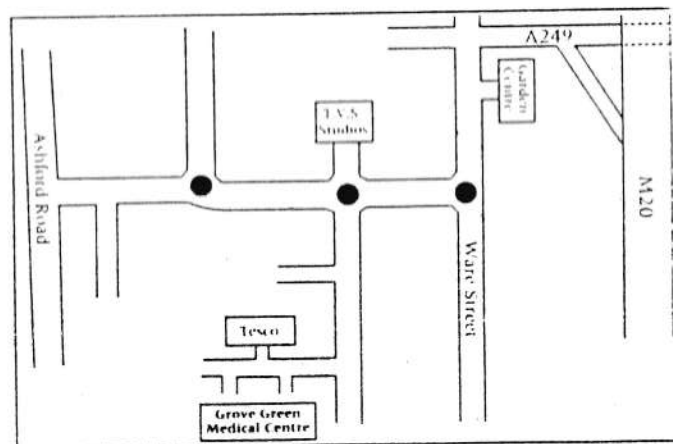

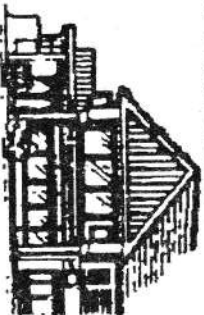
