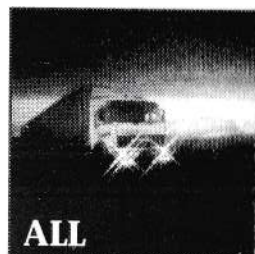

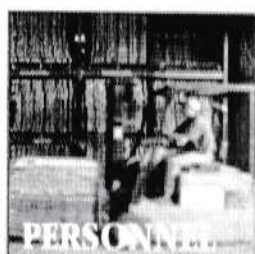

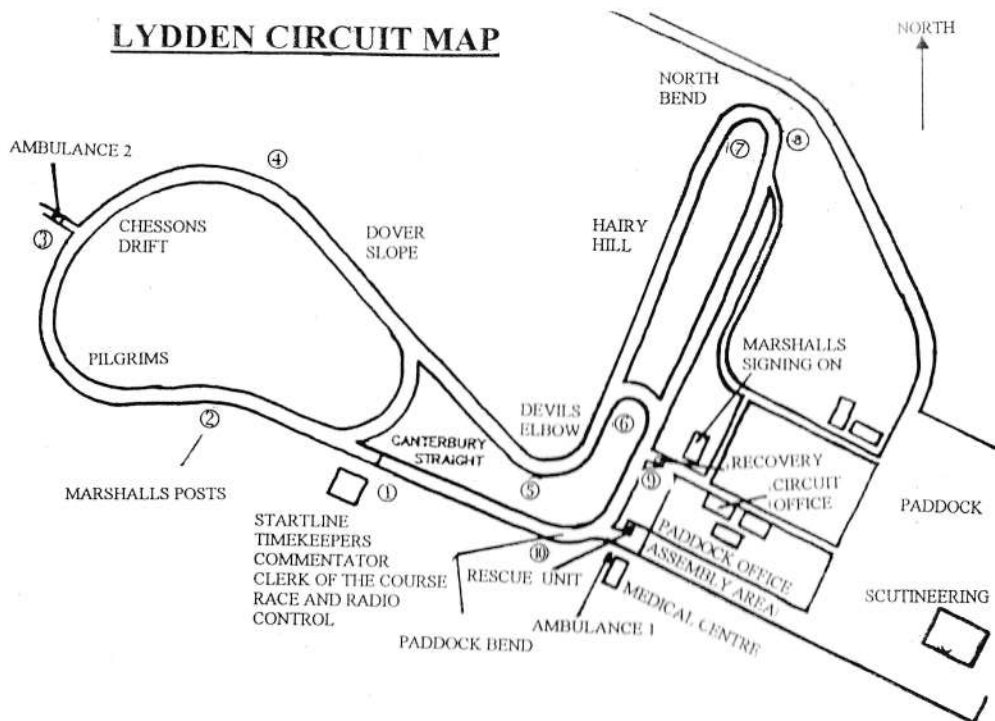

LYDDEN HILL - ROUND 5

Welcome back to the lovely Kent circuit of Lydden and round five of the VMCC Historic Racing Championships. We welcome back the Velocette Owners Club who are again our sponsors for this meeting. Richard Adams' welcome will give you full details. There will be a get together around Richard's 'van' after racing that will include an awards presentation and a barbeque, everyone is welcome.

Mike Powell extended his existing championship lead at our last meeting at Cadwell, in the M.A.N. Flying Systems race for Formula Bantams. Martin and Michael Nash De Villiers will be looking to get some good results to try to close the gap on No. 33 Mike on his 1971 Bantam. With two days racing and luck and skill anything may be possible.

No.30 Mick Hunter is at the top of the table in the Drury Precision Sheet Merta 350cc Championship, and with Phil Jobborn not taking part this weekend hopefully Mick will be able to take increase the difference significantly.

In the Ossie Neal Championship for Sidecars Mo. 10 Werner Eckel and Tim Johnson just have the edge over No. 31 Nick Weston and Kerry Williams. No. 50 Andy and Yvonne Hunt are out there this weekend to join in the battle. In the Consort Championship for three-wheelers newcomers Derek and Lee Rand are holding the top of the table with Graham Alcock and Paul Emmerson having to chase and work their way through the pack to try and gain back some vital points. The Janic Antiques championship sponsored by the team of Nick Saunders and Kay Green see none other than Bill and Maggie Tuer at the top who have a 30 point lead over Nick Weston and Kerry Williams, but nothing is in the bag as we have seen so many times before, no championship is decided until the last race of the day at the last meeting of the season.

Bennett Associates Championship (Event 5) leader Mark Capewell now has a strong lead over his competitors but Phil Wade and Mike Kemp will be working hard to gain vital points. In the Old Bike Mart championship Ian Bain and Toby Smedley battle their way for the title and there is only 7 points between them at the moment.

In the GB Motor Company championship Tim Johnson holds a 3 point lead over Phil Jobborn but as I mentioned earlier Phil is not competing this weekend so he will miss out on some very important points this weekend. Event 1 the Tuers Garage championship sees Toby Smedley and Ian Bain battling again but Mervyn Stratford will be there to out manoeuvre one or both of them.

In the 250cc championship Mervyn Stratford is just 2 points behind championship leader Stu Noble so this will be an interesting race to watch with four sets of points up for grabs.

We now move on to the specials classes, these events are for machines that don't fit into any other event and are separated by their engine capacities. In the upto 500 class sponsored by Dresda Autos, Martin Page has a fair lead over Mike Schofield both of whom are not taking part this weekend, but will John Bown and Len Homer be able to close the gap that they have on the two absentees. In the Big Shot over 500 championship Grahm Williams will be there to try and increase his current 22 point lead over John Butcher but will he succeed, stick around and watch.

We were unable to run the Pertemp Recruitment Partnership Solo Champion of Champions race at Cadwell in July due to an oil spillage so there was no change of leaders there, Mike Powell will be able to start the race on Sunday knowing that second place man Phil Jobborn will be nowhere to be seen but he will have to watch out for Tim Johnson who is lying third at the moment.

The Norton Owners Club and the Velocette Owners club both sponsor season long championships and races are ran at two day events and this is how the championships stand at the moment. In the Norton Championship No. 130 Mark Capewell has just 1 point over Phil Jobborn who is in second and only 10 points between him and third, fourth and fifth place. In the Velocette Championship Tim Johnson is at the top and Richard Adams and Terence Anderton are fighting for second and third place.

Last but by no means least The Norvil Motorcycle Co. Novice championship sees No.41 William Free with a 9 point lead over No. 54 Charles Jeanes but will the handicap be to their advantage or not as they will both start somewhere near the back of the grid and have to plough their way through to the front to take the chequered flag.

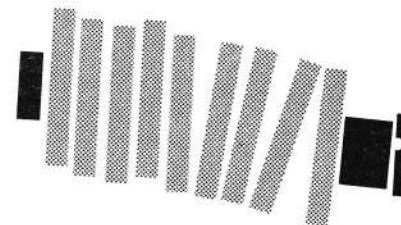

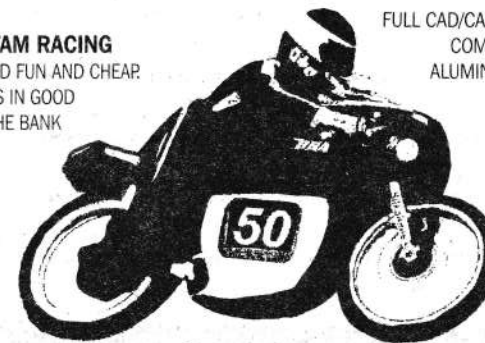

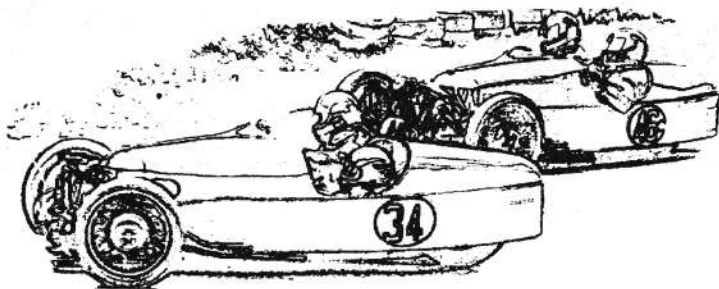
