


Flag Signals

Blue/Steady: Another competitor is close
Blue/Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass.
White: Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down. Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow

down, be prepared to stop.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Slippery surface ahead.

Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals; (at startline and individual marshals posts) race stopped.

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechnical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits immediately.

Black/White rectangular with White number: Warning to driver that his behaviour (i.e. corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

Black display with White number: Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

Yellow/Black Quartered Flag: On passing the flag at the Start/Finish line, the race leader must slow down significantly (to around 50mph maximum) until the obstruction on the track is clear.

Black/White Chequered: End of race.

Races are started using a system of red/green traffic lights.

as four of the series here face twin bouts this afternoon. Saloon type cars feature strongly in the package. However, the remarkable Formula Hondas have grabbed two race slots to uphold Single Seater honours.

A Lydden Hill favourite, the VSR's are back. A direct descendant of the old Eurocar series, the VSR6 championship is here for Round 4, whilst the mighty VSR8's battle it out for on-the-day Trophy honours.

In the VSR6 series, expect a real head-to-head battle for supremacy

between Mike Doble and Steve Dance. Doble has suffered in early rounds with un-reliability, but the Caterham based motorcycle dealer certainly has the pace, and should the car allow, he'll be door-to-door with Dance throughout today's encounters. Last time out at Oulton Park, the pair, plus Rick Lemmon, were inseparable throughout the race, and as they crossed the line to take the flag the result was declared a draw. Now that's close!

These three are certain to reacquaint themselves today, and rumour has it that the threesome could very well be a foursome as Shaun Richardson closes in.

Lest we forget the local lad... Robert Bridger from Tonbridge is back for today's action, and he may just have a

> thing or two to say at the front as well!

In the VSR8 Trophy series. Miku Santavirta and Kevin Clarke arrive at Lydden Hill this weekend with eyes set very much on victory. They've clashed at the last couple of rounds, with less than favourable outcomes, and to post a hat-trick of offs could just be asking too much from their respective teams.

The certainty is that they will be very close again today, and perhaps with scores settled at the last two encounters they'll get on with the job of racing. Then again...

If the VSR's are at one end of the spectrum, then the BRSCC's T-Cars are at the other. This fantastic 'youth development' Championship fired up at Castle Combe last month, with Ryan Lewis and Tom Chilton dominating proceedings.

Chilton started both races from pole and won round two at a canter, while Lewis just held on to win in round one despite Chilton's spirited attempts to relieve him of victory.

Having just turned 17, Lewis is the oldest driver in the field today - none of

Watch out for 15-year-old Phil Rose; the experience he gained in T-Cars last year brought him a brace of third-place finishes at Combe, and there's the potential for better things to come.

Ben Reeves, along with Lewis and Chilton the most experienced here. didn't fare as well as he had hoped last time out and will be keen to make amends.

Others in action today include Tom Shrimpton, Andrew Gray, Jonathan Cocker, Jonathan Kennard, Adam Sharpe, Matthew Wilson (son of former British Rally Champion Malcolm) and the UK's youngest licensed female circuit racer, Lydia Austen.

Continuing in the Saloon frame, the BRSCC/SEMSEC Sports & Saloons are back again for their third visit of the season.

At the end of April the series visited

Brands, where Rod Birley, in his awesome Honda Prelude, clinched victory from Hailsham's Mike Roberts in his Jade. The race also saw John Oxborrow fighting it out at the front in his self designed and built Ox-7. Almost legendary for his Formula Ford exploits, let's hope the BRSCC/ SEMSEC series can tempt John to

the fold on a more regular basis.

Visiting today for their sole Lydden outing in 2001, the MGCC Anglia Phoenix Championship is here for Round 4 of this year's 13 race Championship, which is open to any model of MG. The series is divided into 4 classes for modified, semi-modified and standard road-going MGs, with a separate class for Metros.

Expect to see a battle royal between the Metro Turbo's of Jason Burgess. Tony Howe and Dick Trevitt as they snap at each other's heels over 14 laps of this challenging corner of Kent. There's also certain to be titanic scraps between the Class C runners.


Whilst on the subject of titanic, the Formula Honda's are here for two Rounds today, and they're as big as it gets when it comes to thrilling Single Seater action. These little 600cc 'Slicks and Wings' racers are capable of hitting a mighty impressive 130mph!

Today sees the fourth round of the Championship in which Mark Gallatly holds a slender four point lead over Andy Roberts. Gallatly has been on the podium at all three races to date, taking the top step at Cadwell Park in April. Roberts endured a slower start to the season, managing only a fifth place finish in round one, before finding form and the podium at both Cadwell Park and Snetterton.

Look out too for young Alex Buncombe – Son of 70's Touring Car Star Jonathan, who has jumped up the points table to third after a scintillating drive at Snetterton. He spent much of the race harrying Gallatly, and in the dash for the flag he snatched victory on the line to claim a well-earned victory and 12 points.
