

Welcome to Lydden for what is the penultimate date on British Historic Racing's 2007 calendar. This weekend we have a mammoth 46 race programme that includes all of our regular solo and threewheeler club championship classes plus two additional Bantam events - The Fred Launchbury and Shuttleworth Challenge races - and also our British Scooter Sport Organisation friends who we can always rely upon for a spectacular show. As always we thank our dedicated officials, marshals and sponsors, without whom these meetings simply couldn't take place.

Set in an attractive natural amphitheatre, Lydden is unequalled as a spectating venue and is a real "riders circuit" in that its numerous twists and turns and lack of a long straight mean that riding/driving ability is often more important than horsepower. I have particularly fond memories of this place as I grew up in North West Kent and it was Brands Hatch and Lydden where I used to watch all my racing in the late 1960's and early 70's. One of its great charms is that it has barely changed in those 40 years, although the one major difference is a good one; I refer of course to the paddock w.c. and shower block that was put up in fairly recent times. Some of you will remember its predecessor - a rusting, corrugated iron shed, in latter years held down by guy ropes, that you never wanted to spend more time inside than necessary in case you encountered one of its numerous animal or insect residents! There's no doubt that the facilities at most of the longer established circuits are unrecognisable these days compared to even 15 years ago, and it's nice to know that the hugely increased circuit fees that clubs now have to pay are being at least partially ploughed back into improved comforts and safety features (chicanes not included!). Cadwell Park is a good example of that - I bet many of you can recall that solitary little toilet block and burger bar of yesteryear, and nowadays there are excellent toilets, showers, bar and restaurant (not to mention the eardrum-shattering new paddock PA system!).

These facilities were no doubt much appreciated by all and sundry two weeks ago when our 2007 weather curse struck again, although at least on this occasion the really heavy rain only affected the last hour or so of the programme and we were able to run all the races except the Champion of Champion events. The marshals and start line officials did a fantastic job in the horrible conditions and there were some heroic performances too by the competitors on both two and three wheels. Whatever they may say, I doubt whether any riders/drivers would genuinely actually choose to race in the wet rather than the dry but you always get those few who seem to be completely unfazed by it. At Cadwell it was lan Bain, Rob Walker and Ian Henshaw who particularly caught my eye in this respect and I wonder whether it's no coincidence that they all reside in the wetter parts of the UK!

As promised in my last programme notes I'm not going to make any pleas or predictions regarding the weather, but I reckon that rain or shine we're in for a great weekend of close, competitive racing, particularly with the position at the top of many of the championship tables being so close.
