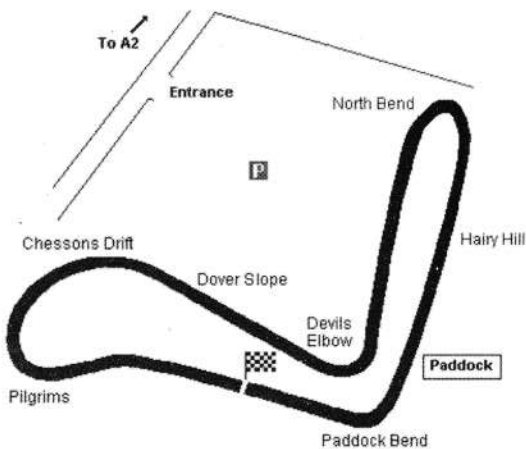

## RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS

Welcome to Lydden for the fourth date on the VMCC British Historic Racing's 2006 calendar. We have a bumper entry that again includes our British Scooter Sport Association friends who put on such a splendid show at Pembrey. As always we thank our dedicated officials, marshals and sponsors, without whom these meetings simply couldn't take place. Special thanks go to the Velocette Owners Club and Steelcraft Design & Fabrication for their continued and much appreciated support. This weekend's meeting is dedicated to the hugely popular solo and sidecar competitor Tim Johnson, who lost his life in last year's Manx Grand Prix, and there is also a trophy being presented to the winner of Saturday's Unlimited race in memory of another former VMCC stalwart, Keith Nicholls. Both are greatly missed.

Set in a beautiful natural amphitheatre, Lydden is unequalled as a spectator's circuit and this weekend we have a mammoth 44 race programme that includes all of our regular club championship classes plus two additional Bantam events - The Fred Launchbury and Shuttleworth Challenge races - and two races that are generously supported by the Velocette Owners Club - the Arthur Lavington event for Velocettes and the ever-popular and always hard fought BSA/Velocette Challenge. Additionally, Sunday's Solo Champion of Champions round is being run as the Race of the South, thanks to the efforts of Steelcraft's Stuart Noble and Andy Hunt, who have revived this once premier series (see separate feature). Andy and Stuart are also involved in the organisation of Saturday evening's paddock barbeque, to which all competitors, marshals, officials, sponsors, partners and support crews are cordially invited.

One of the reasons why Vintage Motor Cycle Club racing has recently been re-branded as "British Historic Racing" is to shake off any lingering reputation that it might have had for being slow and sedate. Newcomers are always amazed at just how fast and furious our racing is and having personally watched every race this season I can honestly say that things are getting ever more hectic! The thing about competitive spirit is that it doesn't fade with the years, and if you ever wanted proof of that just watch Saturday's Over-50's race in which I guarantee you'll see an absolutely flat out battle throughout the field. If our last round at Pembrey is anything to go by, Tim Jackson (AJS 7R) and Stuart Tonge (500 Manx Norton) will be at or near the front but there are several others who are also likely to be in the frame. Road racing thrives on such rivalries and let's face it, we've got plenty of those this season! Another example featuring Stuart is with Austen Kear in the 1949-62 500cc solos - Austen was the club's leading novice in 2005 and at the last couple of rounds has been involved in some pretty hectic races with wily veteran Stuart.

Father and son John and Joe Butcher are another duo who have been enjoying a close rivalry this season. At Pembrey Joe led his father in all four Unlimited races, only for John to eventually clinch all four wins, with Ben Graham also well in the mix. Joe also features in the three-wheeler classes as ballast to Dave Aungier, where they will be continuing their regular dices with championship leaders Lenny Pallister and Ian Marriner.

These are just a few of the battles to look out for in what will undoubtedly prove to be a great showcase of Historic racing.

VMCC Historic Racing competitor, Keith Nicholls was killed in a freak low speed motorcycle accident on 6 November 2002. He was 41. Enthusiasts will remember Leics based Keith's unlimited class duels with the late Doug Jones and, later with Graham Buller. Keith's development of his Thunderbird plus his superb riding ability made a formidable combination. Often, by the end of the season there was no more than one point difference in the championship, one year the final scores were equal and Keith shared the trophy with Vincent mounted Graham.

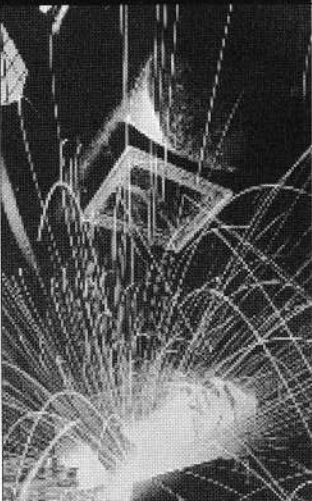
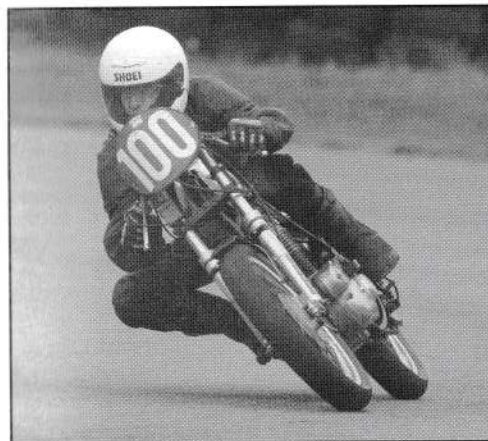
