FLAG SIGNALS

Blue/ Steady: Another competitor is close. Blue/ Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass. White: Service vehicle or very slow moving car on

circuit.

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop.

Yellow with Red stripes: Slippery surface ahead. Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also shown at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions.

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately.

Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number: Warning to driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged.

Black displayed with White number: Driver must return immediately to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course.

Black and White Chequered: End of race. National Flag: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

Ready To Rumble At Lydden

THE SOUTH EASTERN Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club welcomes you to Lydden Circuit for a packed programme of 12 races.

The sound of rumbling V8 saloons will herald the start of the first race for Southern Saloons and Sportscars. Rallycross ace John Cross will be making his 2004 Lydden debut in a brand new 6.0 Mercedes CLK which is similar to the one raced by fellow VSR driver, Paul Sheard.

The VSR Jaguar S Type which Cross previously raced has been taken over by former Stock Hatch champion, Greg Rose. All three are likely to be front-runners in the two races, but with Kris Waite's Sapphire-Cosworth, a Caterham R400 and a wide variety of TVR models as well - who knows?

If the rumbling V8s are likely to excite just look at the entry for the Centre's Track and Race Cars Saloon Championship.

We are more than half way through the year but this is only the second time this popular championship has graced its home track at Lydden.

Enhanced local sponsorship from Track and Race Cars Magazine and Chris Knott Insurance has had a major impact on grids. The championship has already featured at Lydden, but has also visited Silverstone and Snetterton. Later in the year it will be an invited race at Mallory Park and Brands Hatch. The first Brands race will be next week alongside the European Endurance Racing Club activities.

We normally expect Rod Birley in his WRC Escort to take the race win, but that is not the key to Championship honours with bonus points on offer for beating others in class.

After just winning the 2003 title Rod has missed out on a couple of occasions this year and out front at the moment is Class D runner lason Watkins in his Ford Fiesta.

Not only can Jason normally be relied on to win his class, but you can expect him to be mixing it with the bigger classes pushing the little Fiesta to the limit.

West Kingsdown's Birley should enjoy a thrilling battle with Chris Randall's M5 BMW and we should see an interesting contrast between the various Toyo series cars which take on the Sapphire-Cosworths of circuit regulars Kris Waite and former Young England speedway star, Steve Weatherley.

Leading the guest championships on the agenda is the Toyo Tyres Modified Production Saloon series which could give us a great David and Goliath battle between Nick Williamson's Class C Peugeot and the more powerful Class A cars of Chris Randall, Mark Taylor and Neil Philpotts.

And we should see more good racing in the other guest events, the MaX5 series for the popular MX5 Mazda sports cars, the Manugistics TVR CC Tasmin Challenge Cup and two races for the close-fought Citroen 2CV Enduro Cup.

Six of the new Team ERA classic-style single seaters will be joining the usual Formula Ford and Clubmans cars in the BARC SEC Single Seater Series.

The meeting ends with a round of the BARC SEC 2CV Challenge which completes a hattrick of races for the deux chevaux Citroens which never fail to provide thrilling entertainment as they screech, slither and scrape their way around the Lydden track.

You can't afford to miss a moment of it - so build up those bladder muscles!



The Best Of Racing History

On December 12 1912 a group of cyclecar enthusiasts gathered at the Hut Hotel, Wisley, in Surrey to compare notes on their machines.

Cyclecars (virtually four-wheeled powered cycles) provided the real enthusiasts motoring of those days, and the group decided there and then to form the Cyclecar Club.

The Hut Hotel was demolished in 1978 to make way for the old Portsmouth Road improvements, but the little acorns sown that day sprang into the mighty oak that is today's British Automobile Racing Club.

The Cycle Car Club was soon to become the Junior Car Club, racing at Brooklands and elsewhere in Britain, organising

foreign tours and generally looking after the interests of the enthusiast. Brooklands was to play a big part in the BARC's childhood and adolescence, as the JCC was destined to merge with the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club to become the modern day British Automobile Racing Club.

The BARC's past is mile-stoned with all the great races at Brooklands, Donington, the Goodwood Formula One and Formula Two meetings, the British Grand Prix at Aintree and Crystal Palace.

Brooklands was its first home, Goodwood its second and, since 1968, Thruxton its third. Housed in its headquarters at Thruxton the BARC now oversees race meetings at all the

major circuits in the country and now runs the majority of the rounds of the British Touring Car Championship. The club also officiates at the highly-successful Goodwood Festival of Speed and the Goodwood Revival Race meetings.

In addition national race meetings are run throughout the country alongside sprint and

hill climb championships in the hands of the successful network of local centres.

In 1955 the original South Eastern Centre was formed. Over the years a number of developments took place culminating in the formation in 1977 of the highly-successful London and Home Counties Centre.



Recent years have seen the Centre spread its geographic area of activities and the Centre has now reverted to the name South Eastern Centre to better reflect this.

This year the Centre will organise race meetings at Lydden and Silverstone and Sprints at Goodwood and Silverstone.

These meetings will feature rounds of the Centre-organised Track and Race Cars Saloon Championship; Southern Saloon and Sports Car Series; BARC SEC Single Seater Series; Circuit Driver Speed Championship alongside many of the National BARC Racing Championships.
