



Ben first got involved in the sport of motorcycle racing at our French meeting at Croix en Ternois in 1994. He slotted in to the friendly atmosphere of the singles class immediately and was to become a regular at Bemsee meetings. Although he never raced himself he was a keen motorcyclist and had a Yamaha FZR250 for road use.

Ben worked as a care worker with mentally ill patients and was therefore not the richest young man in the paddock. This did not stop him from being open handed and generous towards his friends. Lawrence Barry told me a story regarding this that I would like to share with you. "It was at Pembrey in South Wales last year and two of our bikes were giving us some severe grief. one had an intermittant electrical fault and the other an equally frustrating fuel starvation problem. It was roasting in our awning and the sweat was running off all of us. Now Ben was at a bit of a loose end ('cos no one likes to let another man give his race bike a good kicking when it needs it!) So he slipped off towards the ice cream van. When he returned he had bought ice creams for everyone which helped cool our frustrations and was much appreciated by all. It was only much later when the dust had settled that we found out he had used his last tenner to cool us (much wealthier friends) down, leaving himself skint for the week!"

I have heard several similar stories from the other singles lads but that particular tale stuck in my mind.

Ben was not an angel but he was one of those rare people who's company it was always easy to be in, someone you would invariably choose to have around. He was good humoured and quick to lend a hand when needed. His mum, Judy and his dad, Chris would like him to be remembered the way he was, happy in his home life and full of enthusiasm at the racetrack.

So when you watch race 19 today, imagine Ben standing at your shoulder cheering on his friends, many of whom have made a special effort to be here today to honour him.



- 3. Glen Biggs Honda 600 mounted Glen is blisteringly fast when he stays aboard and has had 8 wins this year at Lydden clocking a best lap time of 43.80 secs back in April.
- 13. Kevin Richards Kevin is now 50 years old but is still one of the best club riders around, this ex-Champion of Brands is always good to watch but will sadly probably be outgunned today on his ageing TZ350.
- **29.** Dave Cohen Another Honda 600 mounted rider, Dave has had just 3 wins here at Lydden this year but he does race against the specialist open class racers. Daves best time this year is 43.56 secs.
- 31. Gareth Piggott Gareth has not won here at Lydden this year but the last two meetings have seen him come into his best vein of form ever .Gareth took a maiden win on his Fireblade at Brands. Look out!
- **36.** Tony Sear Tony is one of the best up and coming riders around and on his day he can beat anyone. Tony has clocked a best time of 44.27 secs this year but that belies his undoubted ability.
- **40. Shane Byrne** Shane is another very talented rider destined for better things. He has had four 600 superstock wins this year and is the 600 lap record holder at 43.68 secs. One of many possible winners.
