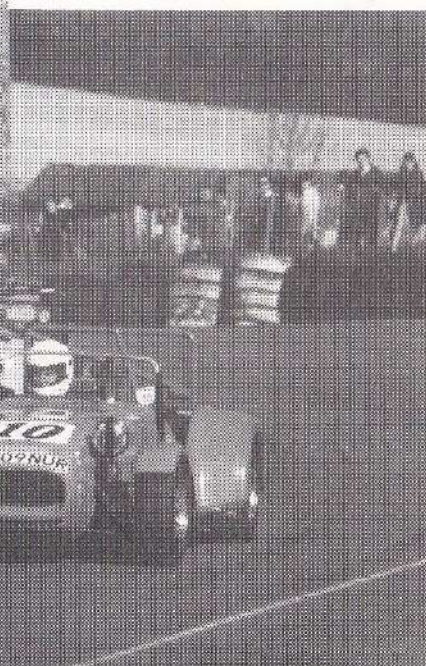

Dogs are allowed in the Circuit Grounds, but they must be kept securely on a lead, they are not allowed in the Paddock Area.



SPECTATOR NOTICES

Prohibited Area Notice: The public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed. The fences are there for protection, and any persons found trespassing, or wilfully damaging trees, shrubs, fences, etc., will be prosecuted by Lydden Circuit Ltd.

Litter: Please do not leave litter about the ground, place in the bins provided, or take it with you. This is a Race Track, the roads outside are not. Please drive with caution when leaving the grounds, giving consideration to other road users and pedestrians.

Animals: Whilst we do not encourage visitors to bring animals to the grounds, we must insist that if they do they be kept on a short leash, at no time are they to be taken in to the competitor's paddock area.

FLAG SIGNALS

RED: This is shown at the start and at marshals posts around the circuit, to indicate the race has been stopped. (only authorised by the Clerk of the Course). All vehicles must cease racing and proceed slowly to the pits or return to the startline as instructed to do so by the marshals or officials.

YELLOW: (motionless) Danger ahead, NO overtaking, slow down.

YELLOW: (waved) Great danger ahead, NO overtaking, SLOW down, be prepared to STOP.

GREEN: Course Clear, used at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been displayed, to indicate that the course ahead is now clear.

YELLOW with RED stripes: Lack of adhesion, used to indicate that liquid or a slippery substance is present on the surface in that section. This will be displayed until the hazard has been dealt with.

WHITE: service or slow moving course vehicle on course.

BLACK: This will be shown at the startline, together with a board indicating the competitor's racing number. The driver carrying that number MUST return immediately to the paddock.

BLACK FLAG with ORANGE disc displayed with WHITE number: A warning of apparent mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. The car concerned must call at its pit for repairs on the next lap.

BLACK and WHITE chequered: Denotes the race has finished, this is usually waved at the winner and held motionless until all other competitors have passed.

NATIONAL FLAG: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

CLASSIC ENTERTAINMENT AT LYDDEN

The London and Home Counties Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club extends a warm welcome to competitors, officials and spectators for its second race meeting of the season at Lydden. We can only hope that today's meeting proves as successful as our Spring Bank Holiday race and recent rallycross events at the circuit.

This season our regular Lydden championship events have rounds at SEMSEC meetings as well, and so for today we have injected some variety by adding extra races for three BARC Classic Saloon Car Club championships and Westfield Sports Cars.

As its name implies the CSCC was founded to cater for classic saloons such as Morris Minors and Austin A40s which formed the backbone of early touring car racing in the late 50s. The top three drivers in the current championship, Reg Salway, Simon Kemp and Alan Boyce will be renewing their rivalry once again. But these days the more modern Historics and Post-Historics are more plentiful and provide close and exciting racing. Watch out for the spectacular Lotus Cortinas as they three-wheel through the corners in their efforts to stay ahead of the Jaguars and Andy Gill's Ford Mustang. Nigel Garrett's Dolomite Sprint currently leads the Post-Historic series and he will be turning out again in the Group 1 event to take on a collection of Capris.

There will be two championship races for the hard-charging Westfield drivers who regularly push their mounts way over the limit of adhesion. Carl Webster, Steve Newey, Anthony Wilds and Nic Grindrod all starred in the previous round at Pembrey, but with an over-subscribed entry there will be plenty more scrapping for supremacy here today.

Newington nurseman Julian Sage gives his Formula Renault Alpa a rare outing in the Single-seater event, when he will meet Richard Carrison (in the ex-Derek Pullman Elden) and Trevor Williams, who drives his self-built AJK. This race will be run in conjunction with the BARC FF1600 and RESB single seater championship rounds which features regular such as Dave Connor, Matt Hayes, Dennis O'Sullivan and Chris Glazier.

The current Lydden Saloon champion, Neil Bostock is back to defend his title in the AstraTech-backed series, although there is a strong bid for overall honours as well as the class championship from Barry Andrews, the former FF2000 champion who now races a car donated by SEAT UK. And Julian Belcher's

very capable mechanic Len Whitehead will be giving the Group 1 Rover another gallop. As entries are still arriving for this event at the time of going to press no-one is too sure how it will pan out.

The programme will be completed with invitation events for Saloons and Westfields, and so drivers and spectators alike should get ample value for money today!

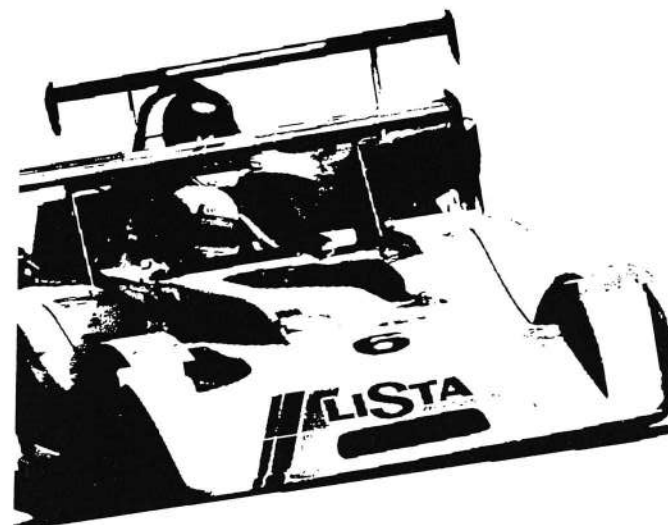
