FLAG SIGNALS

- Blue/ Steady:** Another competitor is close.
- Blue/Waved:** Another competitor is trying to pass.
- White:** Service vehicle or very slow moving car on circuit.
- Yellow/Steady:** Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.
- Yellow/Waved:** Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop.
- Yellow with Red stripes:** Slippery surface ahead.
- Green:** Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also shown at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions.
- Red:** Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.
- Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number:** Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately.
- Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number:** Warning to driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged.
- Black displayed with White number:** Driver must return immediately to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course.
- Black and White Chequered:** End of race.
- National Flag:** This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

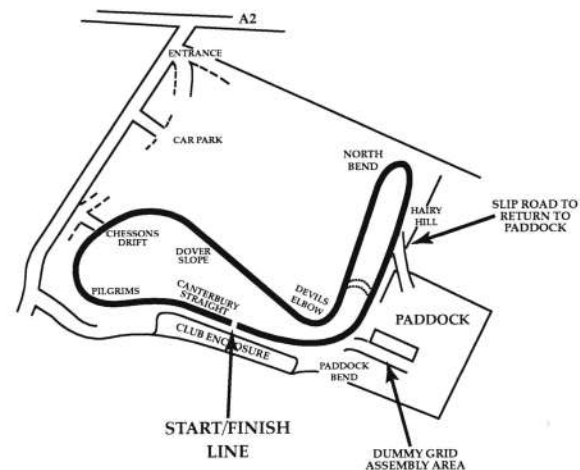

PETITION TO KEEP RACING AT LYDDEN

The owners of Lydden Circuit, TAG-McLaren, plan to build a factory and test-track here for the new Mercedes sports car - probably during 2002. At a recent planning committee meeting of Dover District Council it was agreed that racing at Lydden must cease as soon as development begins.

At the British Grand Prix last month Ron Dennis and Martin Whitmarsh of McLaren assured me that they would like to see racing continue at Lydden, but because of complaints about noise from a few local residents they had been obliged to agree to the terms set by Dover District Council.

I have started a petition to show the level of

support for motorsport here. If you have not already signed it you should find a form in the paddock office. If you feel as strongly as I do you may even be prepared to write a short letter, addressed to the Director of Planning, Dover District Council. If you send it to me at the address below I will ensure that they are all delivered, together with the signatures.

Caterhams Graduate at Lydden

Welcome to Lydden Circuit for the first race meeting of the season to be organised by the South Eastern Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club.

Two races for the burgeoning Caterham Graduate series and a round of the BARC Modified Production and BRSCC Super Road Saloon Championship will add extra spice to a programme of seven races to be run here today.

The Caterham Graduate drivers are all up-and-coming chargers keen to progress and so the series has a reputation for hard, close racing with spectacular action. Because there is such a healthy entry we will have to run two races - so everybody gets a chance to catch a slice of the action.

The Toyo Tyres Modified Production and Super Road Saloons are rare visitors to Lydden so they like to make the most of the opportunity to race on this tight, twisting and undulating track. Chris Randall is a former winner here, so see how his BMW copes with the bellowing V8 Rov-ers of Gerry Cain and Robin Woodger.

Herne Bay's Barry Andrews, a former Lydden FF2000 champion is aiming for another title this year when he takes part in the two AstraTech Single Seater Championship events. The strongest opposition

to his Formula Renault Orion, which is spectacularly sprayed in the same colours as the Jordan F1 team cars, is likely to come from the Jedi of John Lord. Gillingham's Chris Glazier, a former Lydden Formula Ford champion, will be taking part in the FF1600 category.

In the two races for the Formula One Racewear Saloon Car championship West Kingsdown's Rod Birley will be back to defend his title against strong opposition which includes Londoner Alex Thorogood, Maidstone's Alex Sidwell and Ashford's Craig Dawson. Former Silhouette champion, Bill Richards from the Romney Marsh has acquired a Mini Cooper so that he can take part in this event as well.

The second of the Formula One Racewear Saloon races is combined with the Lydden Mini Challenge introduced this year by the BARC SEC. At the time of writing the entry for the challenge was still a bit sparse, so let's hope it picks up in time to give us yet another good race.

It has been a long, wet winter. Rallycross and other off-road events are good entertainment, but now it's time for some circuit racing. Watch for the green light and let battle commence!
