

## LIST AND EXPLANATORY NOTES CONCERNING EVENTS

**Event 1**—This is the Final of a series of three meetings to establish the Lydden Solo Champion for National Licence holders. Each rider will ride three times, with their best two rides counting in determining the best 16 riders to go forward to the semi-finals.

**Event 2**—This is the Final in a series of three meetings to establish the Lydden Sidecar Speedtrack Champion for National Licence holders. Each driver will race three times with the best two rides counting in determining the best 8 riders to go forward to the Final.

**Event 3**—This is an Invitation International Solo Scratch Race. Each rider will race three times with their best two rides to count in determining the best 6 riders to go forward to the Final.

**Event 4**—This is an Invitation International Sidecar Race to be run over 3 legs of 4 laps each. Each leg to count in determining the result.

**Event 5**—This is an Invitation event for selected International riders, to establish a flying lap record. Selected riders will start individually from the Paddock area and complete one flying lap after crossing the start and finish line.

**Points scoring Method**—In all race heats, points will be awarded to the winner and placemen in the following ratio:- 1st-6pts, 2nd-4pts, 3rd-3pts, 4th-2pts, 5th-1pt. In the case of a tie on points gained in Events 1 and 2 the rider with the highest single ride will take precedence, if still a tie persists the riders positions in the uncounted leg will determine the matter.

In the case of a tie on points gained in Event 3 the rider with the higher single ride will take precedence. If still a tie persists the riders positions in the third leg will determine the matter. In the case of a tie in Event 4 the position in the latter leg will determine the matter.

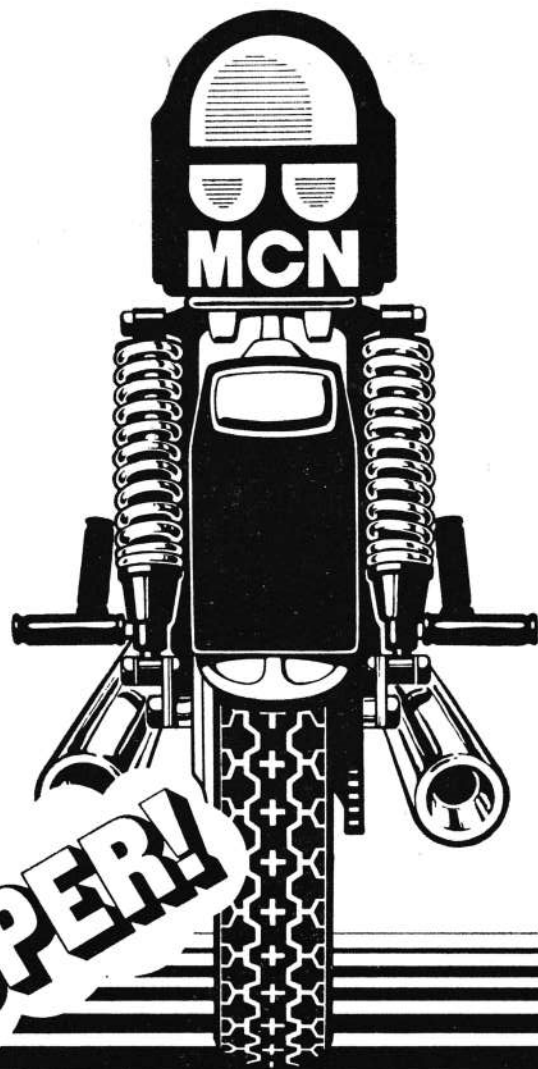

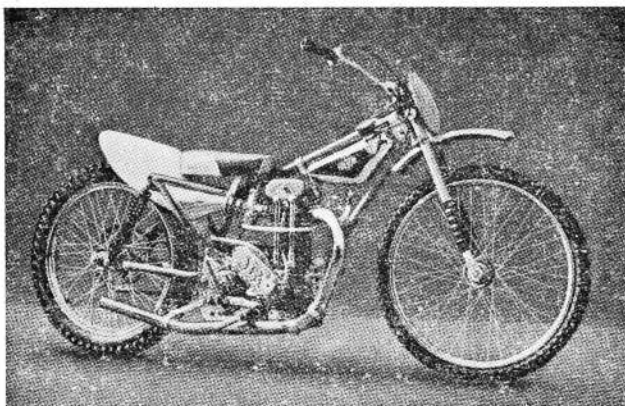
