FLAG SIGNALS

Blue/ Steady: Another competitor is close.
Blue/ Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass.
White: Service vehicle or very slow moving car on

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow

Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop.

Yellow with Red stripes: Slippery surface ahead. Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also shown at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions.

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately.

Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number: Warning to driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged.

Black displayed with White number: Driver must return immediately to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course.

Black and White Chequered: End of race.

National Flag: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

AUGUST BANK HOLIDAY RALLYCROSS RETURNS TO LYDDEN

AFTER the spectacular Easter event at Lydden Rallycross returns to the circuit on August Bank Holiday Monday.

At the Easter Monday meeting, Tony Bell hit the headlines - and a very solid bank which launched his Toyota Corolla into a series of somersaults pictured below.

Bell's dramatic exit came at the climax of the meeting, the Supercar Final. After a bad start the Durham driver was making ground rapidly in his efforts to gain a place on the rostrum.

But on the penultimate lap, as he accelerated out of North Bend with a reputed 640 horse-power under his right foot, he lost control and slewed onto the verge. The Toyota careered down Hairy Hill on the grass, launched itself high into the air off a protective earth bank and then landed in the middle of the track with a sickening crunch. There was a brief flicker of flame from the engine compartment, but mercifully the fire never took hold.



Marshals were quickly on the scene to rescue the trapped driver, who was still conscious. He was given oxygen while the car was cut away from around him. Then he was removed to hospital and fortunately, was allowed to leave later that evening with nothing worse than severe bruising.

Rivalries Renewed

A warm welcome to Lydden, which is surely the friendliest track with the best viewing, for the third race meeting of the season to be staged by the London and Home Counties Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club.

We are especially pleased to have another opportunity to enjoy the ultra-competitive racing in two series which are guaranteed to add spice to the events today, the Kent County Formula Ford Championship and the Andyspares/Firestone 2CV Championship.

Last time out at Lydden the Kent series made the most of its double-header format, when honours were shared between

Australian Brett Francis and local expert Dave Connor.


We also saw evidence of the increasing rivalry between these two as each driver was forced onto the grass by the other, although in each case they managed to gather it all to-

gether and continue racing.

In the first race the current Lydden champion, Chris Glazier led impressively for a while and in the second there was a tremendous five-car battle for the lead which also included Matt and Keith Wood and the promising Jason Down. So let's hope today's round will be just as exciting. In the 1800 Zetec category it was Mark Langfield and Neale Blunden who made all the running, although Dave Hardisty carried out a couple of stunning

overtakes to move in on the leaders.

We also saw a fine example of the kind of sportsmanship often seen at Lydden - after problems during practice Jamun drivers Blunden and local hero Matt Hayes took turns to share the same throttle body. So far it is Francis, who drives for Peter Alexander's Folkestone-based PA Motorsport squad, who leads the series overall.

At the time of writing it seems likely that the Zetecs will run with the Single Seater series so that all the Kent drivers have a chance to race.

The struggle for supremacy will be just as fraught in the national championship for the Andyspares/Firestone 2CV Citroen series. The little French cars have become firm favourites at Lydden as they lurch through the corners side by side with the chassis juddering and the tyres squealing.

The first of the regular Lydden championship events is the F1 Racewear Saloon Series. West Kingsdown's Rod Birley will be keen to extend his advantage over Ashford's Craig Dawson, especially since the Peugeot driver missed the last round here.

The former hot-rod and Thunder Saloon racer will also be taking part in the Lydden Silhouette Saloon Championship, when he will face strong opposition from former champion, Bill Richards and the ever-

improving Mark Burton. The Silhouette event is combined with the Lydden Sports Car Championship round, so it will be interesting to see how the self-built OX 7 prototype of Seaford's John Oxborrow compares with the sports cars of championship contenders John Lord and Maidstone's John Dewing. But remember that Mike Roberts' Radical has shown a tremendous turn of speed here.

Matt Hayes and Dave Hardisty will be looking for further success in the two Single Seater races which include an Open Wheel Invitation race. And with a Closed Wheel Invitation event as well there should be plenty of entertainment for everyone.

SMART CAR PRESENTATION

The BARC (L&HCC) is offering a prize of £50 to the driver of the "best presented car" at each of its Lydden race meetings this year as an incentive to make cars look even smarter.

The decision will be made by a panel of judges consisting of the Chief Scrutineer, the Commentator and a Centre official.

The winner of the award at the Centre's last meeting in June was Doug Anderson, from Dumfries, driving his MSR Motorsport Peugeot 205.



Some 86 years ago - on December 12 1912 to be precise - a group of cyclecar enthusiasts gathered at the Hut Hotel, Wisley, in Surrey to compare notes on their machines.

Cyclecars (virtually four-wheeled powered cycles) provided the real enthusiasts motoring of those days, and the group decided there and then to form the Cyclecar Club.

The Hut Hotel was demolished in 1978 to make way for the old Portsmouth Road improvements, but the little acorns sown that day sprang into the mighty oak that is today's British Automobile Racing Club. And last year it was the club's proud boast that it organised more events of International Status than any other in the world.

The Cycle Car Club was soon to become the Junior Car Club, racing at Brooklands and elsewhere in Britain, organising foreign tours and generally looking after the interests of the enthusiast. Brooklands was to play a big part in the BARC's childhood and adolescence, as the JCC was

destined to merge with the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club to become the modern day British Automobile Racing Club.

The BARC's past is mile-stoned with all the great races at Brooklands, Donington, the Goodwood Formula One and Formula Two meetings, the British Grand Prix at Aintree and Crystal Palace.

Brooklands was its first home, Goodwood

its second and, since 1968, Thruxton its third.

Housed in its headquarters at Thruxton the BARC now oversees race meetings at all the major circuits in the country and now oversees 18 of the 24 rounds of the British Touring Car Championship. The club officiates at the highly-successful Goodwood Festival of Speed and the

Goodwood Revival meeting.

In addition national race meetings are run throughout the country alongside sprint and hill climb championships in the hands of the successful network of local centres, including the London and Home Counties Centre.

THE Club - THE Centre

As one of the largest Centres in Britain's biggest and brightest motor club, the London and Home Counties Centre is truly a club within an club.


In 1955 the South Eastern Centre was formed, to be followed three years later by the Surrey Centre founded as the Leatherhead Group which became the North Thames Centre in 1962. These all amalgamated in 1977 to form the now highly-successful London and Home Counties Centre.

January 1st 2000 will see the Centre revert to the name South Eastern Centre to better reflect its area of activities. The London and Home Counties name

will continue through this year, while new marketing material is introduced ready for the change in the new Millennium.

This year the Centre will organise three race meetings at Lydden Circuit and co-promote a finals day with the South East Motor Sports Enthusiasts Club at the circuit in October; co-promote three rallycross events at Lydden Circuit, organise two sprint meetings at Goodwood Circuit; it has already co-promoted a sprint meeting with Sevenoaks and District MC at Lydden Circuit and organised a championship sprint and race meeting at Silverstone's Stowe Circuit.
