FLAG SIGNALS

RED: This is shown at the start and at marshals posts around the cicuit, to indicate the race has been stopped, (only authorised by the Clerk of the Course). All vehicles must cease racing and proceed slowly to the pits or return to the startline as instructed to do so by the marshals or officials.

YELLOW: (motionless) Danger ahead, NO overtaking, slow down.

YELLOW: (waved) Great danger ahead, NO overtaking, SLOW down, be prepared to STOP.

GREEN: Course Clear, used at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been displayed, to indicate that the course ahead is now clear.

YELLOW with RED stripes: Lack of adhesion, used to indicate that liquid or a slippery substance is present on the surface in that section. This will be displayed until the hazard has been dealt with.

WHITE: service or slow moving course vehicle on course.

BLACK: This will be shown at the startline, together with a board indicating the competitor's racing number. The driver carrying that number MUST return immediately to the paddock.

BLACK FLAG with ORANGE disc displayed with WHITE number: A warning of apparent mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. The car concerned must call at its pit for repairs on the next lap.

BLACK and WHITE chequered: Denotes the race has finished, this is usually waved at the winner and held motionless until all other competitors have passed.

NATIONAL FLAG: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

MINIWORLD MANIA

First of all, on behalf of the London and Home Counties Centre of the British Automobile Racing Club I would like to welcome you all to Lydden for the third meeting of the season to be organised by the Centre.

The highlight of today's meeting is the MiniWorld Trophy race, when Minis of all kinds will be competing for an annual prize put up by the Mini World Magazine. The fastest cars in action will probably be Mark Chandler's specially prepared 1430cc Swiftune Mini and Nick Swift's 1460cc Classic Championship-winning example which compete in the Kent Automotive Developments Special Saloon class. Nick is a former ISC Classic Touring Car champion and his father, Glyn is the founder of the Swiftune concern, as well as being a regular winner in Minis a few years ago.

There should be some close racing in the 1400cc Modified category, where Helmut Kulhavy is bringing his 1275GT over from Germany to race against Paul Hardman and circuit specialist, Chris Judge, who has already won the MiniWorld Trophy twice. But the Mini Miglia class should be the best of all as it traditionally produces epic, door-to-door battles at Lydden. David Abbott could be a good bet at this class as he has already won the MiniWorld Trophy once before, although Gerald Dale was always in the leading group and often a winner.

And with Bev Comber lured from retirement after an absence of nine years to compete in the Road Going class and the opportunity to see Mini Sevens in action in the Osborne Automotive Preparations category as well, there should be plenty of excitement in this event.

The Kent County Formula Ford Championship continues to produce some of the best single seater races. Folkestone's Peter Alexander currently leads the 1800cc Zetec class, although Neale Blunden and Ian Smythe will be keen to stop the local driver from taking another victory. A series of pole positions, fastest laps and victories have put Mark Langfield on top in the 1600cc Kent class, although with Matt Hayes, Dave Conner and several other up-and-coming drivers to beat he cannot expect an easy win.

There is a strong local entry in the Lydden Saloon Car Championship where consistent winner Rod Birley (West Kingsdown) will meet his regular rival, Craig Dawson (Ashford), as well as Alan Feaver (Rochester), Chris Judge (New Ash Green) and Steve Govett (Sittingbourne) among others. Birley's already successful efforts have been given a fresh impetus with the arrival of a new sponsor, Speedtrap UK, so it is difficult to see anyone beating the former Thundersaloon champion, even though he




