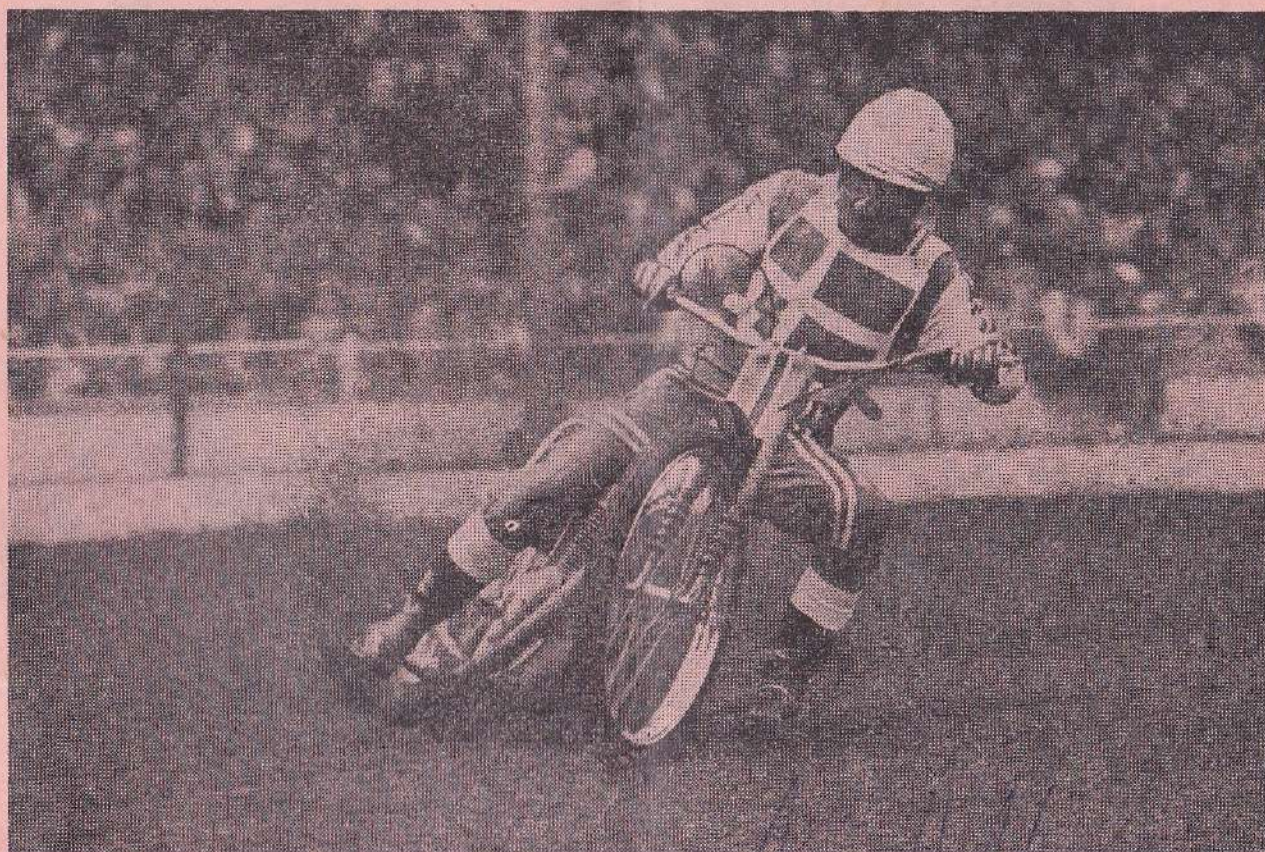

List and Explanatory Notes concerning Events.

Event 1—This is an Invitation International Solo Scratch Race to be run over 3 legs of 4 laps each leg for the Lydden International Solo Title. Each leg will count in determining the result. The first three riders from this event will be seeded into the final of event 2; the remainder will be seeded into the semi-final of event 2.

Event 2—This is an open event for International Solo riders. With the exception of the seeded riders from Event 1 all riders will be required to ride three times although only their best two rides will be counted in determining the best five riders to join the 4th, 5th and 6th placemen from event 1 to race in an eliminating semi-final. The first four riders from this semi-final will race against the first three from event 1 for the Prize Money of Event 2.

Event 3—This is an open event for National Solo riders. All riders will be required to ride three times although only their best two rides will be counted in determining the eight best riders to ride in the final of this event.

Event 4—This is an Invitation International Sidecar Scratch Race to be run over three legs of 4 laps each leg for the Lydden International Sidecar Trophy. Each leg will count in determining the result.

Event 5—This is an Invitation National Sidecar Race to be run over three Heats of 4 laps each Heat. Riders will race twice, both times to count in determining best 6 for Final.

Points Scoring Method:—In all race heats, points will be awarded to the winner and placemen in the following ratio: 1st—5 pts; 2nd—3 pts; 3rd—2 pts.; 4th—1 pt. In the case of a tie on points gained in Events 1 & 4 the rider with the higher single ride will take precedence, if still a tie persists the riders' positions in the latter leg will determine the matter.

In the case of a tie on points gained in Events 2 & 3 the riders uncounted legs will be taken into consideration. If still a tie persists then the rider with the higher single ride will take precedence.

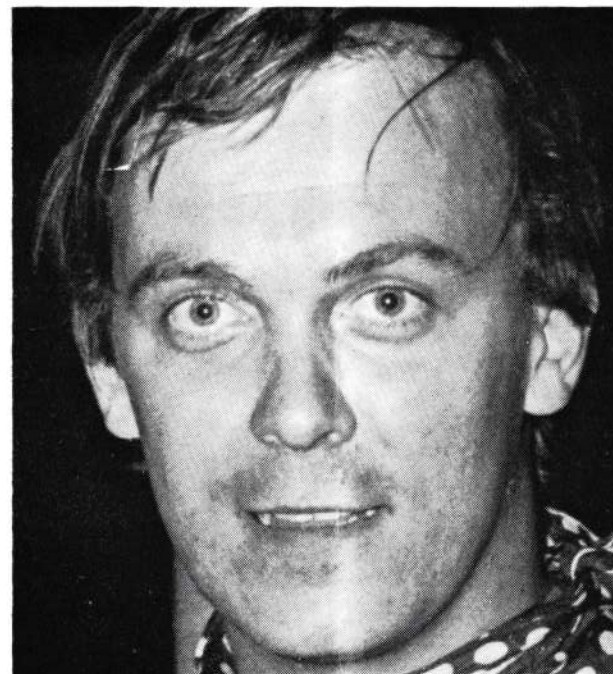

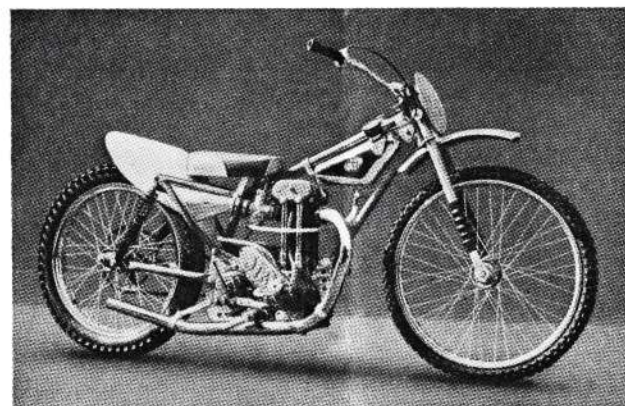

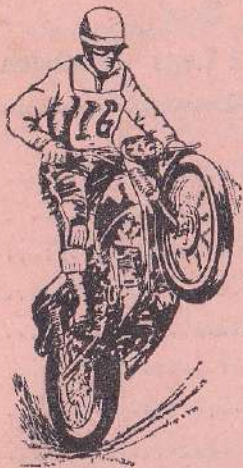
