Championship Chase at Crucial Stage

The ACU British Clubmans Championship has now reached a vital stage in the series, as there is only one more round after today's meeting, which is organised by the Triumph Owners Motor Cycle Club.

The series caters primarily for up-and-coming riders who hope to graduate to the National championship. Most of the competitors have not been to Lydden before so they are all on a steep learning curve, and the racing is bound to be fun, fast and furious.

Gary Bull, who was born in Birmingham but has spent most of his life in Australia is currently the man to beat in the T.T. Formula One class. But he has never raced here before, whereas Neil Dove, Jason Sear and Barry Watts have all been successful at Lydden recently. Sear led the championship in the early stages until he crashed at Donington and broke his elbow.

In the 125cc Open class all the top ten riders will be here. Pete Jennings (Knotts) was leading the series with 49 points, but he failed to score at Pembrey two weeks ago and so all his rivals have closed up.

Phil Burman (Rotax) has been a regular winner in the 250cc class, but he too failed to score at Pembrey, whereas the leading contenders, Neil Higgs, Carl Salvage and Neil Richardson took the first three places at the Welsh venue.

So what about the knee-scraping, elbow-shoving, fairing-bashing brigade — the Supersports competitors? Well, would you believe it, Tony Goldstraw who had been leading the 600cc class also failed to add to his tally at Pembrey, so Ian Knights and Mark Hill are much closer — and Mark has raced here before so we can expect fireworks in this category!

The ubiquitous KR1 Kawasakis' dominate the 400cc class, where John McGuinness, Neil Durham and Graham Read tackle the Suzuki of Sean Adams. Graham is probably fed up with everyone pointing out that his father is Phil Read, who won world championships with the Yamaha and M.V. Agusta factory teams.

Chesterfield's Lee Dickinson has held the advantage over Darren Lane in the SS125cc class for most of the season, but Alan McDougall, who has to travel all the way from Ormskirk is closing fast.

In the Sidecar category Trevor Robinson and Richard Graham will be hoping to keep their LCR ahead of the 1100 Kawasaki of Chris Wright and Paul Bailey who have been chasing them for most of the season. The F2 outfits will be running alongside their Open class counterparts here today, and the Welsh veterans Paul Iwanski and Simon Ansell could give some of the drivers of the bigger outfits a nasty shock with their ultra-rapid, ultra-reliable ex-Eddie Wright 350cc Yamaha.

Apart from the championship events there are nine supporting races, and the most important of these is another sidecar event, for the Judd Drew Memorial Trophy.

Judd was a great competitor, a racer's racer, and he never gave up even when there was no chance of victory. He started in grasstrack racing and then graduated to speedway, mainly at Crayford. He raced for many, many years, always spectacular as he slid broadside with his orange silk scarf flapping in the breeze, but he never achieved any great success. Then, at an age when most would have been long retired, he took up sidecar racing. Suddenly, he found his niche and success came almost immediately. He won at circuits all over the country, but especially at Brands and Lydden. He even graduated to the European Championship with considerable success.

Then he was struck down by the ultimate illness at a time when there were still many more races to win.

Always ready with a cheerful grin for anyone that knew him, Judd was a great example to us all. He is sorely missed.

"The first time I met Judd Drew was before I had ever ridden a sidecar outfit in a race. I answered an advertisement in the *Motorcycle News* and went down to Gravesend to see Judd's Suzuki outfit. It turned out to be the start of a friendship that spanned ten years. He was a great help to me in more ways than one. He taught me the correct way to set an engine up and I remember on one occasion when I was having problems at a meeting at Brands Hatch, he invited me to his home for a meal with his family and afterwards gave me the run of his workshop to carry out some machining that I had to do to be able to race the next day.

You could always be sure of getting a cup of tea (or a gin and tonic!) in Judd's coach even at one in the morning! He would help anyone who needed it and he proved to be valuable to our team keeping us abreast of things that were happening on the British racing scene whilst we were abroad. Judd was one of racing's characters and I don't think I'm alone in saying that he is sadly missed."
