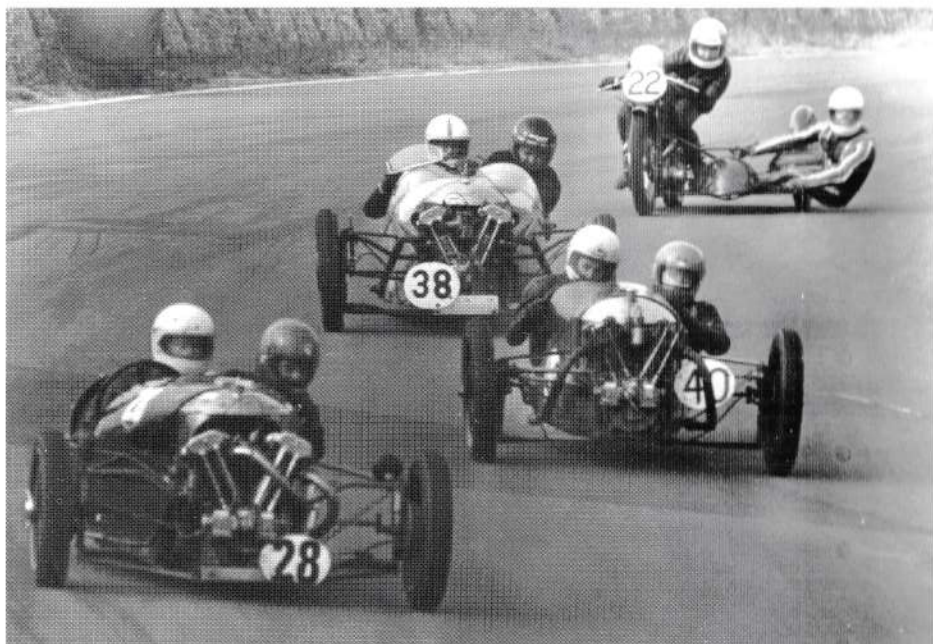


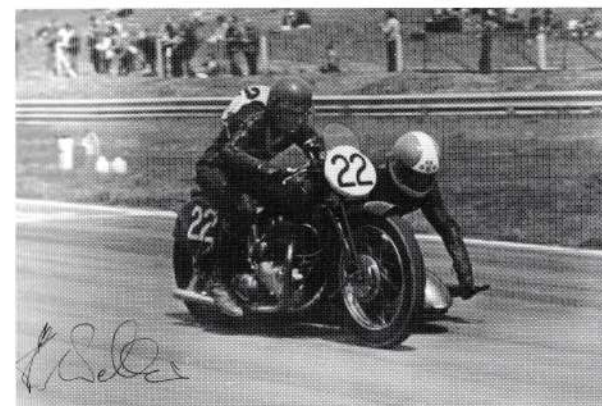

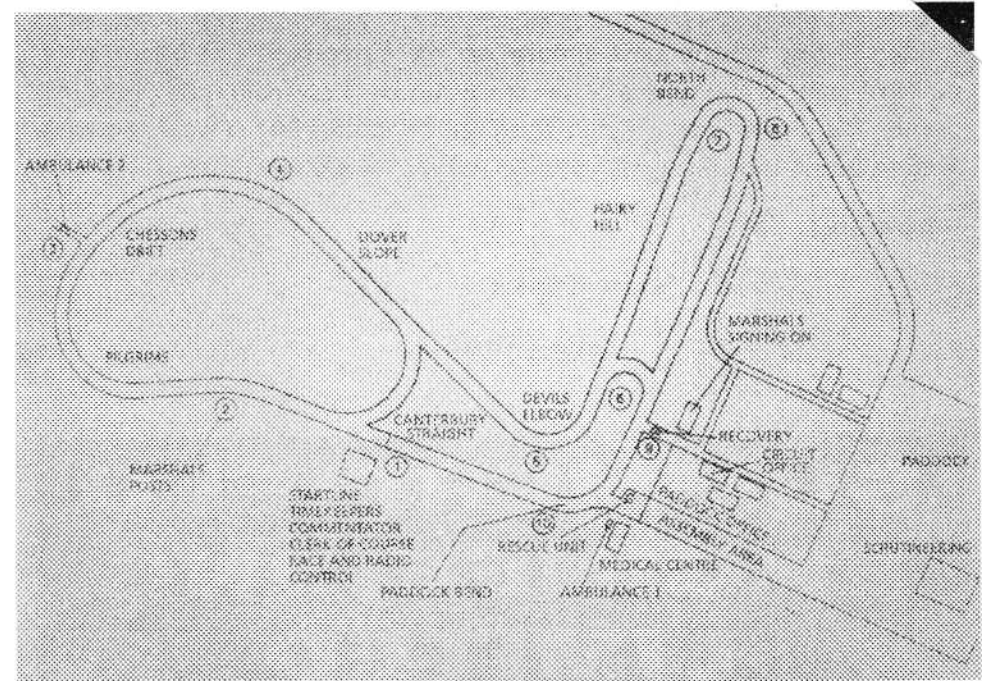

**CHAIRMAN'S CHAT**

Welcome to all our members, guests, spectators and the Velocette Owners Club to our second race meeting of the 2003 calendar here at Lydden Hill. The circuit is an excellent spectator venue and is liked by most of our riders.

If the racing and response to it is as good as that of our first meeting at Mallory Park an excellent weekend should be had by all.

In the opening rounds of the championship some epic battles took place in most classes. Event 1, the pre 34's, saw two wins for 190 Ian Bain followed by a battle for second place between Mike Farrall and Patrick Welch with Mike taking second place each time.

Event 2, the 250cc class saw a win for Alan Smallbones in the first race, after being chased all the way by Stu Noble on his BSA C15. The second race was won by Peter Aston on a Greeves RDS, but because the machine is not eligible for the class, first place points go to Ray Hemming after a close battle with Alan Smallbones.

Event 3, the 350's gave Len Homer a 1.5 second win in both races, in the first from Nigel Lines and the second from John McMahon.

Event 4, the pre 48 unlimited gave Ian Bain two more wins for the day, both convincingly from Mike Farrall and John McMahon.

Event 5 and 6 ran together with Mike Capewell taking two convincing wins in Event 5 from Phillip Wade and Mike Kemp.

Event 6 went the way of Lee Moore in both races firstly closely chased by Richard Adams who was 1.7 seconds adrift in the second race.

Event 7A, the up to 500cc specials, saw a win in both races for guest rider Bob Newby on his Mularney Manx. The points for first place going to John McMahon, who just managed to hold off Richard Adams in the first race, and to Richard Adams, chased home by Len Homer in the second race. Event 7B, the over 500cc specials, gave two run away wins for Stacey Killworth on his Rickman T110, firstly from Norman White on the John Player Norton and secondly from Roy Robertson on the nicely turned out Egli-Vincent.

Event 10, the Bantams, who ran with Event 4, saw two wins for Mike Powell from Stephen and Keith Woods; Mikes usual challenger, Martin Nash de Villiers, was not present at the meeting but has entered here so watch out for some close fought races. Danny Toone on his first Bantam outing failed to finish both races.

The Novice Solo Handicap Race was won by Miki Sprosen on his Rudge Sports from Susan Wright, our ex-starter, at her second race meeting.

Our guest riders, the 50CC racing Club, saw Ron Ponti gain two wins on his Kreidler GP.

The Solo Champion of Champions Handicap Race was won by Lee Moore, some 3.5 seconds from Mike Kemp and 5.5 seconds in front of the present champion, Mike Powell.

Event 8 and 9A, sidecar outfits to 1958 and sidecar based three wheelers to 1972 ran together. Both Event 8 honours went to the pairing of Nick Weston / Kerry Williams and for 9A machines, the first race was awarded to Lenny Pallister / Ian Marriner, the race declared after a red flag stoppage with three laps complete, and the second to Dave Mellows / Nick Archer. However, as their machine was not eligible for the class, first place points again went to Lenny Pallister and Ian Marriner.

Event 9B, B3 cyclecars, sidecar based three wheelers and Morgans, gave two wins to the Morgan of Bill and Maggie Tuer from the Morgan of Greg Bibby / Paula Heaney.

The Three Wheeler Champion of Champions saw a win for Dave Mellows / Nick Archer, after spending most of the day trying to get their amazing Vincent Special running. It seems patience paid off. The 2002 champions, Rowland Mettam / Gerry Daine, pulled out with a miss fire after the warm up lap.

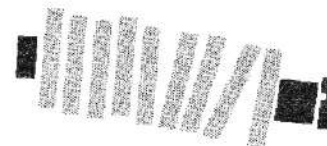
