SPECTATOR NOTICES

Prohibited Area Notice: The public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed. The fences are there for protection, and any persons found trespassing, or willfully damaging trees, shrubs, fences, etc., will be prosecuted by Lydden Circuit Ltd.

Litter: Please do not leave litter about the ground, place in the bins provided, or take it with you. This is a Race Track, the roads outside are not. Please drive with caution when leaving the grounds, giving consideration to other road users and pedestrians.

Animals: Whilst we do not encourage visitors to bring animals to the grounds, we must insist that if they do they be kept on a short leash, at no time are they to be taken in to the competitor's paddock area.

FLAG SIGNALS

RED: This is shown at the start and at marshals posts around the circuit, to indicate the race has been stopped. (only authorised by the Clerk of the Course). All vehicles must cease racing and proceed slowly to the pits or return to the startline as instructed to do so by the marshals or officials.

YELLOW: (motionless) Danger ahead, NO overtaking, slow down.

YELLOW: (waved) Great danger ahead, NO overtaking, SLOW down, be prepared to STOP.

GREEN: Course Clear, used at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions. Also shown immediately after the post where a yellow flag has been displayed, to indicate that the course ahead is now clear.

YELLOW with RED stripes: Lack of adhesion, used to indicate that liquid or a slippery substance is present on the surface in that section. This will be displayed until the hazard has been dealt with.

WHITE: service or slow moving course vehicle on course.
BLACK: This will be shown at the startline, together with a board indicating the competitor's racing number. The driver carrying that number MUST return immediately to the paddock.

BLACK FLAG with ORANGE disc displayed with WHITE number: A warning of apparent mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. The car concerned must call at its pit for repairs on the next lap.

BLACK and WHITE chequered: Denotes the race has finished, this is usually waved at the winner and held motionless until all other competitors have passed.

NATIONAL FLAG: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

LOOKING GOOD AT LYDDEN

Welcome back to Lydden Circuit, the home of grass-roots motor racing for genuine club competitors, for the first race meeting of the season to be organised by the London and Home Counties of the British Automobile Racing Club. A glance down the entry list shows that this is probably the healthiest entry for the Centre for some time and thanks are due to all those who helped make it happen.

Being a Bank Holiday means racing can start earlier than on a Sunday. Consequently we can squeeze in more races than usual and so there are some extra events for National categories here today.

The RDS Automotive K Sports Championship is a prime example. This season, for the first time, all these rapid, slicks and wings sports racers will be powered by a 1.6 Rover K series engine. The current leader of the series is Justin Foley, who is rapidly making a name for himself like his father, Barry, the creator of the "Catchpole" motor racing cartoons. Justin's chief rivals in the series, Matthew Slinn and Barry Webb will be trying to reduce his points advantage here today.

It will be good to see the rorty, tyre-squealing Jaguars in action again and if that kind of spectacular action appeals the Historic Road Sports should be just as entertaining, especially with Roger Conner's TVR Griffiths and two Shelby GT350 models entered. And the two classic single-seater events, for FF1600 and FF2000 cars, recall nostalgic images of the halcyon days when grids were full for the Marchant & Cox Formula Ford series and the Flint FF2000 Championship. Some of the drivers (Steve Nichols, Tony Hancock, Nick Own and Nick Pearce) are still leading contenders.

Lydden has been blessed with several rounds of the Kent County FF1600 series this season. The current champion, Dave Hardisty will probably set the pace here, although Matt Hayes and Mark Langfield could spring a surprise, especially if it is wet. But Hayes shunted at Chesson's last time out and his car might not be ready.

Of the four Lydden championships the Saloon series is shaping up well and we can expect another duel between the Escort-Cosworths of Kevan Wells and Julian Sage, with ever-improving performances from Centre champion, Neil Bostock and Barry Andrews, the former FF2000 champion who now races an Ibiza donated by SEAT UK.
