

FLAG SIGNALS

Blue/Steady: Another competitor is close Blue/Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass White: Service vehicle or very slow moving car on circuit

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow

Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop Yellow with Red Stripes: Slippery surface ahead Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also shown at marshal posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals

Black/orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately

Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number: Warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged

Black displayed with White numbers: Driver must report to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course immediatly.

Black & White Chequered: End of race National Flag: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

Ready for an all-action weekend!

Welcome to BARC South Eastern Centre's annual Lydden Hill extravaganza, which promises two days of exciting track action and plenty of variety in a total of 24 races.

The Centre's three racing series are all on view, with pride of place being taken by the flagship Dunlop/Motorsport News Saloon Championship. The DMN as it's regularly known, the Cannons Motor Spares Tin Tops and the Quaife Intermarque League all move past the halfway mark in a busy season this weekend.







We're also excited to welcome the fabulous Legends as a guest championship, plus a one-make series for Mazda MX5 sports cars. Certainly not to be overlooked are the cars of the awesome NASCAR-lookalike European Late Model Series which perform on the tight Chessons oval. Unlike last year these cars will race on both days, but like last year they're heading for cross-Channel connections direct from the track.

Read on for more information, and have a great weekend's sport.

Coming to Lydden Richard Brent, champion in 2008, heads the Dunlop/Motorsport News points and will be hard to beat here in his class. Richard won't be the only one looking forward to the return of his old sparring partner Bill Richards, after a violent crash at Brands Hatch which left Bill's Mini wrecked and Bill himself battered and bruised.

Defending champion Rod Birley has had to overcome problems of his own this year but is not far behind Brent in the overall reckoning, and he too has a formidable record at Lydden. The scoring system means that drivers like Richard Brent, who may not normally be in the running for outright race victory, have the same chance of taking the title as the turbo-powered Class A group.

Intermarque and Tin Tops drivers have been racing for points since these words went to press, and without knowing the outcome it's safe to predict that 2009 Intermarque champion Steve Hall and close rival Keith White remain locked in combat at the top of the table. Among the Tin Tops the midfield classes have again been giving us some of the best action and regularly produce the end-of-season champion.


Tigers from a Cambridgeshire sports car manufacturer regularly appear with our Intermarque and Tin Tops cars, but this weekend they have separate races. The Tigers have a class structure of their own and pace-setters this season have included Paul Dudley, Mick Grant and Michael Pearce.

Some of the hottest racing will come from the Legends, which are based on pre-war Chevrolet, Ford and Dodge bodies built to five eighths scale. Powered by Yamaha bike engines they produce some of the closest competition you're ever likely to see.


The Legends' race format is for two heats and a final at each qualifying round with the top points scorers in the heats starting at the back in the final. This guarantees plenty of overtaking and some very close encounters. Here we can look forward to a double round so that drivers will be out six times in all.

The Mazda Max5 championship, confusingly, is one of two open to the hugely popular Japanese Lotus Elan clones and this weekend we see round five and the second doubleheader of 2010. The aim is to provide close and cost-effective racing for the club competitor.

V8 Chevy-powered monsters from the European Late Model Series (ELMS) are scheduled to race three times each day on the short oval and should not under any circumstances be missed. ELMS was conceived as a way of bringing American-style stock car racing to Europe. The exclusively oval racers spend much of their time at Warneton in Belgium. This is their second UK appearance of the year, having raced at Ipswich earlier this month, and they're due back at Lydden in a few weeks.


