

these 52 days. I am not complaining about that for, in my book, the leisure activity of the competitor goes on and occupies the mind for a lot more of his/her time than is spent in actually racing. Also for the spectators and marshals at the track, their leisure is not confined to the period of racing itself. Here at Lydden Circuit I like to think that a big part of their leisure is in fact just being in the open air and enjoying the beautiful countryside surrounding the circuit – a facility which would be denied to them were the circuit not there.

So, how can you help? You can help by writing to Mr. S. Parslow, at the Department of the Environment, Room 13/18, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9JD, quoting reference APP/X2220/A/85/36956 saying, in effect,

Dear Sir,

In accordance with H.M. Government's thinking, we the undersigned agree that the constructive pursuit of legitimate sport and leisure activities is a fundamental requisite for this country's well-being. Business and other agencies which bring this about should be actively encouraged. Therefore, please take note that we support Mr. William Chesson in his appeal against the decision of the local Dover District Council planning authority in respect of the Lydden Motor Race Circuit Appeal, reference APP/X2220/A/85/36956.

After 30 years of operating at the same venue, without the benefit of permanent planning permission, we believe that the time has surely arrived for a declaration of permanency at this venue, and we respectfully request that you determine this Appeal in favour of the Appellant.

The above is merely a draft letter, to give some idea of what is required.

I am sure that many of you will be able to write your own thoughts without any prompting by me, but what is important is that you do write something, telling the Appeals Inspector that you wish Lydden Circuit to remain in operation, for whatever reasons you feel appropriate. When considering my application, earlier this year, Dover Council indicated that it was swayed through receiving some 30 letters against the circuit, with only 3 in favour. This was because I thought that they were well aware of the strength of feeling to retain the circuit, from the public hearing of a few years ago. This was when supporters for the circuit greatly swamped the dissenters by something like 100 to 1 and it seemed unnecessary to re-acquaint them with the strength of feeling in support. I was wrong, it IS necessary to tell the planners again and again that we want to keep our leisure venue. Dover Council is not going for a public hearing in this Appeal, as I am sure that they are well aware that they would again be swamped – they are to rely on the written word. Let's show them that we can also write and swamp them again. I thank you sincerely, in anticipation of your support.



LYDDEN NEWS – HELP NEEDED!

As the 1985 season draws to a close, may I take this opportunity of thanking all spectators, competitors and marshals for their support during the year, in continuing to make Lydden Circuit a trouble-free centre for Motor Sport, and a venue at which we can all enjoy our leisure pursuits and chosen sport in a friendly atmosphere. But, now the time has come for an all-out effort to secure this venue as a permanent leisure centre specialising in motor sport.

As you may know, two-thirds of the circuit lies within the jurisdiction of Canterbury City Council, the remaining one-third is within the boundary of the Dover District Council. Canterbury has declared that I have permanent planning permission for the two-thirds in their area. Dover District Council will not give permanent permission for the one-third in their area and thus I operate only on a temporary permission, which is not satisfactory when large capital sums must be earmarked for re-surfacing and generally updating facilities.

For some 30 years I have operated at this site, coping with various temporary planning legislation but 'enough is enough', so I have now appealed to the Secretary of State, via the Department of the Environment, for a declaration from them that this site may now be considered a permanent place of leisure activity for Motor Sport enthusiasts, albeit for only 52 days per year, with fairly stringent times when racing can actually take place on
