A warm welcome to Lydden International Circuit for the CRMC's second meeting of 2006. We have an excellent entry with over 250 solo and sidecar competitors coming under starter's orders for this weekend's 43-race programme. With its succession of tricky turns and constantly changing gradients Lydden is arguably the ultimate rider's circuit, where superior horsepower often doesn't mean a thing, and can sometimes even be a disadvantage.

As always we would like to thank officials, marshals, competitors and of course our much valued sponsors. Without all these committed people the meeting just cannot take place.

You will see a vast variety of bikes on show so don't miss the opportunity to tour the paddock. The CRMC is a very friendly club and you'll nearly always find riders, owners and sponsors very approachable and only too happy to talk racing.

In some ways this feels like the start of 2006 proceedings after our Mallory Park season-opener was blighted by an unprecedented succession of problems that led to the abandonment of the meeting with seven races still to go. We had crashes, hailstones, power cuts and oil slicks – just about the only crisis that Clerk of the Course, John Wilcox, and his heroic team weren't confronted with was an outbreak of bird flu among Mallory's resident wildfowl! In over 20 years of involvement with the sport I certainly can't recall a combination of events quite like it so with any luck that means we are going to run like clockwork this weekend (hope that doesn't jinx it!)

Among all the Mallory mayhem we still had some excellent racing and I am confidently predicting that we are in for a thrilling weekend's action here around Lydden's tight turns. Lea Gourlay, 2005 Solo Racer of the Year and multiple championship winner had a poor time of it at Mallory as he was suffering from an eye injury that forced him to retire after just 2 races. Among those to capitalise on this was new Lidgate team-mate, Paul Dobbs, who grabbed the win in the opening round of the prestigious 1300 National Championship from Graham Williams (Weslake Triton) and 2005 Champion, Gary Thwaites (Watson Norton). Gourlay missed out on this title last year so you can bet he will be going particularly hard to claw back lost ground.

In addition to all our regular classes we have the opening rounds of this season's 350 and 500 National Series. Gourlay won both titles last year on Summerfield Engineering's Petty Manx Nortons but with Steve Tomes on board Andy Molnar's rapid machines we can expect a battle royal. Sunday sees the annual 12 lap Charlie Sanby Race, in memory of one of British racing's most popular short circuit stars. The event rotates through the classes that Charlie himself rode and this year it's the turn of the Post Classics. Last year's race (won by Nigel Palmer) was a thriller and with the Classic Superbikes and 2-stroke GP machines contesting this year's event we are again guaranteed spectacular action.

Sidecars are always particularly spectacular around Lydden and this weekend has attracted a wide variety of machinery to savour, including Mallory victors Jon Perkins and Pete Allebone on their PBR Imp outfit.

FLAG SIGNALS

Red: Immediately stop racing.

Yellow (steady): Signal of danger. (Waved) Slow down, driver must be prepared to stop.

OVERTAKING FORBIDDEN ON ANY YELLOW FLAG.

National flag or Green: Start

Black displayed with white number: informs the driver of motorcycle the number of which is shown that he must stop at the pit on the next lap.

Black with Orange circle: Displayed with vehicles number: the rider must leave the track IMMEDIATELY.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Deterioration of adhesion of the track surface

White: Slow moving intervention vehicle on track. The white flag informs drivers they are about to overtake a vehicle which is travelling on the track at much slower speed than competing motorcycles.

Blue: Overtaking signal, informs rider he they are about to be overtaken by a faster motorcycle.

Yellow with black diagonal cross: Start of the last lap.

Black/White Chequered: End of race.

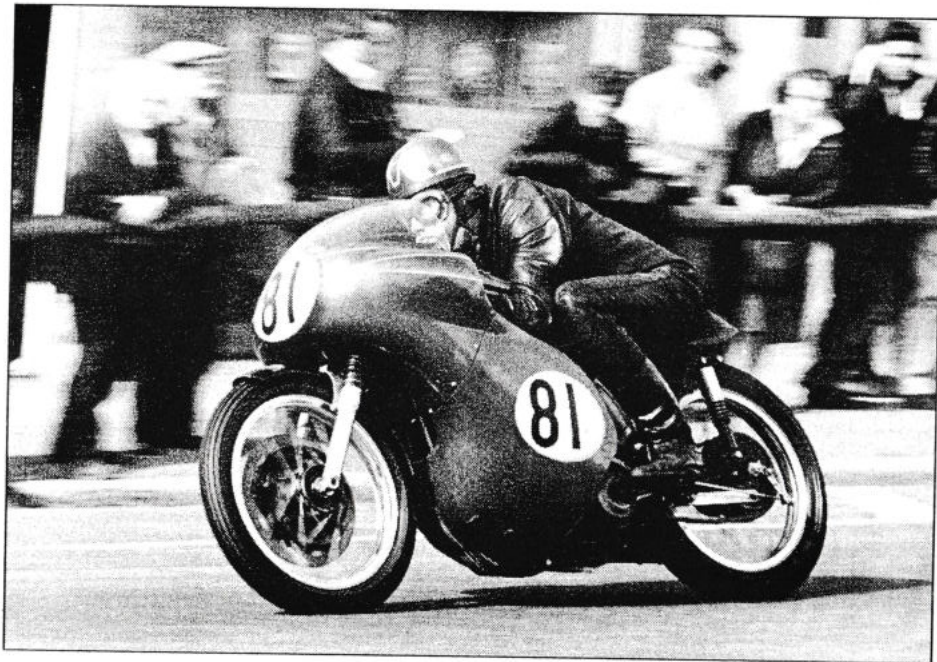
Charlie Sanby

Charlie Sanby started his racing career when the UK motorcycle factories dominated the racing scene and the likes of Mike Hailwood, Phil Read, Bill Ivy, Derek Minter and John Cooper ruled over the British short circuits. At over six foot tall he towered over some of his rivals such as Bill Ivy, but just look how he gets tucked in behind the fairing in the picture.

He came to prominence when he won the prestigious Grovewood award in 1966 and reigned supreme at Lydden in 1972 when he was crowned Lord of Lydden. Although he could "scratch" with the best, he also had success in the Isle of Man with thirds in the 1973 Senior and 1975 Classic and led the 1971 Production TT from Ray Pickrell and Tony Jefferies until forced to retire with an electrical problem. Not only versatile on different types of circuit, Charlie was equally adaptable with the machinery, racing 500 & 750 Nortons, 350 Aermacchi's Yamaha's, 500 Suzuki's and Moto Guzzi's.

It is to reflect Charlie's ability to ride most bikes that this race is shared between the 500's, the 1300's and the Post Classic's. In 2006 it is the turn of the Post Classics to battle for the trophy
