

Rallycross Promoters Ltd would like to welcome you all to Lydden Hill for the second event in the 2006 Rallycross Super Series - The 2006 Rallycross Super Series Masters. We would like to start by saying a very big thank you to all of the marshals and the Darlington & District Motor Club for putting on a tremendous event at Croft Circuit in March, after being presented with the worst possible conditions. Despite the heavy snow blizzards and the temperature dipping below freezing the 2006 season started on a high.

Polish Champion, Jacek Ptaszek was crowned the new English Rallycross Masters Champion at Croft Circuit, becoming the first driver outside Britain & Ireland to win in the Rallycross Super Series Division 1 category. 2005 Rallycross Superprix Champion, Evans dominated the event, but was struck with some cruel luck in the final, when his crankshaft broke. Evans will be hoping to make up for his disapointment here today and claim his first RSS win of the year.

The Rallycross Superprix was the perfect note to end last season with the top drivers from European Rallycross taking on the best of British. It was a great day for British and Irish Rallycross with Christopher Evans emerging victorious, beating the likes of Kenneth Hansen, Per Eklund and Jos Kuypers to put the sport firmly back on the map in Britain Our next event in the Rallycross Super Series is the Austrian Rallycross Masters, which takes place at Greinbach on Sunday July 30th. This is then followed by the Swedish Rallycross Masters (Arvika) on Sunday September 17th. These two events will firmly establish the RSS in Europe and it is likely that further European events will be added to the calendar next year.



The second round of the MDA Clubmans Rallycross Championship took place at Blyton Circuit two weeks ago and it was great to see that once again the MDA proved they could run a successful Clubmans Championship event outside of a major series or championship. This is a very important factor for the development of Rallycross in the UK to ensure that there is a greater pool of drivers progressing through the sport. By having seperate clubmans events, it will hopefully lead to the return of single circuit based Championship's like we had back in the eighties, which in turn will re-introduce more organising motor clubs into the sport.

A big thank you must go to K&N Filters, Yokohama Tyres, Hayfisher television productions, Scalextric, Mel Williams tyres, Rally School Ireland, the Darlington & District Motor Club, the BARC and Tony Bell for all of the their support towards the 2006 Rallycross Super Series. The timetable outlined above may be brought forward should the event be running ahead of schedule. The prize giving will take place following the conclusion of racing, after the Division 1 A Final.

Each category, will consist of three qualifying heats. The grids will be pre-determined by the organisers. Each competitor will be awarded points in each heat race with the two lowest points counting towards their grid position in the Finals. When two drivers have scored the same total of points for entering the Finals, the points obtained in the heat which has not been counted will be decisive. In a further tie, the fastest time of any of the heats is decisive. If a driver is unable to come to the grid for a Final, his place will remain empty and cannot be taken by another driver.

In the Junior category, there will be a maximum of two finals for the top 15 drivers. The best 7 drivers having the smallest total of points from two qualifying Heats will enter the A Final, the next 8 will enter the B Final. The winner of the B Final will take the last place on the grid for the A Final. The grid for the Junior Finals will be 3 - 2 - 3. The highest qualified driver will choose the Pole Position at either side of the grid but not the middle. For the Division 1, Super Series 2000, Super National, Stock Hatch, Minicross & Revivals categories, there will be a maximum of three finals for the top 28 drivers. The best nine drivers having the smallest total of points from two qualifying Heats will enter the A Final, the next 10 will enter the B Final and so on. The winner of the B Final will take the last place on the grid for the A Final. The grid formation for the Finals will be 3 - 2 - 3 - 2. The highest qualified driver can choose the Pole Position.




#### Hill aims for first Rallycross victory

Action all the way in Division 1...




Having enjoyed a successful start to the season with his Mitsubishi Lancer, Steve Hill could be a good bet for victory here today. A new Julian Godfrey prepared engine was fitted to the car over the winter which has transformed Hills pace. The car has plenty of torque and is quick out of the blocks making the Mitsubishi hard to beat on the run down to the first corner. Tony Bell finished second behind Jacek Ptaszek at Croft and usually goes well at Lydden Hill with his Toyota Corolla. The engine in the Toyota was rebuilt over the winter and the car will be in tip top condition for today's event. Andy Grant and Steve Mundy will be very close to the action at the front of the field, while Kevin McCann and Mad Mark will be hoping for some better luck after a difficult start to the year.

'Christopher Evans will be aiming to get back to winning ways in the Rallycross Super Series Masters event here at Lydden Hill today, following the disappointment of Croft back in March. Evans in his Tony Bardy Motorsport prepared Opel



Can Turpin take his second RSS win?




This could one of the closest Super National battles there has been for a long time with anyone of six drivers capable of taking home the win. Ironically no one has ever won two Super Series events in this category and the chances are that we could have yet another first time Super Series winner today.



Mike Turpin in his Vauxhall Nova starts today's event as the favourite for the race win, but is sure to be pushed hard by David Binks (BMW Mini), Mike Sellar (Renault Clio), Jamie Bird (Renault Clio) and Mike Howlin (Ford Fiesta). Binks today gives debut to his new BMW Mini which is prepared by Competition Engineering.



The new car is now powered by a 2.5 litre turbocharged BMW engine and features a six speed sequential gearbox from Elite racing transmissions. The team has switched to a new Ohlins suspension unit together with a move to Avon tyres.



Bill Harbour (Ford Escort Cosworth), Mark Watson (Ford Focus) and Phil Collard (Ford KA) both aim to get in on the action on what is their home circuit, while Sean McAdean (Vauxhall Corsa) could also be in with a shout of a podium position.

Dover based driver, Russell Etherington will put his local circuit knowledge to good effect as he makes his second outing of the season with his rebuilt Renault Clio. It is surely only a matter of time before we see the first win for the Audi TT of Michael Boak. The car is now right on the pace and with a bit of luck on his side, then the Geordie could easily be standing on the top of the podium this afternoon.

#### Rally School Ireland Junior Rallycross Championship in association with Scalextric

Rallycross Promoters Limited announced last week that Rally School Ireland will be the title sponsor of the 2006 Rallycross Super Series/MDA run Junior Rallycross Championship. The Championship for 14-17 year olds in identical 1.0 Rover Mini's will now be known as the 2006 Rally School Ireland Junior Rallycross Championship. Rally School Ireland will award the top three drivers in the Championship at the end of the season with a day's test drive/tuition at their school with a leading driver from the World of Rallying.

Rally School Ireland is situated in Gola, Scotstown, Co. Monaghan, which features a two million euro facility which is designed with maximum entertainment in mind. This purpose built gravel & Tarmac rally stage comes complete with handbrake turns and hairpin bends along with corners designed to get the rally car drifting & skidding. At the facility they have a range of cars including a Subaru Impreza WRC, Metro 6R4 and Audi Quattro Turbo. Over the years the school has entertained many of the top Rally drivers including Colin McRae and Mikko Hirvonen.

Ben Rennison is the leader of the Rally School Ireland Junior Rallycross Championship after two rounds, but is on holiday for today's event giving his rivals a perfect opportunity to cut into his point's advantage. Liam Harrison, Ben Power, Kyle Orr and Russell Simpson will all be aiming for there first victory of the season, while Taylor Edwardes and Charlie Budd make their first appearances in the Rallycross Super Series. Stephen Larkin is hoping for some better luck following engine problems at Blyton. Scalextric are providing prizes for today's event in the Junior Rallycross category.

Division 1 - Equivalent to World Rally Cars. 530bhp + machinery, the main class in Rallycross.


Division 1A - 2wd, maximum of 1600cc, similar to the Super 1600cc Rally machinery. Sequential gearboxes are not permitted. Super Series 2000 - Maximum 2 litre engine capacity. Front wheel drive cars only which are not turbocharged or spaceframed.

Super National - Any 2 wheel drive car is permitted.

Stock Hatch - Standard production cars, with a maximum engine capacity of 1600cc.

Minicross - One make category, made up the lengendary Mini.

MDA Revivals - New category for 2006, designed to bring some of the older cars back into the sport. Juniors - One make category for Juniors. Maximum age limit is upto and including 16 years old.

#### Revivals A and B



Rallycross Super Series 2000





Knowles aims to get back to winning ways in Minicross




Rallycross Super Series Stock Hatch Cup




