Gearbox and diff must be from a production car. The control tyre is the Yokohama A032R/A048R. Rim width is 6" or 7" depending upon class.

The regulations provide ample scope for the amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits There are two engine options. either the highly tuned Reliant 850cc or the unmodified Fiat 'FIRE' 1108cc, the latter introduced in 2003 due to the diminishing supply of spares for the Reliant engine. Course, Incident, Flag, Observer, Pits, Paddock, Assembly, Race Rescue Unit - all these basically come under the umbrella of marshalling. However, you don't just come along and do whatever job you fancy on the day; there is a lot more to it than that. Those with no experience start as Trainees and will be placed with experienced marshals at whatever position they are allocated. Training days are available, ranging from fire-fighting, incident handling, use and knowledge of the many flags through to, after years of experience, becoming Examining Observer or Specialist.

The 750 Motor Club looks after its Marshals, realising only too well that they are all volunteers and it has a Sponsorship Scheme to assist new marshals to buy the necessary kit (overalls, wet weather gear etc) or to help with their replacement; this funding uniquely comes directly from the 750 Motor Club competitors by way of donations to our Marshals Fund.

With its 20+ race days the 750 Motor Club has lots to offer to both new and experienced Marshals.


