

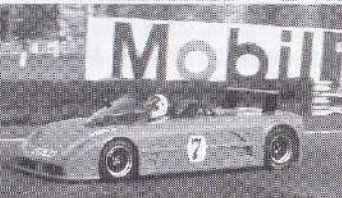

#### Flag Signals

**Blue/Steady:** Another competitor is close

**Blue/Waved:** Another competitor is trying to pass.

**White:** Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

**Yellow/Steady:** Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

**Yellow/Waved:** Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

**Yellow with Red Stripes:** Slippery surface ahead.

**Green:** Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.

**Red:** Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals; (at startline and individual marshals posts) race stopped.

**Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number:** Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits immediately.

**Black/White rectangular with White number:** Warning to driver that his behaviour (i.e. corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

**Black display with White number:** Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

**Yellow/Black Quartered Flag:** On passing the flag at the Start/Finish line, the race leader must slow down significantly (to around 50mph maximum) until the obstruction on the track is clear.

**Black/White Chequered:** End of race.

**Races are started using a system of red/green traffic lights.**

## A Cornucopia of Club Sport

Porsche, Ferrari, Alfa Romeo, Ford... All enjoy a significant slice of the pie that is known as the heritage of motor sport. Well, this weekend here at Lydden Hill,

Whatever your sporting preference, this weekend's meeting has something for everyone. So, in no particular order, here's a brief look through the entry lists. Race one - just after lunch on Saturday - sees the Alfa Romeo Owners Club take to the track. These guys and gals were at Brands Hatch six days ago where, under blue skies and soaring temperatures, they put on one of the shows of the weekend. A multi-class series that caters for Alfa Romeos from production Alfa Suds through to significantly race modified Alfa 75's; there really is no racing that's closer than this. In classes A-E at Brands, Julian Birley (cousin of Rod) in his Alfa 75 V6 took the spoils after a fantastic early race dice with Graham Presley. Class C's John Brooke completed the podium just ahead of Simon Diffey in a GTV6. Simon's car had not turned a wheel since the mid 1980's prior to Brands Hatch, so his fourth place finish earned him a well-deserved Driver of the Day award from the AROC. Watching him power the striking blue GTV through clearways with a touch of controlled opposite lock really was a joy to behold for the sun drenched spectators that lined the banks of the Brands Indy circuit. More of the same this weekend would be much appreciated Simon...

In Class F, which is Alfa 33 heaven, Chelmsford's Colm Flanagan once again climbed to the top step of the podium, beating Graham Saunders and John Whitbourne. With fastest lap and pole position, the Brands result cements Colm's second position in the Championship standings just two points adrift of Class E and overall leader Bryn Griffiths.

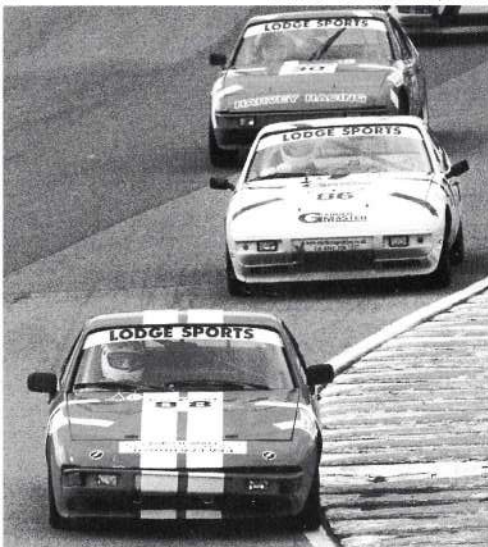
If Italian racing machinery is your baby, and the Alfa's haven't left you satisfied, this weekend also sees the Le Mans Autoitalia series here at Lydden. Again, a multi class championship, the Le Mans Autoitalia series sees Alfas a-plenty, but also introduces variety in the shape of Lancias and Fiats.

Head north from Italy and we find the home of Porsche. A company with a motor sporting pedigree that takes some beating, the Lodge Sports Porsche 924 Championship returns to Lydden to kick-off the second half of their season. A double header, which represents rounds 7 and 8 of this year's championship, Keith Penman has forced his way to the head of the standings from Alan Wilshire and Jon Wolfe.

This series really is all about having fun on and off the track and it may be worth taking the time to wander down to the paddock to see a bunch of drivers that are real competitors and a group of people that are great friends. The Lodge Sports Porsche 924 series runs on Colway re-treaded tyres, which marks it out as unique in British motor sport. The only series sanctioned by the MSA to race on re-treaded tyres, Colway have made significant strides forwards in their product development through the association with Lodge Sports Porsches.

Move across the Atlantic from Europe and we find Detroit and Ford. The Worlds largest manufacturer, and one that's riding high on motor sporting achievement with Colin McRea's World Rally Championship bid looking ever stronger as each week passes. Ford are well represented here too this weekend, with races for both the immensely close and entertaining Ford Si Championship and the popular Ford Saloons series. In the Si's Ian Flynn has eeked out a slender 18 point lead at the head of the table from local lad, Peter Daniels. Peter comes from Canterbury, so he's looking to do well at his 'home' circuit, and close down on Ian's Championship lead.

In the Ford Saloon Championship, the little Fiesta XR2's that are so well represented on the grid here, could just upset their more powerful rivals with their superior handling through the tight left hander at Devils Elbow and then around the hairpin at the top of the hill. Two Fiesta XR2's currently sandwich the Sierra



that heritage continues. Welcome from the BRSCC South Eastern Centre to this, the Little Stour Race Weekend.

Cosworth of Graham Waite in the points standings. Leader is Leicester's Tim Watson; with third place man Chris Lester - who travels down from Hinckley.

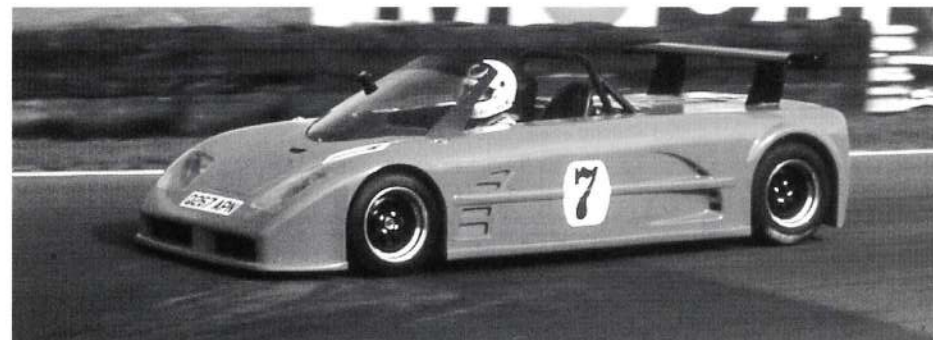
The Lumenition Road Saloon Championship arrives at Lydden for Rounds 6 & 7. So far it has been a fantastic start to the season, with last years Class A and overall winner Simon Taylor back on form, even though he missed the first round. Tim Dawson is also having a better season than he did in 2000. One of this year's newcomers to Road Saloons is Adie Hawkins - who is currently leading Class B - followed very closely by John Strickland and Phil Simms.

Class C front-runner is Lee Scott, who has come first in his class at every round bar Mallory, which was won by Gareth Broadbent. Gareth is another driver embarking on his first year of competition and he's certainly now signalled his intent after posting win number one. This weekend could just see an epic class

battle between these two...

To prevent this weekend from becoming a saloon festival, The SEMSEC Sports and Saloons, and Tunbridge Wells Motor Club Silhouettes and Sports series introduce a selection of Sports racing cars which are quite simply awesome to watch here at Lydden. Cars to look out for are Mike Roberts in the Blue and Red Jade Sports Prototype, John Oxborrow in his 'home built and designed' Ox-7, and the ever competitive Rod Birley who races a Ford Escort World Rally Car in the Sports & Saloons series. Rod won his Formula Saloon encounters at Brands Hatch last weekend and could just take some beating this weekend too!

Rounding off the weekend is the John Taylor Handicap, which at the time of closing for press had only attracted two entries. Let us hope that more join the fray in the coming days.

#### BRSCC FORD SALOON CHAMPIONSHIP - Races 6 & 18

**DESCRIPTION:** Any Ford manufactured motor car. Run in 5 classes with a 6th class (Class F) for any vehicle entered as an experimental or development car by, or on behalf of the Ford Motor Company.

**Class Structure:** A - Over 2100cc and including all Escort Cosworths, Sierra Cosworths and Sapphire Cosworths. Also any vehicles utilising the complete turbo charged unit originating from the above or the RS200; B - From 1650cc - 2100cc including Escort Turbo manufactured between 1984 and 1991 and Fiesta Turbo from 1990; C - Up to 1650cc; D - Any Ford car over 1650cc (Including turbo charged models) which is, or has been homologated to Group N specification in accordance with the technical regulations of the FIA; E - Any Ford car up to 1650cc which is, or has been homologated to Group N in accordance with the technical regulations of the FIA.

**AWARDS:** Trophies to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers.

**POINTS:** 16 - 14 - 13 - 12 - 11 - 10 down to 1 point for 15th place, per class and subject to entry. All other finishers are awarded 1 point. Fastest Race lap in each class - 1 point. Fastest qualifier in each class - 1 point.
