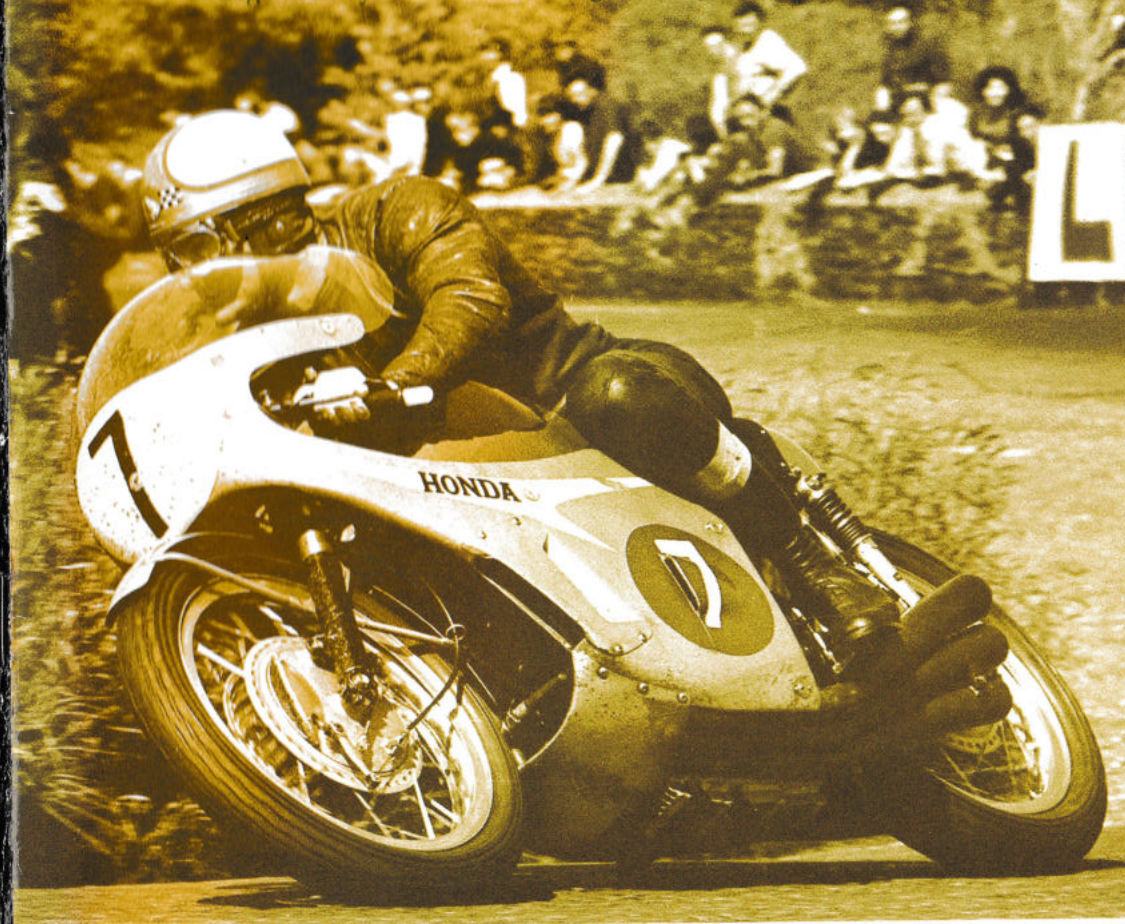

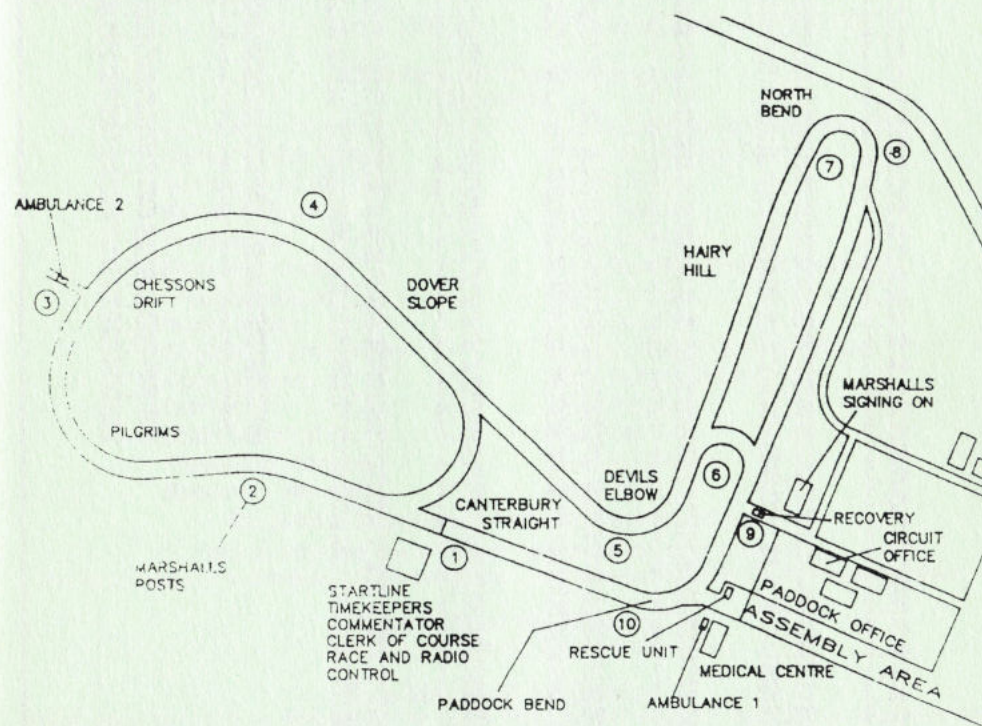

FOR SPECTATORS CRMC TERMINOLOGY:

Period: Period One machines were produced before December 31st 1963; Period Two machines after January 1st 1964.

Group: Group One refers to thoroughbred TT and GP machines; Group Two to short circuit machines and specials; Group Three to sports and production racing machines.

Post Classic: is for genuine Grand Prix machines manufactured after the Classic cut off dates.

Sideplates: Green denotes up to 250 cc • Blue denotes up to 350cc • Yellow denotes up to 500 cc • White denotes up to 750 cc Red denotes Unlimited

FLAG SIGNALS

Red: Immediately stop racing

Yellow (Steady): Signal of danger. (Waved): Slow down, driver must be prepared to stop. OVERTAKING STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.

National Flag or Green: Start

Green: Course clear.

Black displayed with white number: Informs the driver of the motorcycle the number of which is shown that he must stop at the pit on the next lap.

Yellow with Red stripes: Deterioration of adhesion of the track surface.

White: Slow moving intervention vehicle on track. The white flag informs drivers that they are about to overtake a vehicle which is travelling on the track at much slower speed than competing motorcycles.

Blue: Overtaking signal. The blue flag informs the driver that he is going to be overtaken by one or more faster motorcycles.

Yellow with black diagonal cross: Start of the last lap.

Black/White Chequered: End of Race.
