FLAG SIGNALS

Blue/ Steady: Another competitor is close.

Blue/Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass. White: Service vehicle or very slow moving car on circuit.

Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down.

Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop.

Yellow with Red stripes: Slippery surface ahead. Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also shown at marshals posts to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions.

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals.

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately.

Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number: Warning to driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged.

Black displayed with White number: Driver must return immediately to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course.

Black and White Chequered: End of race.

National Flag: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

It's A Classic . . .

AFTER A long winter break from circuit racing at Lydden, the BARC South Eastern Centre returns with a bang today with the Classic Package and Jaguar Enthusiasts' Club Races.

The laguar races are reviewed elsewhere and here we look at the races which make up the BARC package.

Many would say that the "Jewel in the Crown" of the Classic Touring Car package is the Classic Group One Touring Car race for Pre '83 cars which features many of last year's front-runners.

Expect Brian Stevens and David Howard to be at the front of the field in their Jaguars, but Chris Bright (Rover SDI) and current Champion, Stacy Vickers (Mazda RX7) will ensure life is not easy for them.

Stepping a little further back in time is the York Fitness Post Historic Touring Car Championship which sees cars built before 1974 in action. David Howard (Jaguar) is out in this as well, but this time will see opposition from the Mustang of Canadian Pete Hallford.

There should be some close action

through the classes with current championship leader Dave Nixon (Mazda) battling to stay ahead of Tony Crudgington (Triumph Dolomite Sprint).

Pete Hallford races the Mustang again in the Barons Auctions Classic Saloon and Historic Touring Car Championship for pre '66 cars and should not have much opposition as he is the only entrant in the big-engined class.

But who knows! On Lydden's tight confines current championship leader Jim



Burrows might fancy his chances in his Mini Cooper S and will be looking to do his best to stay with Hallford as well as notch up more class points, especially if it's a damp day.

The class for Lotus Cortinas should provide close racing with Les Nash up against Daniel Nash (no relation) and Greg Carpenter. Veteran Les loves Lydden and who will forget his superb drive from the back of the field at this meeting last year?

Joining the Classic Package this year is another Saloon Category for the Toyo Tyres Modified Production Saloon Car Championship.

Back in action will be Robyn Woodger, who featured in a rather dramatic incident with fellow Rover SD1 driver Gerry Cain at the last round at Brands Hatch.

Robyn will be looking to get his 4800cc Rover to the head of the field to retrieve his class points deficit to Neil Pilpotts and championship leader Nick Williamson (Peugeot 205 GTi).

Always very smooth and quick Nick has opened up a useful lead over Piers Grange who is not with us today.

Sandwiched between this Saloon action will be two races for Single Seaters.

Unfortunately neither has attracted a large grid, but we can expect some close racing at the head of the field.

The Universal Racing Services Classic Formula Ford 2000 Championship is for wings and slicks cars built before 1983.

Many of today's famous names have been associated with FFord 2000 over the years including Martin Brundle, Patrick Head, Jonny Herbert, Damon Hill, David Leslie, Tiff Needell, Ayrton Senna . . . the list goes on.

Last year's champion Eddie Wilkins (Van Diemen RF83) has built up a healthy lead over Nicholas Pearce (Van Diemen RF82) who has moved up from Class B. Nicholas is racing this year to raise money for the Nick Owen Fund.

Also on the Single Seater bill is a race for the BRSCC/BARC Classic Formula Ford 1600 Championship.

TODAY'S RACING

In the class for older cars built before 1974, last year's champion Dave Lowe was just headed for honours by Keith Ward (Jomic) after three rounds. Dave will be travelling from his Guernsey home to race his Lotus 69 - surely still one of the prettiest cars on the circuits.

However top of the points scorers is Class B runner Simon Davey(Van Dieman RF81) ahead of Steve Pearce.

Closing the action today will be an Allcomers Challenge which will bring together competitors from all the Saloon and Sports Car races today. BMW E28 v Jaguar XK120 v Daihatsu Charade turbo v Rover SDI v Jaguar D-Type. Now that *is* variety. We are sure you will enjoy it!



British Automobile Racing Club

90 Years of Racing History - South Eastern Centre

On December 12 1912 a group of cyclecar enthusiasts gathered at the Hut Hotel, Wisley, in Surrey to compare notes on their machines.

Cyclecars (virtually four-wheeled powered cycles) provided the real enthusiasts motoring of those days, and the group decided there and then to form the Cyclecar Club.

The Hut Hotel was demolished in 1978 to make way for the old Portsmouth Road improvements, but the little acorns sown that day sprang into the mighty oak that is today's British Automobile Racing Club.

The Cycle Car Club was soon to become the Junior Car Club, racing at Brooklands and elsewhere in Britain, organising foreign tours and generally looking after the interests of the enthusiast. Brooklands was to play a big part in the BARC's childhood and adolescence, as the JCC was destined to merge with the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club to become the modern day British Automobile Racing Club.

The BARC's past is mile-stoned with all the great races at Brooklands, Donington, the Goodwood Formula One and Formula Two meetings, the British Grand Prix at Aintree and Crystal Palace.

Brooklands was its first home, Goodwood its

second and, since 1968, Thruxton its third. Housed in its headquarters at Thruxton the BARC now oversees race meetings at all the major circuits in the country and now runs the majority of the rounds of the British Touring Car Championship. In addition the club officiates at the highly-successful Goodwood Festival of Speed and the Goodwood Revival Race meetings.

In addition national race meetings are run throughout the country alongside sprint and hill climb championships in the hands of the successful network of local centres.

In 1955 the original South Eastern Centre was formed. Over the years a number of developments took place culminating in the formation in 1977 of the highly-successful London and Home Counties Centre.

Recent years have seen the Centre spread its geographic area of activities and January 1st 2000 saw the Centre revert to the name South Eastern Centre to better reflect this.

This year the Centre will organise race meetings rallycross events and sprint meetings at Lydden Circuit, Goodwood Circuit and Silverstone as well as being the event organiser for the Citroen 2CV 24 Hour Race to be held at Snetterton Circuit in June.
