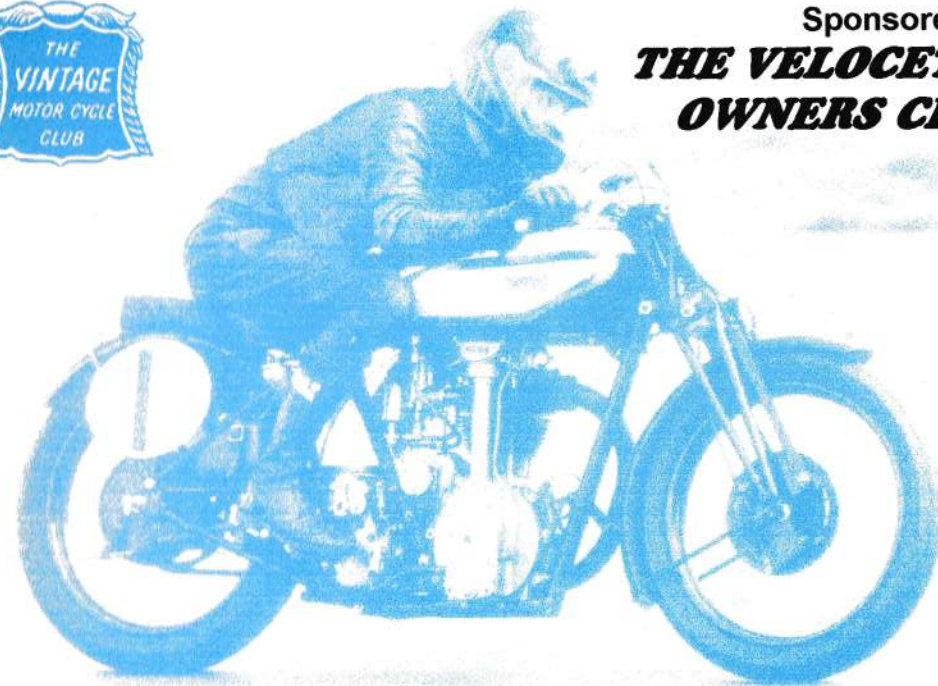

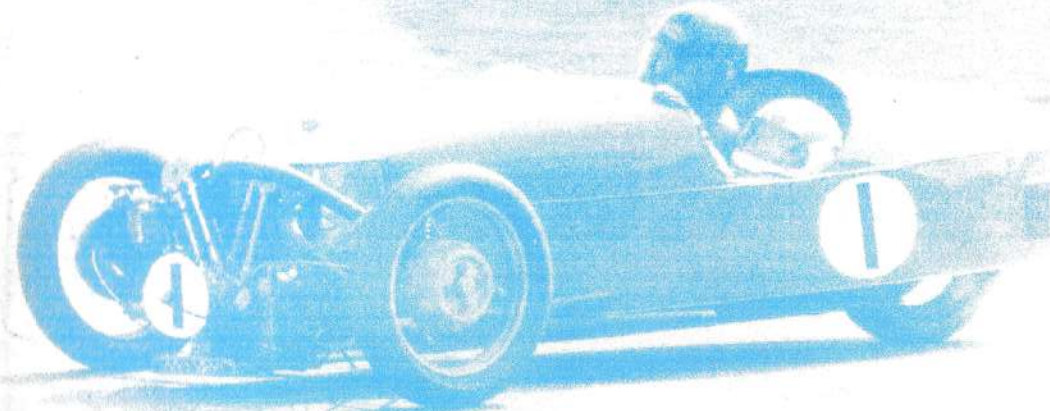

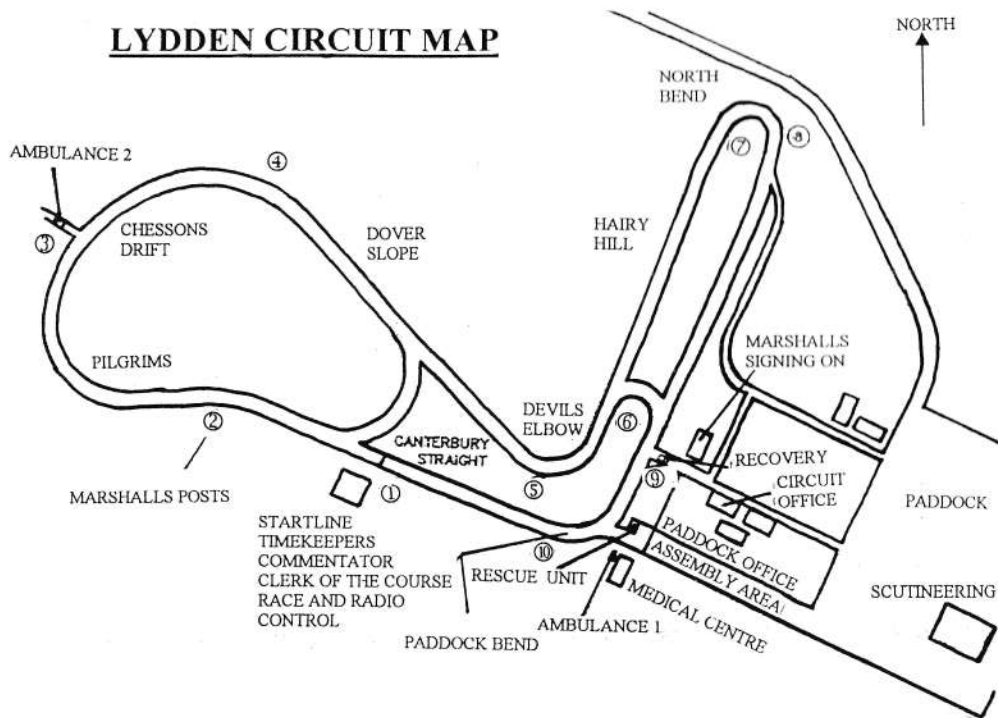

## RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS - RACING NEWS

This weekend's trip to Lydden is both the southern-most leg of the championships and part of the Velocette O.C. backed event. For those unaware, the V.O.C. joined forces with Historic Racing in a two-part venture, the first being Cadwell's 3<sup>rd</sup> round a couple of weeks ago - the Northern half - with today's being the Southern equivalent. So welcome along to Lydden, let's hope the weather keeps up its previous standards and improves upon the last round's foggy environment!

As far as the championships are concerned, things are hotting up. Yet another new name went into the Morris Lubricants Champion of Champions record books last time out. Martin Waters capitalised on the handicap advantage to take his B33 to victory, just pipping Ray Moore's Norton to the line and storming into the title fray with 15 points. Reigning No.1 Ian Bain goes top with 17 points with Phil Jobborn on 16. Waters, Allan Marsh and Tim Jackson all 3<sup>rd</sup> with 15 points. My money is on Jackson today, if he can overcome his stiff handicap because Ian Bain, on the '28 Norton, will start half a lap ahead of him. It should be a cracker.

Can anyone catch John Butcher in the J.T. Fabrications Unlimited and the Chiltern Systems Specials series', for his T'Bird has so far proved almost invincible. Graham Buller's mighty Vincent has chased him hard, bursting the bubble just once at Cadwell and Jim Overbury's Weslake Metisse has also played second fiddle. I reckon the nimble Triumph will have the edge here.

In the later class the Bantams feature and have embarrassed more than a few of the bigger lads here in the past. Keith Woods, Mark Carkeek, Peter Tibbitts and Brian White are the names to watch.

If Tony Webb has his Greeves here then he must start favourite for the Lortim 250 event, but he will be chased hard by fellow two-stroker, Deane Wakeling on the Ariel and the ever-green Merv Stratford with his rapid '34 Rudge.

Tim Jackson has so far been master of the GB Motor Co. Senior Class, his Summerfield Manx dominant. Having said that, Ewan Cameron got his Velo' ahead once at slippery Cadwell to halt the clean sweep. Likewise, it's so far been the year of the Gold Star in the Jim Lidgate Memorial 350 chase. Steve Radakovic doing the business with Stuart Tonge's push-rod AJS and John McMahon's Manx forming the main opposition.

McMahon has turned out to be the major force in the Old Bike Mart pre '49 Unlimited series, too. His oversized 5T just a bit too quick for the likes of Bain on the ex-Guthrie Manx and the HRD Comet of Graham Buller.

Bain's 1928 CS1 Norton and the Stratford Rudge combination have been the stars of the Tuers Garage pre '35 event, and both like Lydden. Indeed, they collided a season ago at the Elbow, so it will be a matter of pride this weekend.

Dark horse here could be Allan Marsh, who is improving rapidly on his push-rod Norton. Despite some serious challenges from the twin cylinder hordes. Robin Williamson and Nick Houghton have their big Manx outfit a-top the Langham Engineering Sidecar table, and the inevitable Tuer Morgan, having suffered problems at Cadwell, will be out to increase the table-top lead in the G.S. Fabrications Three-Wheelers.

Tuer has staked an early claim on his No.1 plate too, in the Richard Adams Three-Wheeler Champion of Champions Handicap. The Morgans and the Mettam Mogvin put on the race of the weekend last year, so should make the sparks fly again.

With the added bonus of the Velocette and Norton races, it promises to be a great weekend's Historic Racing. Enjoy it to the full, and I'll see you on the long circuit at Cadwell Park on June 22.

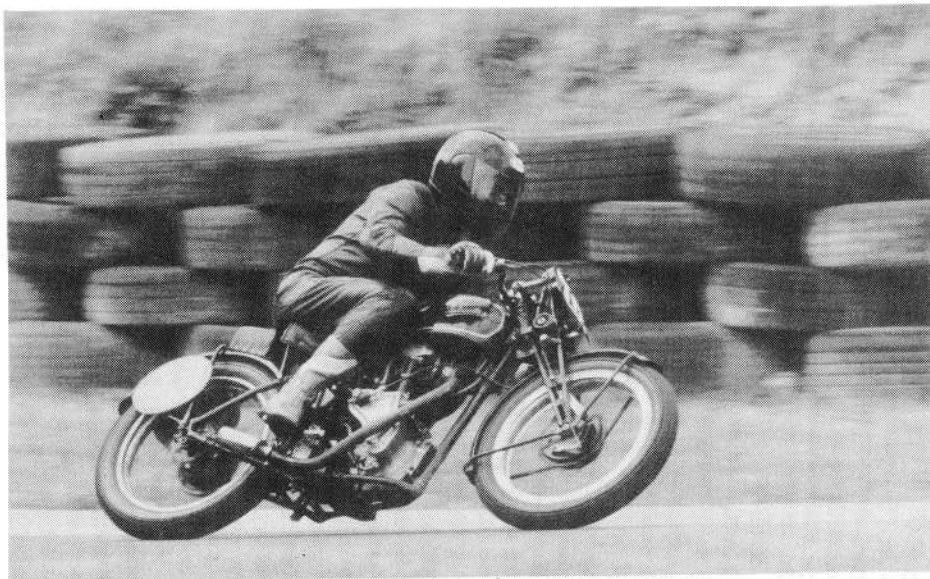

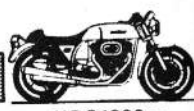

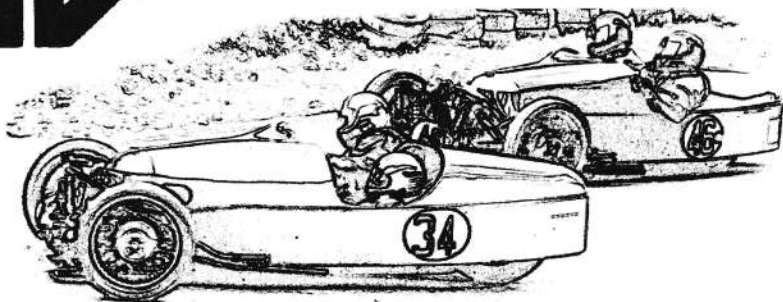

Welcome to the second 1997 race meeting and get-together for Velocettes and Velo fans!

The first of this year's two VMCC Historic Race meetings sponsored by the Velocette Owners Club was at Cadwell a fortnight ago, and today the winner of the premier Arthur Lavington Trophy will be decided by the aggregate result of this weekend's Lavington race and the first leg at Cadwell. Points are awarded for the top ten places in each leg, on the basis of 15, 12, 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. The first leg was won by Ewan Cameron, number 113, and the full Cadwell result was:

Members of the Velocette Owners Club have been invited to enter Velocettes or other classic machines in any of the solo and three-wheeler races during the weekend, even though they may not meet VMCC eligibility criteria, but of course their positions will not count towards the VMCC annual championships unless their machine is VMCC eligible.

Regular VMCC Velocette riders are competing all this season for an annual trophy championship sponsored by the Velocette Owners in memory of Dave Allcock, who was suddenly and prematurely taken from us at the start of this year, after giving so much of his time and skill to the club.

Back by popular demand is the traditional Velocette Owners Club 'High Speed Trial'. In this race the riders are competing for 1st or 2nd class awards which require them to complete a certain number of laps within the 20 minutes of the trial. The number of laps for a First class award is a real challenge, requiring a sustained lap time that could well win a place amongst the leaders in a straight race! The High Speed Trial is sponsored by Nick Payton who will be remembered by many of the VMCC riders as an outstanding Velocette racer on his Viper and Venom based machines. He retired a few years ago and now offers Velocette engineering and spares services in South London.

A different sort of event is the Circuit Tour for Road-worthy Classic Bikes, which will take place just after the morning's racing, during the lunch-break. It is not a race, rather a chance to see several generations of machines motoring steadily around the circuit. The Velocette machines participating will gather in the paddock area after the tour for trophy judging – unkind non-Velocette riders have suggested that the trophy goes to the machine standing over the smallest oil puddle after cooling off.

Please do have a closer look at all the bikes in the paddock, and a chat with their riders. And come along to the trophy presentation for all these events, plus best-presented Velocette, outside the bar on Saturday evening, half an hour after racing finishes.
