## FLAGS AND LIGHTS

Marshals and other officials display flags, lights or boards to provide information and/or convey instructions to the riders during practice as well as the races.

**Flags and lights used to provide information.**

**NATIONAL FLAG OR "START LIGHTS"** : Start of the race.

**GREEN FLAG OR GREEN LIGHT** : This indicates the end of a Danger Area controlled by yellow flags. In these circumstances overtaking is **PROHIBITED** until the point where the Green Flag is displayed has been passed. It is also to signal the start of a warm-up lap and shown at all posts during the first lap of each practice session.

**YELLOW AND RED STRIPED FLAG** : Shown waved indicates oil, water or another substance is affecting adhesion on this section of the track.

**BLUE FLAG** : Shown waved, this flag indicates that a faster rider is about to overtake.

**WHITE FLAG** : Shown waved, there is a slow moving car, ambulance or similar vehicle on the track this flag indicates that the rider will encounter the vehicle in current section of the track. The dispatcher of such a vehicle on the track must ensure that the post prior to the point where the vehicle will join the track is aware of the situation. It is forbidden for a rider to overtake another rider during the display of the white flag. Overtaking the slower moving vehicle is permitted. As soon as such a vehicle stops on the track, the white flags must be maintained and the yellow flags must be presented.

**CHEQUERED (BLACK AND WHITE) FLAG** : Finish of race or practice session.

**CHEQUERED FLAG AND BLUE FLAG** : These flags are shown together at the start line when a rider(s) precedes the leader during the final lap before the finish line.

**YELLOW FLAG WITH BLACK CROSS** : You are about to start your last lap.

**Flags Which Convey Information and Instructions.**

**RED FLAG OR RED LIGHT** : The practice or race is being interrupted. Riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. Riders must return to the pits, or as directed by the Marshals acting upon instructions from the Clerk of the Course.

**YELLOW FLAG OR YELLOW LIGHTS** : Danger on this section of the track. When motionless **overtaking is forbidden**. When shown waved the danger is more imminent and riders must slow down and be prepared to stop. **Overtaking or failing to slow down is forbidden**. Riders must take immediate action on **seeing** the yellow flag/lights. During the final inspection lap, the yellow flag must be presented motionless at the exact place where the flag marshal will be positioned during practice and races.

There are automatic penalties for disregarding yellow or red flags. It may also be considered as an act of dangerous or reckless riding.

**BLACK FLAG** : This flag is designed to convey instructions to a rider and is displayed at the startline together with the rider's number. The rider must stop at the pits at the end of the current lap.

**BLACK WITH ORANGE CIRCLE FLAG** : This flag is displayed with the rider's number. The rider must leave the track **IMMEDIATELY**.

**OTHER FLAGS MAY BE USED FROM TIME TO TIME IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACU HANDBOOK.**

## SPECTATOR NOTICES

Please do not leave litter about the grounds, place in receptacles provided, or take home with you, remember just one piece of litter could be FATAL.

Please drive with care and consideration when leaving the circuit, this is a RaceTrack, the Road outside is NOT.

## PROHIBITED AREA NOTICES

The Public are not permitted in the areas where these notices are displayed, any fences or gates are there for your protection, any person found trespassing, or wilfully damaging trees, fences etc, **WILL BE PROSECUTED**.

## BLAST OFF AT LYDDEN HILL



The biggest Club Championship in the UK kicks off at Lydden Hill on the 3rd - 4th March with a packed programme, featuring over 300 solos of all classes. Add in a full grid of Formula One Sidecars and you have a recipe for a superb days entertainment.

The prize for the Overall Club Champion is over £5,000 plus having the honour of engraving your name on the historic Mellano Trophy (first awarded in 1923). Last years winner, Darren Moggridge, now has his name engraved alongside Barry Sheene, John Surtees, Geoff Duke and Mike Hailwood amongst many others.

The tight and twisty circuit at Lydden Hill brings out the best in riders who have a neat and tidy style but must also be willing to scrap for each corner. There is no real machine advantage at Lydden, where any machine from 250 Grand Prix to Powerbike can set the fastest times, therefore the spectator is guaranteed good racing and plenty of passing manouveres. Any refugee from F1 car racing would possibly O.D. on adrenaline watching a Supersport 600 race at Lydden. They might however recognise the faint crackle of fibreglass as they all try to use the same piece of tarmac going into the hairpin on the first lap! Kenny Everest, Ricky Chadwick, Mark Parrett and Jason McNulty have all raced in the British championships and will be hoping to head the field from the up and coming riders such as Ben Mossey, Phil Seton, John Woodhams and Jim Woodhams. All look likely to figure strongly in the MRO National Cup this season and will be hoping to establish a psychological advantage.

The club has introduced a new 600cc class this year for the more faint hearted Clubmen not yet ready for the frenetic cut and thrust of the Supersport 600 category. Clubman 600 should give the middle tier riders a chance to shine in their own class of racing, and also enable the club to accommodate another 40 entries in this ever popular class.

The first meeting of the year usually highlights some new and unknown talents in the Rookie classes. Many of us have yet to shake off the memory of Shane Byrnes first race 5 years ago, his sideways on style looked as though he was on the point of crashing at every corner. Amazingly, he stayed aboard to win and went on to take in the last two rounds of the British Championship in the same year. In following seasons we have seen many outstanding riders and the Rookie of the Meeting at the seasons opening event is usually a fair indication of success to follow.

There being only two modern Motorcycle events at Lydden Hill this year means that many riders will take this opportunity to get machine set up for the Lord of Lydden in October. Lap record holder Ricardo Ballerini has made it known that he intends to take that title this year, so don't be surprised if he breaks his own record this weekend. Roger Ford, Andy Denyer and Vince Whittle will obviously have other ideas about that, none of them will want to see the 'Italian Stallion' galloping off into the distance.

In the sidecar events British Championship front runners Tim & Tristan Reeves will be making an appearance to hopefully get their season off to a winning start. Sidecar events are always spectacular and sometimes throw up surprising results. Bill Philp & Ian Conn aboard their new LCR outfit will hope to outshine the Reeves brothers.

So the scene is set for the season opener.
