FLAG SIGNALS

Blue/Steady: Another competitor is close
Blue/Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass
White: Service vehicle or very slow moving car on circuit
Yellow/Steady: Danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down
Yellow/Waved: Great danger ahead, no overtaking, slow down and be prepared to stop
Yellow with Red Stripes: Slippery surface ahead
Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared. Also, shown at all marshals post to indicate their positions to competitors on the first lap of all practice sessions
Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals
Black/orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure or of a fire which might not be obvious to the driver. Call into pits immediately
Black/White Rectangular displayed with White number: Warning to the driver that his behaviour is suspect and he may be black flagged
Black displayed with White numbers: Driver must return to the paddock and report to the Clerk of Course
Black & White Chequered: End of race
National Flag: This is used to start races in the absence of electric starting lights, and where races have split starts.

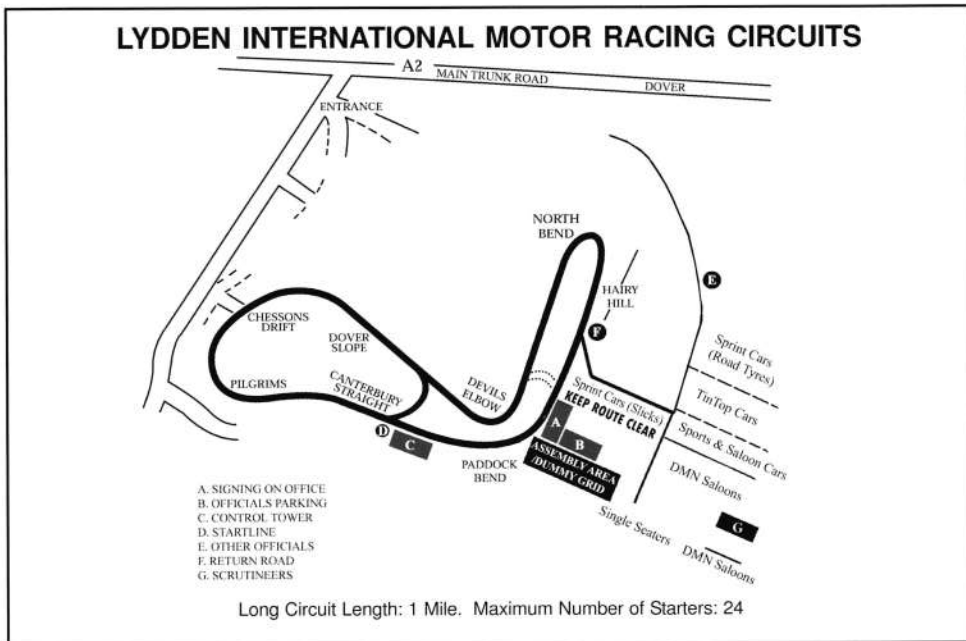


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Left: Steve Weatherley and Greg Rose running a very close and very clean race into Paddock Bend when at Lydden in April.

Coming in to the final round of the championship, David Watson (Radical SR4) is just 0.8 points ahead of Derek Jones (BMW M Coupe) after a season long battle. A class win for David will move him into an unassailable lead with a total score of 201.2 while the best Derek can hope for is a 0.4 point improvement to give him a total of 198.8. Watch out for them both today, Derek in the yellow BMW running number 6 and David on the red Radical SR4 running number 63.

The battle of the Hondas continues in class 0b where Chris York leads Jeremy Parker in the championship. Class 1 sees a rare outing by 2006 champion Mike Edwards in his Mini while Jonathon Dowding will be hoping to take class honours in the Micra but cannot catch the score amassed by his Dad who is leading the class. Class 3 honours are still very much up for

grabs. Simon Taylor currently leads Kim Adams by 8 points so must finish no more than 3 places behind Kim's mighty Mitsubishi to clinch the class. Of course, Brian Winstone, Ian Stevenson, John Start and Neil Duncanson will be looking to spoil Kim's chances as well!

In class 5, Simon Besant's V8 Westfield reigns supreme while Peter Ellen's Alpine cannot be challenged in class 7.

Peter Hayter has sewn up class 9 in the SBD Westfield but the battle will be close between him, Steve Broughton and Dick Hulbert on the day.

Championship leader David Watson will be pushed hard by the OMS drivers for class 10 honours.

TODAY'S RACING

This is the final visit to Lydden by the BARC south east centre for this year. As usual the Dunlop

Motorsport News saloon car championship tops the bill, but there are some excellent support races featuring the road tyred Tin Tops, plus Sports/Saloons and Single Seaters. The DMN overall title has been decided in favour of last year's champion Rod Birley (Ford Escort WRC), who has proved to be almost unbeatable in class A. I say almost, because Greg Rose took a well deserved first outright win at Silverstone in August. Greg is hoping to bring either the Ford Falcon or the Sierra RS500 today, in an effort to maintain the runner up spot in class A from a fast closing John Cross (Mercedes V8).

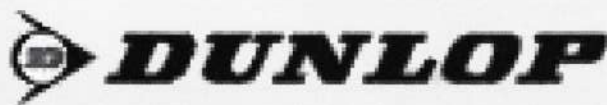
Class B sees the consistent Andy Thompson (Seat) as points champion, although Lydden has not proved to be one of his better circuits. Here he has faced stern opposition from the Ford Sierra driven by Rick May and the Sapphire of Steve Weatherley, along with the other Seats of Ray Adams and Anthony Ahmed. In class C Andy Woods-Dean (Renault Megane) heads the way after scoring a magnificent outright win here last month. Andy is almost home and dry in the class points chase, although Ashley Hargreaves (Peugeot 205) does have an outside chance along with Chris Adams (Honda Integra).



Conversely class D is showing all the signs of a nail biting finish. Alex Ribbens (Ford Escort Mk.2) narrowly leads newly wed Andy Pipe (Ford Escort Mk.1). Both are now looking towards their eight best scores to secure the class title. However, they may struggle to win their class today as the quick Peugeot of Phil Brent

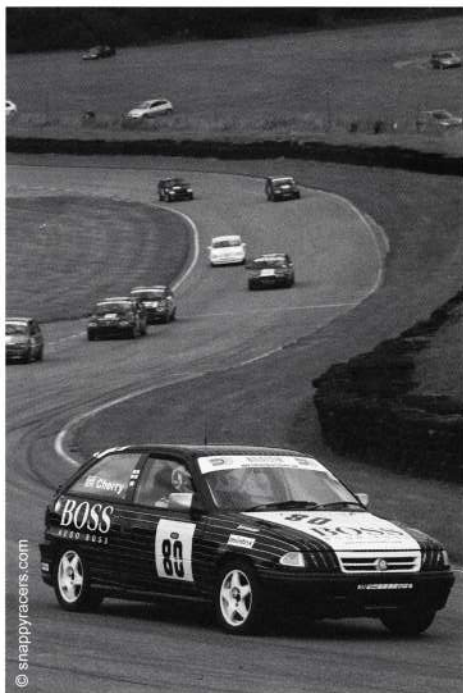

usually leads the way, along with newcomer Russell Turner in his immaculate Ford Escort Mk.1. Graham Richardson (Vauxhall Nova) could spring a surprise if he has sorted the handling difficulties with his car.

Class E is also hotly contested with three Minis looking to secure honours. The Kent duo of 2005 champion Bill Richards and current class leader Lee McNair face the long distance traveller, from Devon, Peter Crewes. All three have tasted success and drama this year, with Richards suffering a cracked chassis at the most recent round here last month. Add the quick Ford Fiestas of Russell Harding, Eric Falce and Alan Everitt and all the ingredients are in place for a superb set of races.

The tin tops are also likely to feature Bill Richards, with his slightly more standard Mini, but this time he will be up against the Proton driven by Danny Cassar. Hopefully Steve Dann will have fixed his recent engine woes in his VW Golf, but he will be hard pressed to match the BMWs of John Willcocks and Andrew Busby. Gary Chappell (Toyota Celica) will pick up the pieces if any of the above falter.



In the sports/saloons we should see John Hill (Caterham 7) setting the pace, with David Fuller trying hard in his MG Midget. There is also an experimental class for up to 1400 cc Minis, where we see Stephen King challenging Tristram Barden and Paul Simonds.

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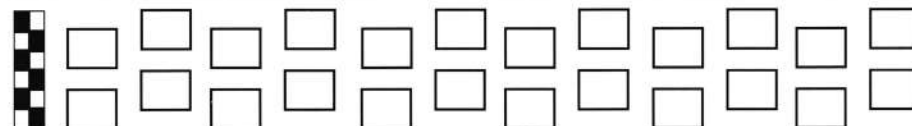

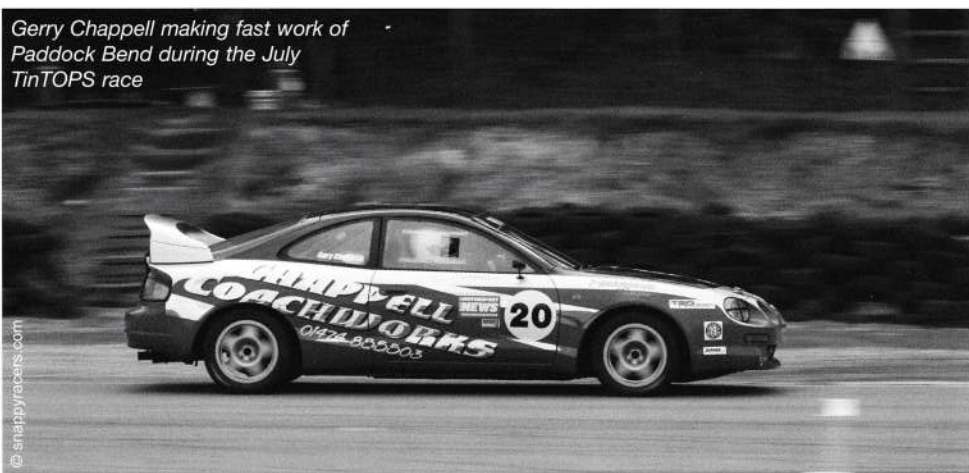
