SEMSEC

It has always been SEMSEC's philosophy is to promote clubman level motor sport to the widest possible audience. Most of our events are run here at the Lydden Hill Circuit, but we also run an event at Brands Hatch. Our Championship and Challenge series are designed to cater for most cars.

SEMSEC Saloon & Sports Championship

This Championship is for Competitors participating in 2 or 4 wheel drive cars. Included are hybrid "closed" configuration Special "GT" cars or Special Saloons, modified saloons, Sports Cars, Sports Cars built for one make racing series and prototype sports cars.

SEMSEC Open Single Seater Challenge

Our Single Seater Challenge is for Single Seat Racing cars up to 2000cc and includes Formula Ford 1600, Formula Ford Zetec, Formula Ford 2000, Formula Vauxhall, Formula Renault and motor cycle engined single seaters.

South East Challenge

For Sports Racing, One Make Sports Racing & Sports Kit Cars. Sports Racing are a two seater competition car designed and built specifically for racing. Kit Cars are two seater sports cars commercial manufactured for the general public in kit form for use on the public highway. Included in the challenge are classes for smaller capacity two wheel drive normally aspirated saloons and hatchbacks for cars up to 1400cc and up to 1600cc.

 Warning to driver of suspect behaviour

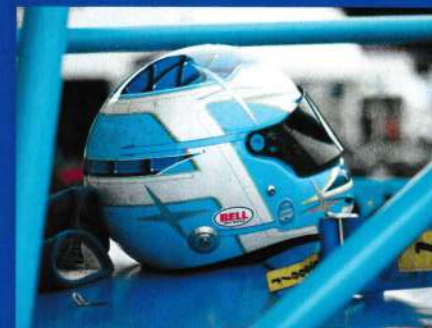

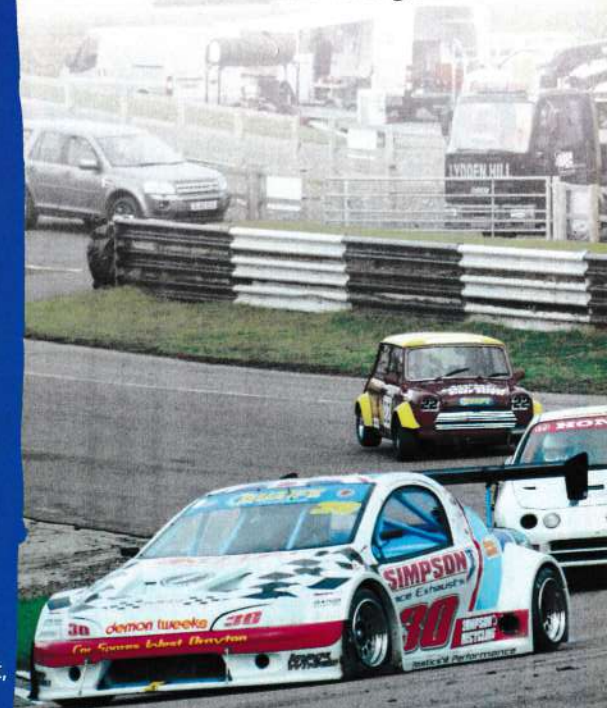

It is a pleasure to welcome you to our first event of 2013 at the fantastic Lydden Hill circuit.

The SEMSEC club is run by enthusiasts for enthusiasts. They are all volunteers so a big thank you to all the officials and marshals here today, without whom this event would not be possible.

Preceding today's racing we have a Sprint. Sprinters compete against the clock, each has a practice and timed runs. The cars are divided into 15 different classes depending on type, engine capacity and state of modification. RAFMSA Race Challenge

The Royal Air Force Motor Sports Association (RAFMSA) has been active since 1961. Its members are currently active in every form of motor-sport from regional to International level. Their most famous member is Squadron Leader Andy Green, driver of Richard Noble's Thrust-SSC, which broke through the sound barrier to make him the fastest man on earth!

The RAFMSA operates a sprint track at RAF Barkston Heath, where newcomers are introduced into motor-sport at a budget level. From these grass-roots beginnings many members have progressed up the motor sports ladder with financial support from the RAF Sports Lottery. Our more experienced members (some of whom are ARDS instructors) are on hand to assist the newcomers.

The aim of the RAFMSA Race Challenge is to bring together the great diversity of cars used by its circuit racing members into a single race format. Consequently, the awards do not relate to track position, but to each individual's pace. Their pace is based on a comparison of their race average lap time against their fastest lap time. This is a measure of their ability to make a good start, how soon they can "get on the pace" (whilst tyres and brakes are cold) and to maintain that pace whilst jostling for race position.

Each season's races are used to select RAFMSA team members for the annual "Birkett 6 Hour Team Handicap Relay" race at Silverstone every October. The RAFMSA have successfully fielded teams for this epic event for the past seven years achieving two class wins plus two outright wins.
