




Special mention must be made about local hero and last year's champion, Bill Richards. Bill drove three cars in the six races, which made up the morning

This time they will be sharing the track with the sportscar Tigers. The Tigers have been competing at various circuits this year, including Mallory Park, Snetterton, and Silverstone. This is their second visit to Lydden so they should be used to the demands of this unique circuit. Expect the front runners to include Mick Grant, Mark Steadman, Paul Dudley and Mark Steward, whilst in the tin tops it should be that man Richards or possibly Jamie Goldthorpe with his Honda CRX.

The single seaters have the added challenge of a team event between the Formula Vees and the E.R.A.s. The Formula Vees have Volkswagen engines with very limited modifications, but there is a choice of chassis. The ERAs come from the same

The final round of the Dunlop Track and Race saloons takes place at Brands Hatch on November 4/5th, where all the championship positions will be decided.

Club Motorsport At Its Best

On December 12 1912 a group of cyclecar enthusiast, gathered at the Hut Hotel, Wisley, Surrey to compare notes on their machines.

Cyclecars (virtually four-wheeled powered cycles) provided the real enthusiasts motoring of those days, and the group decided there and then to form the Cyclecar Club.

The Hut Hotel was demolished in 1978 to make way for the old Portsmouth Road improvements, but the little acorns sown that day sprang in to the mighty oak that is today's British Automobile Racing Club.

The Cycle Car Club was soon to become the Junior Car Club, racing Brooklands and elsewhere in Britain, organising foreign tours and generally looking after the interests of the enthusiast. Brooklands was to play a big part in the BARS's childhood and adolescence, as the JCC was destined to merge with the Brooklands Automobile Racing Club to become the modern day British Automobile Racing Club.

The BARC's past is mile-stoned with all the great races at Brooklands, Donington, the Goodwood Formula One and Formula Two meetings, the British Grand Prix at Aintree and Crystal Palace.

Brooklands was its first home,
Goodwood its second and, since 1968
Thruxton it's third. Housed in its
headquarters at Thruxton the BARC
oversees race meetings at all the
major circuits in the country and now
runs the British Touring Car
Championship among other major
championships.

The club officiates at the highlysuccessful Goodwood Festival of Speed and the Goodwood Revival Race meetings.

In addition national race meetings are run throughout the country alongside sprints and hillclimb championships in the hands of the successful network of local centres.

In 1955, the original South Eastern
Centre was formed. Over the years a
number of developments took place
culminating in the formation in 1977 of
the highly-successful London and
Home Counties Centre.

Recent years have seen the Centre spread it s geographic area of activities and revert to the name South Eastern Centre to better reflect this.

The centre this year has another busy programme with Race and Sprint events at Lydden, Goodwood and Silverstone Circuits.
