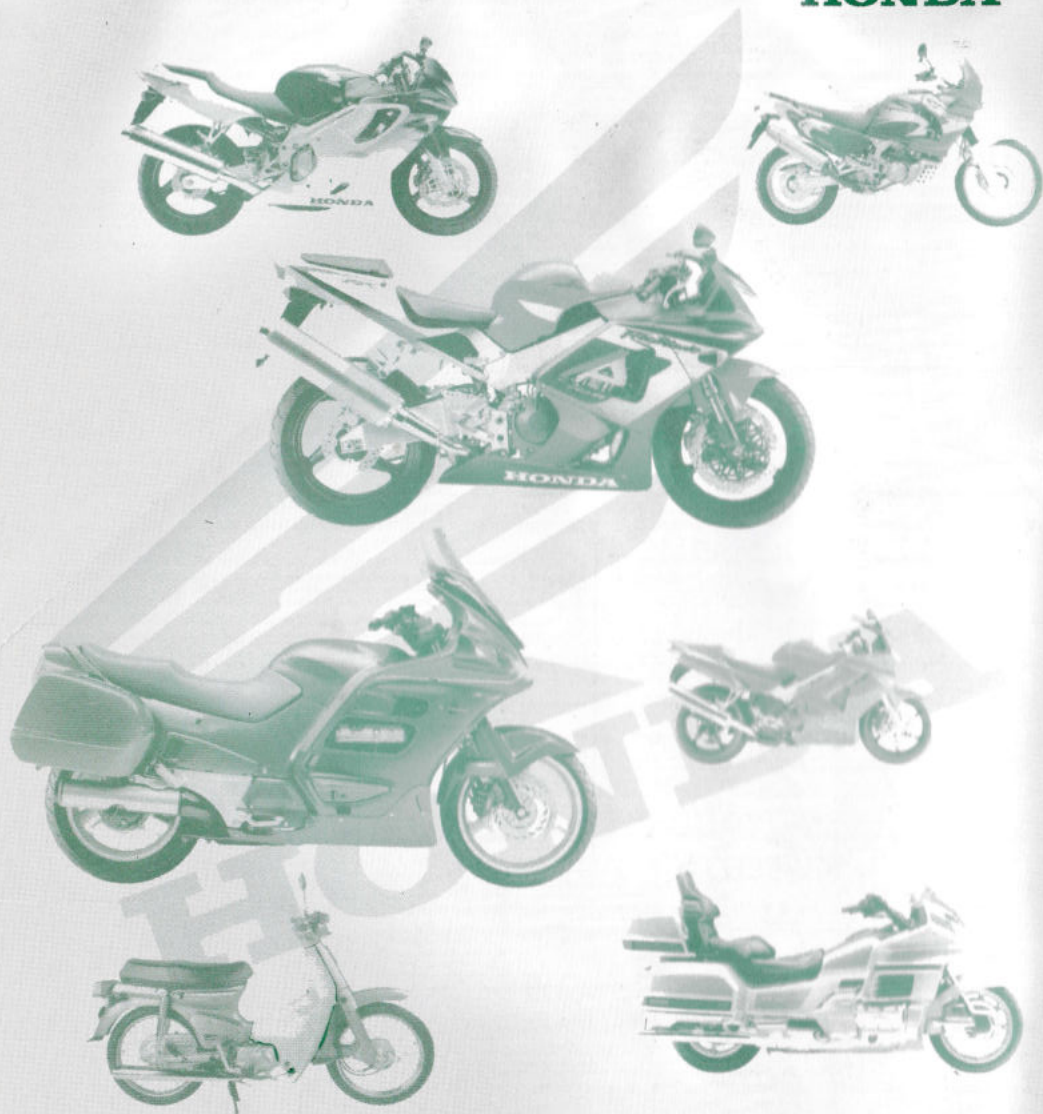

A warm welcome to Lydden International Circuit for the CRMC's second meeting of 2005. Nearly 250 solo and sidecar competitors will come under starter's orders for this weekend's 44-race programme. With its succession of tricky turns and ever changing gradients Lydden is surely the ultimate rider's circuit, where power advantage often doesn't mean a thing, and can sometimes even be a disadvantage.

As always we would like to thank all the officials, marshals, competitors and of course our sponsors. Without these committed people the meeting just cannot take place.

One of the great attractions of Classic Racing is the vast variety of bikes on show so don't miss the opportunity to tour the paddock. You'll find riders, owners and sponsors very approachable and usually only too happy to talk racing.

The season opener at Mallory Park produced some exhilarating racing, with lap and race records falling like ninepins. Manx Norton mounted Glen English and Lea Gourlay can again be expected to provide the fireworks in the Classic Junior and Senior GP races and Saturday's National 350 and 500 Series rounds. Hard riding Luke Notton (7R) missed Mallory but will be adding extra spice in the Junior races. However, the entry for both classes is absolutely loaded with quality riders, and just about anything could happen around Lydden's tight turns.

Gourlay (Triumph) should also be prominent in the Classic 1300 races, where last year's champion, Phil Davenport (Trident), and Gary Thwaites (Norton 920 twin) are just two of several riders who will be in the mix.

Big capacity bikes again feature heavily in the Post Classic class, but don't be surprised if they are given a hard time by some of the ultra fast and nimble TZ 250 and 350 Yamahas. And talking of Tzeds, that's just about all you'll see in the Forgotten Era Classic GP class, where around 20 of them will be making sweet (to some!) 2-stroke music.

Nigel Palmer (480 Ducati) comes to Lydden with a 100% record in the Classic Senior events and will again be the man to catch, while the Classic Lightweight is likely to see a closely matched gaggle of 250 Ducatis and stokers scrapping it out for the honours.

At Mallory Alan Oversby and John Davidson took a win apiece in the Classic Junior Twins races but this is a highly competitive class in which any one of several riders could take the chequered flag this weekend.

In the 350 Goldies and Classic Ultra-lightweight races don't rule out seeing the light and agile 125's and 200's giving the more powerful 350 Gold Stars a run for their money.

And let's not forget those 3-wheelers! Sidecars are always spectacular around Lydden and this weekend has attracted a wide variety of machinery to savour.

Last but by no means least, Sunday sees the annual Charlie Sanby Race, in memory of one of British racing's most popular short circuit stars. This year's 12 lap race will be run for 201cc-1300cc Group 2 bikes, which is guaranteed to ensure spectacular action.

FLAG SIGNALS

Red: Immediately stop racing.

Yellow (steady): Signal of danger. (Waved) Slow down, driver must be prepared to stop.

OVERTAKING FORBIDDEN ON ANY YELLOW FLAG.

National flag or Green: Start

Black displayed with white number: informs the driver of motorcycle the number of which is shown that he must stop at the pit on the next lap.

Black with Orange circle: Displayed with vehicles number: the rider must leave the track IMMEDIATELY.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Deterioration of adhesion of the track surface

White: Slow moving intervention vehicle on track. The white flag informs drivers they are about to overtake a vehicle which is travelling on the track at much slower speed than competing motorcycles.

Blue: Overtaking signal, informs rider he they are about to be overtaken by a faster motorcycle.

Yellow with black diagonal cross: Start of the last lap.

Black/White Chequered: End of race.

Charlie Sanby

Charlie Sanby was a contemporary of the motorcycle legend Mike Hailwood and a star of the British short circuits in the 60's and 70's. At over six foot tall he towered over some of his rivals such as Bill Ivy, but Charlie was as gentle as he was tall.

He came to prominence when he won the prestigious Grovewood award in 1966 and reigned supreme at Lydden in 1972 when he was crowned Lord of Lydden. Although he could "scratch" with the best, he also had success in the Isle of Man with thirds in the 1973 Senior and 1975 Classic and led the 1971 Production TT from Ray Pickrell and Tony Jefferies until forced to retire with an electrical problem. Not only versatile on different types of circuit, Charlie was equally adaptable with the machinery racing 500 & 750 Nortons, 350 Aermacchi's Yamaha's, 500 Suzuki's and Moto Guzzi's.

Charlie returned to Classic racing in the mid eighties and was raced with the CRMC. He competed in the Race of the Year at Pembrey whilst suffering from cancer, and needed a pusher to start from the back of the grid. Despite all the handicaps he raced through the field to 8th place by the time the chequered flag went out.

The man doing the pushing from the back of the grid was his long time mechanic Wally Maisey, who will be here today to present Charlie's trophy to the winner.

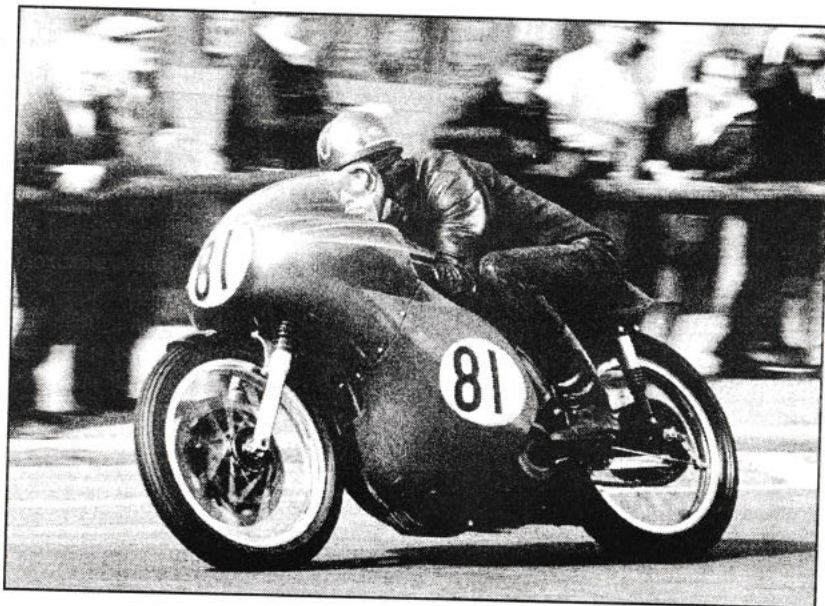

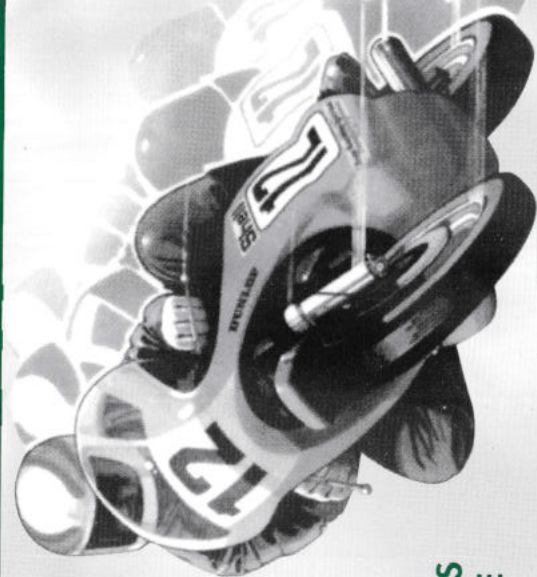
