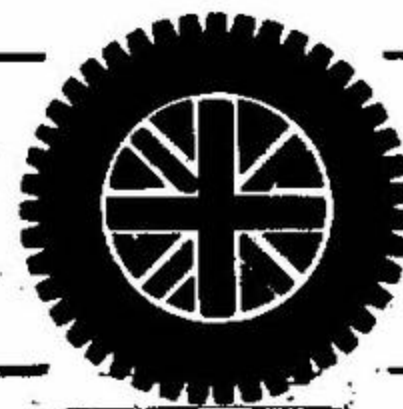

NOTES TO RIDERS! CANCELLED ENTRIES

The new ruling which is operating this season is as follows:

Riders are allowed to cancel entries providing that -

(a) Notification of cancellation is post-marked before the day of the event.

(b) If the reason for cancellation is medical then providing proof is provided a full refund will be made.

(c) If the reason for cancellation is other than medical then £1 is withheld from the entry to cover administration costs and deter frivolous cancellations.

RIDING IN THE Paddock

Riders are reminded that you are not allowed to push your machine with the engine running nor are you allowed to sit on the machine (including sidesaddle) and free wheel down slopes in the paddock.

If you break these rules then an automatic ban will be imposed which will stop you riding again until you have marshalled at two events.

Remember if you knock someone down in the paddock you will be liable NOT the club, nor the A.M.C.A., but you - the rider.

J.T. HELMETS

Riders and officials should note that J.T. Helmets are NOT allowed to be used in the A.M.C.A. events. They are not approved to either the American or B.S.I. Standards.

Confirmation from Rugby that they are also banned in the A.C.U.

It is possible that they may be approved by B.S.I. but until they are they are banned.

RESERVE GROUPING

A correction to the procedure for riders entering and riding in their reserve group. Last weeks A.M.C.A. News included a list of the clubs showing each clubs reserve group.

A few of the rules which apply to riding or attempting to ride in your reserve group.

If your group is not running a event then your club will be informed of which event you can enter in the normal way at the usual fee. This is not automatic and will depend on how many events are being run.

If your home group event is called off at short notice then you should try through your own club officials to see if your reserve group is willing to accept you and if so take your acceptance ticket for the cancelled event and you will NOT have to pay a late entry. It may be though that the organising club may only accept a certain number in some classes.

If your group does not have an event don't presume you can just turn up at your reserve group and get a ride even if you are willing to pay a late entry fee.

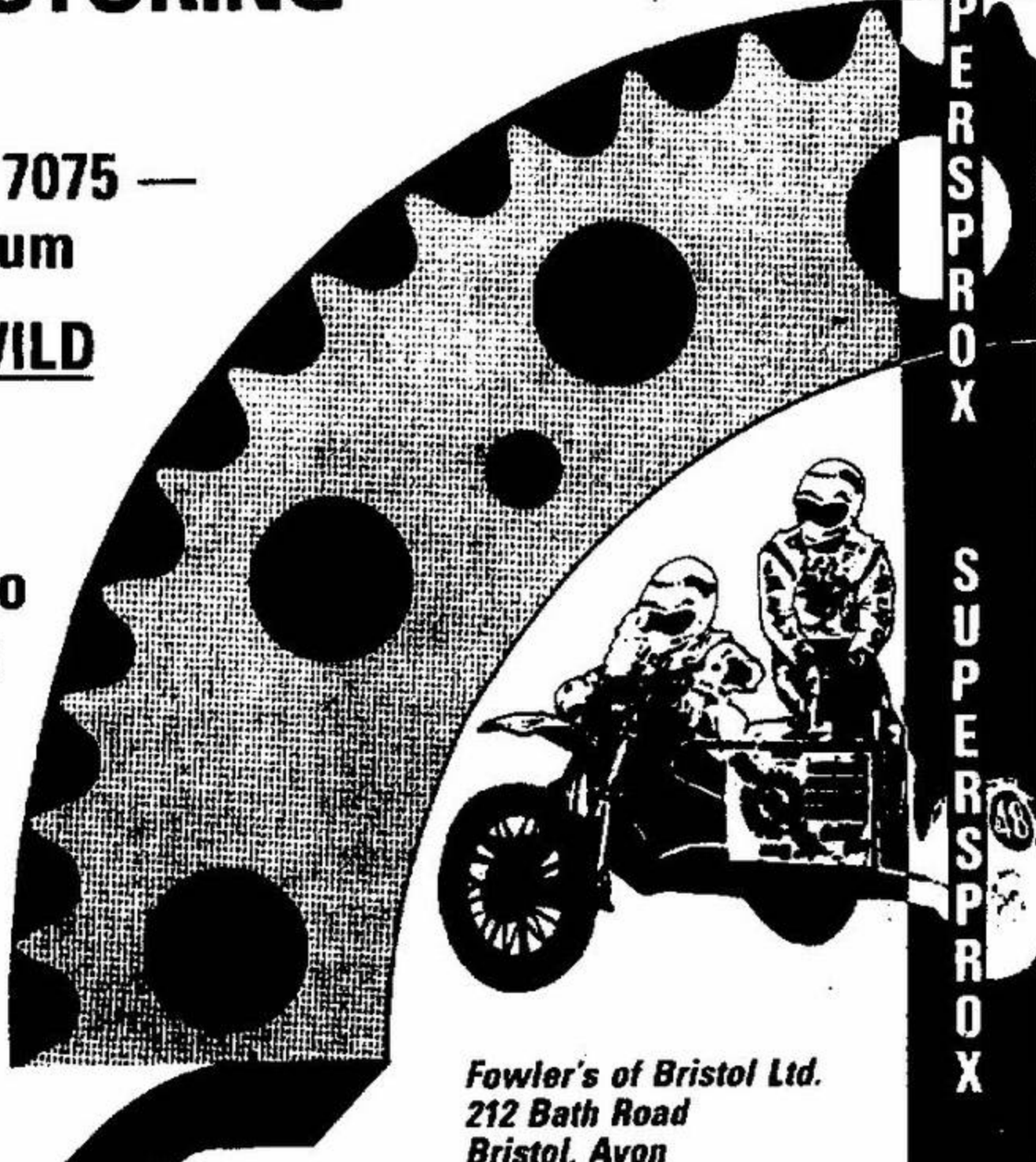
