THE JOANNA KNOTT TRUST

The Joanna Knott Trust has been set up to raise money for essential aids and equipment to help Jo regain some independence and quality of life after the fracture of her spinal cord last year, which has left her paralysed with bicep control only.

Jo, 32, studied at Maidstone Girls' Grammar School before completing an Honours Degree in history and politics at Birmingham University and moving into the world of Public Relations. After working initially for a cancer research charity and an international aeradio company, she worked for a London based P.R. company where she reached the position of Accounts Director, aged 27. Jo was instrumental in two campaigns at the company that won the P.R's industry's "Sword of Excellence" award in 1986-88.

In 1988, Jo and her boyfriend Bruce resigned for a long sabbatical in Australia, via the Far East and India. After establishing themselves in Sydney, doing casual labour, Jo worked for a subsidiary of a large advertising company before successfully completing a two year Masters Degree in Business Administration at the University of New South Wales, Sydney.

Jo has always led an active and outgoing life, she has travelled extensively since her teens and has pursued hobbies in sporting and cultural interests. In Australia she added scuba-diving and sailing to her sporting pursuits. She has always been an avid reader and theatre goer and has many, many friends

The freak accident occurred whilst Jo was ski-ing, back in August 1992 after a minor fall on ice which led to a horrific collision with a tree. Jo's C5 vertebrae was fractured and displaced, severing the nerves.

Since that day, Jo has pulled back from what might have meant a life spent on a ventilator as the paralysis spread up her spine, through ten weeks in traction, to an encouraging period in rehabilitation. She now faces the future as a dependant quadraplegic with no wrist or finger movement. With physiotherapy she is learning to retrain her biceps to gain a wide range of movement.

At the moment, none of us know what the future holds for Jo, although she has been told that further recovery will be limited. Many decisions will be made over the coming months and Jo is determined to retain control over her life and hopes to get back to work. With equipment provided by the trust it is hoped that she will be able to read, use computer equipment and undertake some basic daily tasks for herself. She is also anxious that the Trust should bring attention to the difficulties faced by victims of spinal injury throughout the world.
