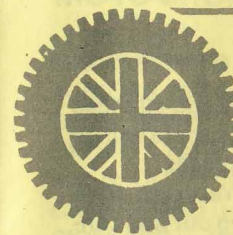

CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS POINTS SCORING SYSTEM

The winner of each race gains 20 points, second 17 points, third 15 points, fourth 13 points, fifth 11 points, sixth 10 points, seventh 9 points, eighth 8 points, ninth 7 points, tenth 6 points, eleventh 5 points, twelfth 4 points, thirteenth 3 points, fourteenth 2 points, and fifteenth 1 point. The winning ride in each class is the rider with the highest number of points. All races shown in the programme will count. Any additional races not shown in the programme will not count towards overall position. Any ties will be settled by the results of the last race in each class.

A.M.C.A. GROUPING OF CLUBS FOR 1993

Several clubs and groups have already been discussing the grouping of clubs for 1993 in view of the reduction in the number of riders competing. A reduction from the present 20 groups of clubs looks inevitable although there is an argument for keeping a large number of small groups who are then easily fitted into out of group events.

NON STARTERS

Whichever system is tried the underlying problem is the high number of riders who enter events but do not turn up to compete. Riders who are injured or whose bikes are unrideable are obvious reasons, but the situation is making it difficult for the clubs struggling to run the events.

EVENTS CANCELLED

Several clubs are now cancelling events due to lack of riders, in some cases riders are refusing to ride because they do not like the circuits.

The question has to be asked, if clubs do not run events as riders will not ride should the club remain in the Association. The present rule is that each club runs a minimum of 2 events (moto cross).

Several people have expressed views that riders should not be able to cancel entries, except perhaps for injury. This is a small part of the problem as the majority of riders who enter events and do not turn up to ride do not cancel their entry.

The main problem is the club on the day thinking they had a reasonable number of riders coming to ride and then finding a high proportion are not turning up.

1993 CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

It is still not too late for clubs interested in running Championship and International events next year to apply. Very few clubs who have applied have indicated they will take sidecars, so if your club is thinking of applying, solo or sidecar, please drop the office a line.

The actual number of qualifiers from each group should be 4 but it could be higher as some riders who have automatically qualified will no doubt decide to drop out during the coming winter.
